Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse
by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 16 February 2020

RACE 1: DOAN PHARMACIES / SABOIS MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1000 metres

GO BALLISTIC (S. Cahill) - Trainer Mr N. Smart was reprimanded under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards.

TRUE ILLUSION (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Inside the 600 metres improved onto the heels of APPLIED and was obliged to be steadied. In the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted out to obtain clear running and inconvenienced GO BOO BOO. Rider reminded of his obligations and to ensure he is sufficiently clear when shifting ground. Laid in, in the straight.

SIMPLY VEIN (C. Puls) - laid out in the straight.

APPLIED (K. Crowther) - Trainer Mr P. Huserot was reprimanded under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Laid in, in the straight.

GO BOO BOO (P. Gatt) - slow into stride. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by TRUE ILLUSION, which shifted out.

RACE 2: WOOLSHED INN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

HABANERO (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in tightening COUNTER SPIN.

SPACE EQUITY (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

FERGIE (J. Maund) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in and inconvenienced PRINCESS ASTRO. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

RACE 2: WOOLSHED INN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

COUNTER SPIN (E. Boyd) - tightened on jumping away between HABANERO, which shifted in and FERGIE, losing its position. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained after being tightened at the start, the gelding raced keenly and for that reason she was unable to settle COUNTER SPIN back with cover as intended, resulting in racing three wide without cover for the remainder of the event. Rider added she had become concerned with the gelding's action over the final 100 metres and for that reason she did not ride it out in her usual manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUSHWA (K. Zechner) - shortly after the start raced ungenerously for a short distance. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 900 metres had to be restrained off the heels of PRINCESS ASTRO, which was being steadied. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRINCESS ASTRO (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of FERGIE, which shifted in.

RACE 3: TATIARA CARPET CLEANING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 2000 metres

BULCMENE (E. Boyd) - shortly after the start shifted out and bumped IKNOW WHERE YOULIV. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without in the early and middle stages.

STEELCAPSTILETTOS (T. Voorham) - laid out in the straight. Rider explained the gelding laid out throughout the event and never travelled. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IKNOW WHERE YOULIV (L. Neindorf) - shortly after the start bumped by BULCMENE.

RED TERRA (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: TASCO PETROLEUM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

NJORD (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly and was inclined to lay in for a short distance thereafter. Approaching the 1000 metres when racing in restricted room between KONINGSBERG, which rolled in marginally and WRITTEN IN OAK, shifted in and away from KONINGSBERG and bumped WRITTEN IN OAK.

ONE OF THESE DAYS (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DE LA BOSSANOVA (R. Hurdle) - which was reluctant to proceed to the start reared up en-route to barrier dislodging the rider, R Hurdle was examined by First Care Medical and passed fit to ride. Trainer Mr M. Seyers was advised a warning had been placed on the mare as it was reluctant to proceed to the start without delay. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

GIRLINTHEMIRROR (K. Zechner) - in the vicinity of the 800 metres was obliged to be steadied away from the heels of DE LA BOSSANOVA.

TONS OF FUN (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground between the 600 metres and the 400 metres.

WRITTEN IN OAK (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres was bumped by NJORD.

RACE 5: IRON JACK BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

RHYTHMATIC (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and across the heels of IN THE FAST LANE and had to be restrained.

IN THE FAST LANE (R. Hurdle) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(b) in that he used his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height and was reprimanded.

KILOWATT (S. Logan) - rider explained the gelding travelled well throughout and could off no further explanation for the gelding's performance in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FAY'S JOY (C. Puls) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

LONG VIEW (J. Potter) - raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 6: TATIARA TRUCK & TRAILERS BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

Shortly after the start of this event, Stewards were notified that the tractor to move the starting gates had failed to engage into gear. Stewards directed the Clerk of the Course to position near the 600 metres and when it became apparent that the gates would not be removed in a safe time, directed that the Clerks advise the riders to ease their mounts from the event.

Acting under AR205 the Stewards declared the race to be void and determined that due to the fact all runners had competed for 1600 metres, it would not be appropriate for the race to be re-run.

RACE 7: MICHELLE'S PET & HOME SERVICES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1500 metres

ATHOS (S. Cahill) - slow to begin.

BUJOLASS (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride.

FREE ATBARA (P. Gatt) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

TEXAS MILLER (L. Halliday) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider explained the gelding was inclined to lay out in the straight and for that reason she was not fully able to fully test TEXAS MILLER to the line. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(b) in that she failed to ride her mount out to the end of the race.

KEYSOR (J. Potter) - held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until the 300 metres and obliged to shifted to the outside of GROOVE WITH ME to obtain clear running.

EUDORA (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Approaching the 1000 metres was obliged to be steadied after improving onto the heels of RIGHT AND READY. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GROOVE WITH ME (D. Tourneur) - raced three wide without cover throughout.
