RACE 1: STOCK AGENTS DAY 15 APRIL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

TIANANMEN (NZ) (D. Bates) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOX ON THE RUN (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced greenly and shifted about in the straight.

RACE 2: BOOK NOW COOPERS KOONARA MARQUEE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1430 metres

ATOMIC KNIGHT (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

LORD ROSENTHAL (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SOLAAZEM (D. Bates) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

GRAFFIAS (NZ) (K. Walters) – inside the 100 metres was obliged to take hold when tightened onto **ATOMIC KNIGHT** to avoid the heels of **TRY TRY TRY**, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TRY TRY TRY (R. Clark) – held up for clear running for a short distance inside the 400 metres. Inside the 100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of **GRAFFIAS (NZ)**, which was obliged to take hold when tightened onto **ATOMIC KNIGHT** to avoid the heels of **TRY TRY TRY**. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 14 January and to conclude at midnight on Sunday, 21 January 2018: a period of four meetings.

RACE 3: TENDER CUTS CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 metres

CHIC SALE (Jemma Frew) – shortly after the start shifted in and became awkward on the heels of **BAHGALLAH BANTAM** for a number of strides. Rider reported that in her opinion the gelding may have chocked down in the vicinity of the 1000 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXPLOSIVE GIFT (R. Clark) – at the entrance to the straight was inconvenienced for a number of strides when tightened onto **HASTA LA SPEC** as **BETTER JOURNEY**, which was hanging in, shifted in and away from **CRONAUER**, which had improved to the outside of **BETTER JOURNEY**.

RACE 3: TENDER CUTS CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

BETTER JOURNEY (K. Bishop) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Hung in rounding the home turn and shifted in onto EXPLOSIVE GIFT, which was inconvenienced for a number of strides when tightened onto HASTA LA SPEC. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA RED (NZ) (T. Germaine) – held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

RACE 4: HANSEN DESIGN & PRINT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

KALANGADOO CHROME (D. Bates) - jumped away very awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small skin lesion on the nose.

WILKIN (A. Jordsjo) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.

MICKY'S DIAMONDS (A. Chan) – in the early stages of the event when being restrained got its head up on a number of occasions

RACE 5: MUNRO & GRIGG AUTO REPAIRS BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

WINSTON TYCOON (C. Puls) – in the vicinity of the 50 metres bumped with MISS JOOLIA, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS JOOLIA (D. Bates) – in the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted out and bumped WINSTON TYCOON.

RACE 6: NARACOORTE RECYCABLES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

VELONSKI (J. Potter) – slow into stride. Difficulty obtaining clear ground from in the vicinity of the 200 metres until approaching the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOING GAGA (S. Cahill) – rider reported in his opinion the gelding did not feel comfortable racing inside other runners. He added that GOING GAGA may appreciate races over greater distances. a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHE'S ALL POWER (K. Walters) – inside the 100 metres rolled out onto BROAD SHOULDERS, which was obliged to be eased.

BROAD SHOULDERS (V. Wong) – inside the 100 metres was obliged to be eased as VISUAL IMAGE rolled in and SHE'S ALL POWER rolled out.

VISUAL IMAGE (A. Chan) - jumped away awkwardly. Inside the 100 metres rolled in onto BROAD SHOULDERS, which was obliged to be eased.

RACE 7: NARACOORTE RADIATORS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1430 metres

AWESOME SIGHT (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LEAD THE WITNESS (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GO WALLY (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

WATERBERG (NZ) (K. Walters) – held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

HUSTLER LA LOPE (V. Wong) - slow to begin.
