**Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse**

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**RACE 1: DK QUARRIES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres**

**FUTAGO** (K. Bishop) – hung out rounding the home turn.

**WICKED KID** (S. Fawke) – trainer, Mr R. King, was fined \$50 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards. Stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. Trainer was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

**FLOP** (A. Jordsjo) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**RACE 2: FOURIER TECHNOLOGIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres**

**CRAZY CULPRIT** (J. Potter) – jumped away awkwardly.

**GOLD MAESTRO** (S. Fawke) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

**TRUFFLE HUNTER** (A. Chan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**ARCTIC BLAZE** (D. Tootell) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SYNERGY.

**FOTO ART** (C. Davies) – kicked out and struck a perimeter fence in the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**SYNERGY** (V. Wong) – lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto GOLD MAESTRO by ARCTIC BLAZE, which shifted out.

**RACE 3: PORT LINCOLN GOURMET MEATS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1000 metres**

**GET PRONTO** (K. Bishop) – shifted in shortly after the start contacting LADY CONQUISTADOR.

**RACE 3: PORT LINCOLN GOURMET MEATS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (cont')**

**HECTIC** (R. Hurdle) – knuckled on jumping away.

**LADY CONQUISTADOR** (S. Fawke) – contacted shortly after the start.

**MAPPINGA QUEEN** (V. Wong) – laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

**LA BANDITA** (K. Crowther) – reared over in the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race.

**RACE 4: DEMPSEY'S SADDLERY & FEED SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1750 metres**

**HEZA HUSSLER** (R. Hurdle) – passing the winning post on the first occasion laid in and contacted THE ENGINEER.

**HAND TO HAND (NZ)** (R. Clark) – rolled out slightly in the vicinity of the 400 metres onto THE ENGINEER.

**HEZA GUNN** (B. Paterson) – passing the winning post on the first occasion was taken in onto GOLDPHON by THE ENGINEER.

**GOLDPHON** (A. Jordsjo) – had to be steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion when tightened by HEZA GUNN, after that gelding had received pressure from its outside.

**THE ENGINEER** (V. Wong) – contacted on jumping away. Passing the winning post on the first occasion was taken in onto HEZA GUNN. In the vicinity of the 400 metres had to be steadied when tightened between HAND TO HAND (NZ), which rolled out slightly, and AMBER DIAMONDS, which shifted in slightly.

**SILENT ELATION** (D. Tootell) – jumped away awkwardly.

**OLD FARM ROAD (NZ)** (K. Crowther) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

**AMBER DIAMONDS** (A. Chan) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting THE ENGINEER. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted in slightly onto THE ENGINEER.

**RACE 5: MEMBER FOR FLINDERS PETER TRELOAR CLASS TWO HANDICAP – 1210 metres**

**KID ME** (A. Chan) – shifted in, in the vicinity of the 1100 metres onto PENULTIMATE STAR. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground in future.

**PENULTIMATE STAR** (J. Maund) – in the vicinity of the 1100 metres had to be momentarily steadied off the heels of KID ME and in doing so shifted out and bumped PRINCESS ASTRO. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**GREEN GRASS** (V. Wong) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

**PRINCESS ASTRO** (K. Bishop) – contacted in the vicinity of the 1100 metres and became unbalanced for a short distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**OBLIQUE LINE** (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**BENGAL TIGER** (K. Crowther) – slow to begin.

**RACE 6: RAMSEY BROS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1750 metres**

**HARD AT IT** (A. Chan) – inclined to rear on jumping away. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 100 metres.

**LOTION** (S. Fawke) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

**RACE 7: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 metres**

**LAKE JACKSON** (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 100 metres clipped heels dislodging its rider. R. Hurdle was taken to Port Lincoln hospital for further observation. An inquiry into the reasons why the gelding clipped heels was adjourned to a date to be fixed to allow R. Hurdle to be present. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**ORATINI** (A. Jordsjo) – hung out rounding the home turn. Rider reported that in her opinion the gelding felt sore in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 8: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1390 metres**

**NEW WAVE** (J. Maund) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**TOUCH OF BELLA** (B. Paterson) – which was in an adjoining stall to DOUBTFUL BILLY, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Slow to begin.

**DOUBTFUL BILLY** (S. Fawke) – reared over in its barrier stall and became cast momentarily. Late scratching on Veterinary Advice at 4.51 pm. Trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, was advised that the gelding would be required to be tractable in the barriers in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

**PATRIOT CODE** (V. Wong) – which was in an adjoining stall to DOUBTFUL BILLY, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

**WILLANDER MISS** (K. Bishop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

<b>FINES</b>	Race 1 – Mr R. King – Fined \$50 – AR59A – Failure to produce the TIC for WICKED KID. Race 4 – S. Fawke – Fined \$200 – AR120(b) – Overweight and having to be replaced on ARTFUL FRANCYL.

<b>HORSE ACTIONS</b>	Race 1 – WICKED KID – Warned – Stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. Race 8 – DOUBTFUL BILLY – Suspended – Required to be tractable in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race – Reared over in the barrier.
