Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Saturday, 13 January 2018

RACE 1: COOPERS HANDICAP – 1208 metres

GO THE JOURNEY (V. Wong) – rider was spoken to regarding the use of his whip with his arm raised above shoulder height over the concluding stages.

ROCK FORTHE LADIES (D. Yendall) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

COUNTER PULSE (E. Boyd) – approaching the 100 metres was obliged to alter course to the outside of GO THE JOURNEY to obtain clear running.

STRATEGIC DEMAND (R. Clark) – rider spoken to regarding the use of the whip with her arm raised above shoulder height over the concluding stages. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

BATTLE BREWING (C. Lindop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was lame in the near foreleg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 2: KINGSFORD HOTEL THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1108 metres

BAJAN (P. Gatt) – in the vicinity of the 600 metres had to be momentarily steadied off the heels of INSTITUTION and inside the 200 metres shifted in for a number of strides and inconvenienced FEVER. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

INSTITUTION (S. Cahill) – in the vicinity of the 600 metres became awkward on the heels of FEVER and had to be restrained. As a consequence, BAJAN, which was following had to be momentarily steadied. Thereafter in the vicinity of the 500 metres became awkwardly placed inside the heels of THRONES. Rider was questioned regarding the tactics adopted in today's event. Rider explained his instructions provided by Trainer Mr L. Kennewell were to come out negative, attempt to settle the gelding in the early stages and settle mid-field or worse.

RACE 2: KINGSFORD HOTEL THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1108 metres (Cont'd)

He added, in his opinion, on paper, there was more pace in the event than was evident in running and in the circumstances his horse got its head up shortly after the start when being restrained and raced a little ungenerously. He further added that mid-race between the 600 metres and 500 metres he experienced some difficulty when awkwardly placed on the heels of runners, however thereafter, upon straightening when finding clear ground, the gelding quickened well in the early part of the straight and then levelled out on its run. Stewards noted his explanation.

MIGHTY MICK (A. Jordsjo) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Laid in, in the straight. Rider reported the horse shortened its stride in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was lame in the near hind leg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

SHERA KHAN (J. Toeroek) – slow into stride and failed to muster early speed. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FEVER (V. Wong) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Inside the 200 metres was inconvenienced by BAJAN as that horse shifted in and was obliged to alter course.

RACE 3: GOLDIN FARMS HANDICAP - 1508 metres

ANTIPAS (J. Holder) – approaching the 400 metres was inconvenienced by MANHATTAN DESIRE, which shifted out to improve.

PERETTI (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly was lame in the near foreleg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

LORD GREYSON (A. Chan) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MANHATTAN DESIRE (C. Lindop) – approaching the 400 metres shifted out to improve and inconvenienced ANTIPAS.

PEARL RAIDER (E. Boyd) - slow to begin.

RACE 4: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE HANDICAP - 1712 metres

ACE ATTACK (C. Lindop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding suffered post-race colic. First aid administered.

WICKED PROMISE (D. Tourneur) – laid out from inside the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MY BAD (J. Holder) – rider reported the filly felt flat in running and was under pressure for some distance before the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEEK TO DESTROY (C. Caserta) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$700. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for his whip use in the context of the race and the fact that it was a distance race, but also considered his record which was not clean.

DOWNUNDER PRINCE (V. Wong) – struck the barrier stalls on arrival at the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and declared unfit to race owing to an injury to is off hind hamstring. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race. Declared a late scratching by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice at 3.51 pm.

RACE 5: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL HANDICAP - 1108 metres

ICONIC (E. Finnegan) – had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the 400 metres until inside the 100 metres and shortly thereafter inside the 100 metres shifted out slightly, tightening CLASSY JACK.

RACE 5: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL HANDICAP - 1108 metres (Cont'd)

CLASSY JACK (R. Clark) – knuckled at the start. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages between **ICONIC**, which shifted out slightly and **MANDEE**, which shifted in and away from **BLONDE MISSILE**, which rolled in.

VICKI'S BOY (J. Holder) – lost its position at the start.

TRUENO (S. Price) – late scratching by order of Stewards at 7.43 am acting on confirmed advice from a Stable Representative, acting on behalf of Trainer Mr R. Balfour. Stewards considered the circumstances of the late notification and took no further action.

BAITON (K. Bishop) – very awkward to begin, shifted in onto **BLONDE MISSILE** taking that horse onto **VICKI'S BOY**, which lost its position. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAKO COVE (S. Cahill) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BLONDE MISSILE (A. Jordsjo) – taken in slightly at the start by **BAITON**, which shifted in and as a consequence shifted in onto **VICKI'S BOY**. Rolled in inside the 100 metres taking **MANDEE** in.

MANDEE (C. Caserta) – shifted in over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLIP DE GLOIRE (J. Teoroek) – inclined to lay out in the early stages of the event.

BROOKTON ICE (J. Potter) – rider spoken to in regard to the use of his whip over the concluding stages with particular reference to raising his arm above shoulder height on two separate occasions.

RACE 6: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 2112 metres

TUNES (V. Wong) – approaching the 200 metres was obliged to be checked and lost its position when tightened by **OUR YANGTZE** (GB), which shifted out and **MY NIKITA** (NZ), which rolled in marginally. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

OUR YANGTZE (GB) (J. Toeroek) – approaching the 200 metres shifted out to improve and tightened **TUNES** onto **MY NIKITA** (NZ), resulting in **TUNES** having to be checked losing its position. Rider was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 20 January and to conclude at midnight on Friday, 26 January 2018: a period of three meetings. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLYING CASINO (J. Holder) – inside the 800 metres became awkward for several strides when racing between the heels of **CONSTRUCTOR** to its inside and **COOL FONZY** to its outside.

MAJESTIC MOMENT (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MY NIKITA (NZ) (D. Yendall) – rolled in marginally approaching the 200 metres.

ECLAIR FIESTA (FR) (C. Caserta) – laid in, in the straight and shifted in sharply inside the 200 metres.

CONSTRUCTOR (S. Fawke) – lost its off hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: BAROSSA VALLEY SCHILD ESTATE WINES HANDICAP - 1508 metres

KIRONA (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISTA HOLYFIELD (P. Gatt) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay out from in the vicinity of the 600 metres.

FOLK TALES (NZ) (C. Caserta) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RACE 7: BAROSSA VALLEY SCHILD ESTATE WINES HANDICAP - 1508 metres (Cont'd)

ROSELLI STING (T. Pannell) – laid in, in the straight.

DON'T WE LOVE IT (D. Yendall) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEE ME ROLLIN' (J. Potter) – laid out in the straight. Rider found guilty under AR137(b) for failing to ride his mount out over the concluding stages and was fined \$400.

RACE 8: GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY HANDICAP – 1208 metres

AUSSIE JACK (A. Jordsjo) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres was inconvenienced for a number of strides.

INFINITY QUEEN (C. Caserta) – held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 300 metres until inside the 200 metres.

MULLINGER LANE (E. Boyd) – awkward to begin. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in onto ALASKAN JADE, which was inconvenienced and taken in onto AUSSIE JACK, inconveniencing that horse.

MISS CUOCO (J. Holder) – approaching the 400 metres shifted out and brushed with MAKIN' THE GRADE tightening that horse onto TRIUMPHANT ONE. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

ALASKAN JADE (V. Wong) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres was inconvenienced and became unbalanced for several strides. In the vicinity of the 800 metres rolled out and contacted TRIUMPHANT ONE for several strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STREET LIFE (S. Fawke) – laid in, in the straight.

BAKER'S DOZEN (T. Pannell) – awkward to begin and was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 600 metres until approaching the 400 metres and thereafter shifted out into the running line of TRIUMPHANT ONE, which was hampered. As a consequence, TRIUMPHANT ONE rolled in onto MAKIN' THE GRADE, tightening that horse onto MISS CUOCO.

COOL MAVERICK (D. Tourneur) – lost its off hind plate during the event.

TRIUMPHANT ONE (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres rolled in and contacted ALASKAN JADE for several strides. Thereafter approaching the 400 metres, whilst initially shifting about, was obliged to be steadied when hampered by BAKER'S DOZEN, which shifted out to improve and as a consequence rolled in onto MAKIN' THE GRADE tightening that horse onto MISS CUOCO.

MAKIN' THE GRADE (A. Chan) – approaching the 400 metres was tightened between MISS CUOCO, which shifted out and TRIUMPHANT ONE, which rolled in and away from BAKER'S DOZEN as that horse shifted out, had to be checked and was unable to maintain its position. In viewing the incident involving MAKIN' THE GRADE, Stewards could not be satisfied that any one rider was responsible for A. Chan having to check his mount and as a consequence took no action other than to remind all riders involved of their obligations during the running of an event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
