## Vital Signs for Horses at Rest

Temp. 36.5 -38.5 C Heart rate 25-45 beats per min. Breathing 8-16 breaths per min. Capilliary refill time 1-2 sec. Hydration Status (pinch test) 1 - 2 secs.

Clear eyes, normal stance, no nasal discharge
