**STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT**

**Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse**  
**by the Strathalbyn Racing Club on Sunday, 27 May 2018**

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**TRACK:** Soft 5

**WEATHER:** Overcast

**RAIL:** True

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**RACE 1 : AAP VALVES AND FITTINGS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

**CIROC** (T. Pannell) - slow to begin. Raced in restricted room for a number of strides in the vicinity of the 1100 metres and was then inconvenienced when DON'T DOUBT shifted in slightly at the same time as LOVES EDGE rolled out.

**EXALTED CRACKER** (K. Bishop) – kicked by another runner on arrival at the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

**HURRY HOME HARRY** (J. Holder) – held up from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight. Stewards question rider in relation to his riding of the gelding over the concluding 300 metres. After considering his explanation, Stewards took no further action however, advised J. Holder to ride in a manner that did not invite question and to ensure his mounts are fully tested in future. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**KHRUSHCHEV** (K. Crowther) – inconvenienced on jumping away.

**DON'T DOUBT IT** (J. Potter) – taken out on jumping away onto KHRUSHCHEV. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted in slightly onto CIROC. Became awkwardly placed on the heels of REGINA MARGHERITA approaching the finish.

**LOVES EDGE** (J. Huxtable) – rolled out slightly in the vicinity of the 1100 metres onto CIROC.

**REGINA MARGHERITA** (J. Bowditch) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

**ZAVILLA** (R. Hurdle) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto DON'T DOUBT IT. A post-race veterinary examination revealed atrial fibrillation. Trainer advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the filly performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

**RACE 2: DAISH IRRIGATION/ VINIDEX / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

**LIL' CHILLI** (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

**SHUCK** (J. Bowditch) – lost its near fore plate en route to the barriers. Required Farrier attention on arrival at the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

**RACE 2: DAISH IRRIGATION/ VINIDEX / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres (Cont'd)**

**ANNIFRID** (K. Crowther) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 800 metres when LITTLE MINKIA shifted in slightly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

**BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS** (T. Pannell) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

**GOOD NIC** (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**LITTLE MINKIA** (R. Clark) – difficult to load. Trainer advised a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to it proving difficult to load. Jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 800 metres improved onto the heels of BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS and shifted out. Shortly thereafter shifted back in to its original position onto ANNIFRID, which was inconvenienced. Rider reprimanded and advised in future to make an assessment prior to shifting ground.

**RACE 3: TEAM POLY / SABOIS + MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE - 2050 metres**

**EXALTED CRAFTSMAN** (T. Pannell) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 600 metres to the 400 metres. Became held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until inside the 300 metres.

**EXALTED JENNI** (R. Clark) – Trainer advised the mare was lame in the near foreleg and would be unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared the mare a late scratching at 8.50 am.

**HEZ A WOLF** (J. Huxtable) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

**FIBBERS (NZ)** (J. Bowditch) – rider reported the filly was reluctant racing between other runners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**EVERY BREATH** (E. Boyd) –raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**LA LA LUCHIE** (C. Lindop) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

**MEADOWS LASSIE** (K. Crowther) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

**RACE 4: ADELAIDE BELT AND HOSE CLASS ONE HANDICAP – 1100 metres**

**INNUENDO** (D. McWhinney) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**PARTY SET** (K. Lau) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

**RACE 5: GRUNDFOS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres**

**HE'S A VALLEYBOY** (J. Holder) – slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GOOD IDEA** (D. Caboche) – laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

**INDIAN MO** (R. Hurdle) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

**STACEY DEE** (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 6: PHILMAC BM 60 HANDICAP (Apprentice riders only) – 1200 metres**

**RAHEEBA** (J. Huxtable) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**REDEEKA** (G. Lo) – laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 6: PHILMAC BM 60 HANDICAP (Apprentice riders only) – 1200 metres (Cont'd)**

**JUST MAK** (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in throughout the event.

**ALERTNESS** (C. Collins) - slow to begin.

**RACE 7: ORANGE PUMPS / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

**BLONDE MISSILE** (J. Huxtable) – inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres when taken in slightly by MINT COLLECTOR onto the heels of PANDEIA.

**MIKAELA** (K. Bishop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**PANDEIA** (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly.

**FABULOUS FLIPPER** (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course which revealed the mare had swelling to its off foreleg and would be unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared FABULOUS FLIPPER a late scratching at 2.33 pm.

**MINT COLLECTOR** (A. Chan) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted in slightly onto BLONDE MISSILE.

**RACE 8: DAVEY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1350 metres**

**TAHNEE TIARA** (C. Collins) – held up from the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight.

**SIMPATICO** (J. Potter) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

**YOUBETCHA** (C. Lindop) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

**CRIES OF JOY** (J. Huxtable) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed tying up in the hindquarters. First aid administered.

**ATARARTZI** (D. McWhinney) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

**JARRVIS** (K. Lau) - jumped away awkwardly.

**MORCHOWIE MISS** (R. Clark) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
