RACE 1: JB RADIATORS & WINDSCREEN SERVICE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

MYSTICAN (R. Hurdle) – laid out rounding the home turn.

LONG STREAKA (S. Fawke) – began awkwardly, shifted in and was slow into stride. Rider reported he placed his mount under pressure shortly after jumping away and was disappointed with its effort throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr J. Hickmott was advised a warning would be placed on the gelding.

LOOK ABOUT (K. Bishop) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

AMBIDEE (J. Maund) – began awkwardly and shifted out at the start.

CALYPSO CLASSIC (A. Chan) – raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: MAX CRANES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1396 metres

MAPLE'S IMAGE (R. Hurdle) – laid out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROBBERY (J. Potter) - slow to begin. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

DOUG'S JOURNEY (G. Lo) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be restrained after improving onto the heels of SHE'S RENELDASGIRL.

IT'S MYSTIC (A. Chan) – laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 50 metres had to be restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SHE'S RENELDASGIRL.

TURF MAN (S. Fawke) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres shifted out abruptly when insufficiently clear of IT'S PRIMROSE. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 23 June 2018 and to conclude at midnight on Sunday, 1 July 2018: a period of four meetings.

HANNAHWIN (E. Boyd) - began awkwardly.

IT'S PRIMROSE (D. McWhinney) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of SHE'S THE MASTER. In the vicinity of the 500 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of TURF MAN, which shifted out when insufficiently clear.

RACE 2: MAX CRANES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1396 metres (Cont'd)

SHE'S THE MASTER (J. Maund) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres laid in despite the efforts of its rider, hampering IT'S PRIMROSE.

RACE 3: MILHINCH HOURGLASS JEWELLERS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

WALKABOUTCREEK (J. Potter) – rider reported his mount felt awkward in its action in the vicinity of the 500 metres and as a result elected not to place his mount under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. First aid administered. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

SAINT VALENTINE (A. Chan) – awkward to begin. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RACE 4: BILRIL ELECTRICAL & DARREN BONETTI RACING BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ROSIE LOUISE (J. Maund) – hampered on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. Rider reported his mount failed to respond to his riding throughout the race and finished the race off disappointingly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr W. Bencic was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

AY OH WHEY OH (E. Boyd) – shifted out on jumping away.

RACE 5: OFFICE NATIONAL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1867 metres

EIGELSTEIN (GB) (D. Morgan) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

OVERSTREET (J. Maund) – when questioned regarding the performance of the gelding, rider stated his mount began to weaken in the vicinity of the 600 metres and finished the race off disappointingly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DYLAN JACK (J. Potter) – laid out rounding the turn.

UNDOUBTABLE (K. Bishop) - slow to begin. Rider stated her mount began to weaken in the vicinity of the 600 metres and finished the race off disappointingly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MOSHIRE (K. Crowther) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

AMINO (NZ) (P. Crich) - slow to begin. Rider reported his mount failed to travel throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: SPRINGBETTS DELIVERIES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP- 1396 metres

TAMARA MARIE (A. Chan) – held up for clear running on entering the straight in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

MANTILLA (J. Maund) – began awkwardly throwing its head in the air for a number of strides. Failed to travel at any stage of the race. Rider reported in his opinion, MANTILLA may have resented the application of the tongue-tie. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: DATGAW SERVICES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

STREETHAVENONAME (R. Clark) – awkward to begin shifted in contacting KING'S SPIRIT.

KING'S SPIRIT (A. Chan) – hampered on jumping away.

INWARD BOUND (NZ) (W. Cave) - slow to begin.
