Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 30 June 2018

RACE 1: HUGHES LIMOUSINES HANDICAP - 2600 metres

RED ALTO (A. Chan) – inclined to lay in in the middle stages of the event.

GLORIOUS SINNDAR (FR) (J. Allen) – difficulty obtaining clear ground in the straight.

ANCIENT KING (IRE) (J. Bowditch) – rider explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, had failed to let down when placed under pressure inside the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUEDOUTES (P. Gat) – Trainer advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to it being uncompetitive in metropolitan events.

RACE 2: UBET TWO-YEARS-OLD PLATE – 1100 metres

ASSERTIVE PLAY (D. Tourneur) – laid in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off hind leg and minor laceration to the off hind pastern. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

TOOLBAR (J. Allen) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 300 metres. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

EXALTED TRAIL (T. Pannell) – laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIZZLING AFFAIR (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

EXALTED MAXINE (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: FOUR-TIME G1 WINNER SEPOY STANDING AT DARLEY IN VICTORIA HANDICAP
- 1800 metres

IS DON IS GOOD (D. Tourneur) – rider explained the gelding had made excessive respiratory noise on pulling up and in his opinion may have chocked down. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TURNPIKE (A. Jordsjo) – Stewards questioned rider into her riding of the gelding in particular from the vicinity of the 1100 metres. Rider explained her instructions were to be positive from the barriers and to make one long sustained run from the vicinity of the 1000 metres, with the intention to obtain a five length lead on the remainder of the field by the 600 metres, due to the gelding being one paced, however, she was unable to do so due to the positioning of LITTLEBITFUNNY. She added the gelding raced flat when compared to its previous start and in her opinion, would be better suited on a softer track. Trainer Mr D. Saxon confirmed the instructions provided to A. Jordsjo. A post-race veterinary examination revealed poorer than expected post-race respiratory recovery with slightly injected oral mucus membranes.

GORILLE (T. Pannell) – contacted on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MUSSOORIE MAGIC (J. Allen) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto GORILLE. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

LITTLEBITFUNNY (R. Clark) – contacted on jumping away. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event when racing to the inside of TURNPIKE.

ASHADY HUSSY (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto LITTLEBITFUNNY.

RACE 4: IRISH RACE DAY - 1ST SEPTEMBER AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1050 metres

SOVEREIGN DUKE (R. Clark) – shifted in on jumping away contacting ANAMNESIS. Rider reported her instructions were to obtain a position on pace however, after jumping well the gelding had not travelled as she had anticipated and was unable to settle closer despite her efforts.

STREETCAR ILLUSION (K. Crowther) – laid in under pressure in the straight and inside the 100 metres shifted in onto ANAMNESIS.

EVIL DREAMS (E. Boyd) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEE ME ROLLIN' (J. Potter) – inside the 100 metres shifted out and away from ASHERO onto ANAMNESIS.

AADELAD (J. Kah) – dipped on jumping away.

MYSTICANO (T. Pannell) – held up from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 200 metres and then again over the concluding 50 metres.

ANAMNESIS (A. Chan) – contacted on jumping away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inside the 100 metres lost its position when taken out by SEE ME ROLLIN' onto STREETCAR ILLUSION, which shifted in slightly.

RACE 5: 13CABS THREE-YEAR-OLD PLATE - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes.

MODULATE (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 200 metres shifted out and bumped OH MO, which shifted in. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was inconvenienced and had its hindquarters turned when contacted by OH MO, which had been taken in by DANGER DEAL.

RACE 5: 13CABS THREE-YEAR-OLD PLATE - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

PURRFECT KISSES (K. Crowther) – shifted out shortly after the start onto EXALTED LAURETTA. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANGER DEAL (R. Clark) – laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in onto OH MO, which was tightened onto MODULATE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

MOUNT HOREB (J. Allen) – laid in over the concluding 600 metres.

BOOMER BEACH (T. Pannell) – lost its position shortly after the start when tightened between MODULATE and OH MO. Laid in over the concluding 300 metres.

OH MO (S. Fawke) – taken out shortly after the start by EXALTED LAURETTA onto BOOMER BEACH. Approaching the 200 metres shifted in and bumped MODULATE, which shifted out. Inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 200 metres when DANGER DEAL shifted in.

BAJAN (J. Kah) – rider reported that when being eased in the vicinity of the 600 metres the gelding locked its jaw and shifted out abruptly. Held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the finish and was untested to the line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TRIPLE DEEZ (R. Hurdle) – raced in restricted room between the 700 metres and 500 metres. Held up from the vicinity of the 300 metres until near the 150 metres.

EXALTED LAURETTA (D. Tourneur) – taken out onto OH MO shortly after the start by PURRFECT KISSES.

SUPER HUSSEY (E. Boyd) – had to be steadied at the entrance to the straight when FLOP shifted out.

FOIE GRAS (J. Holder) – slow to begin. Laid in, in the early stages of the event. Rider reported the filly was reluctant to stretch out in the early and middle stages despite his efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected heart rate.

FLOP (J. Bowditch) - jumped away awkwardly. At the entrance to the straight shifted out onto SUPER HUSSEY, which had to be steadied. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a).

ZAGATO STAR (H. Coffey) – fractious in its barrier after being loaded damaging the front partition of the barriers. As a result all runners to the outside of ZAGATO STAR had to be backed out and reloaded one barrier wider. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.

RACE 6: FLEURIEU MILK HANDICAP - 2000 metres

TEMPS VOLEUR (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXCITES ZELADY (P. Gatt) – trainer advised that he would instruct the rider to attempt to settle further back with cover if possible, in an attempt to have the gelding run out the race.

BEAU'S MY BOY (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

IGITUR (J. Bowditch) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Rounding the home turn shifted in slightly and brushed SILVERA, which was commencing to shift out.

EXALTED HONEY (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

RACE 7: METAL-LINK HANDICAP - 1600 metres

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 7: METAL-LINK HANDICAP - 1600 metres (Cont'd)

CREANCE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly.

POLAR VORTEX (S. Fawke) - slow to begin. Had to be steadied approaching the 200 metres to avoid the heels of **STEEL PRINCE** (IRE), which shifted in and away from **LUCKY WICK**.

RAT WITH GOLDTOOTH (J. Potter) –raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BEAU RIVAGE (A. Chan) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: SEE THE MAGIC OF MATT TARRANT AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ARTIE DEE TWO (J. Allen) - slow to begin.

VIEIRA (A. Chan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

HARD EMPIRE (K. Crowther) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COUNTER SPIN (R. Clark) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LAST WITNESS (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

RUPTURE (P. Gatt) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

JUST RESTING (A. Jordsjo) – rider reported she was concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.
