RACE 1: UBET HANDICAP - 1000 metres

DANCER'S KIN (K. Crowther) – inclined to lay out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the finish.

HEAVEN'S DEAL (G. Cartwright) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THINE IS THE POWER (J. Kah) – slow to begin.

BLACK CHAMPAGNE (C. Caserta) – late scratching at 12.33 pm acting on a report by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon that the filly had exacerbated an old injury to the near foreleg and would be unfit to race. Trainer, Mr T. McEvoy, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RACE 2: THIRSTY CAMEL CUP LAWN PARTY- DEC 21 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP – 1400 metres

ARTFUL RAMBLER (A. Chan) – shortly after the start shifted out and inconvenienced TARANTINO (NZ).

SKILLFUL STEPS (P. Gatt) – in the vicinity of the 150 metres rolled in and inconvenienced STRYKER FORTUNE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TARANTINO (NZ) (C. Caserta) – difficult to load. Trainer, Mr S. Cahill was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding. Slow into stride. Shortly after the start was inconvenienced as ARTFUL RAMBLER shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRYKER FORTUNE (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly and wide in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 150 metres was inconvenienced when SKILLFUL STEPS rolled in.

RACE 3: FLASHDANCE, THE CHRISTMAS SHOW - DEC 8 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP – 1250 metres

USTINOV'S FURY (C. Caserta) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding never travelled during the event, was inclined to lay out from rounding the home turn until the finish, and he was concerned with USTINOV'S FURY's action in the straight and for this reason did not ride the gelding out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COUNTER PULSE (E. Boyd) – dipped shortly after the start.

PORT VALE (O. Ridge) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VIEIRA (G. Cartwright) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 800 metres elected to roll forward to take the lead.

SOARING HIGH (A. Chan) – jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

SIZZLING BULLET (J. Holder) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

LIVE FAST (E. Finnegan) – help up for a short distance near the 300 metres.

RACE 4: MEDALLION HOMES HANDICAP - 2250 metres

SHIMRANO (GER) (A. Jordsjo) – raced wide from in the vicinity of the 1100 metres. Laid in for a short distance in the vicinity of the 700 metres.

THE STATESMAN (GB) (C. Caserta) – approaching the 400 metres, when racing in restricted room between AZURO (FR) and TROPICAL LIGHTNING, clipped heels and dipped. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VALAC (IRE) (J. Kah) – rider explained that her instructions were to be positive in the event but not to lead. She added that after being caught wide early she elected to roll forward to take up a position in the lead.

DUQUESSA (E. Boyd) – required to be re-shod in the parade ring as it had misplaced its near fore shoe. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start.

ROCK ON IVY (NZ) (E. Finnegan) – hung out rounding the home turn until the finish.

RACE 5: AAMI SPRING CARNIVAL OCT 20 - NOV 6 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1550 metres

HEPTAGON (NZ) (J. Kah) – rider explained that in her opinion the gelding would appreciate a race with more pace in it. She added that HEPTAGON (NZ), when placed under pressure, failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUSK FALLS (IRE) (H. Coffey) – prior to the event stable representative advised that they would instruct their rider to attempt to be more positive in the event and settle forward of midfield. Jumped away awkwardly. Weakened from in the vicinity of the 500 metres. Rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's poor performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PERUGGIA (C. Caserta) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPECIAL DIVA (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up for a short distance in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

AWAKE IN GRINZING (NZ) (A. Chan) – slow to begin. Trainer, Ms K. Byrnes, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

RACE 6: TWILIGHT RACES - DEC 14 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

FRENCH ROCK (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARROW LANE (G. Cartwright) – rider dislodged en route to the barriers. G. Cartwright was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to ride. Became fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew ARROW LANE at 4.49 pm. Trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, was advised that the gelding is now required to complete an Official Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to accepting for a future race.

ICELANDIC STAR (A. Jordsjo) – rider dislodged en route to the barriers, was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to ride. Rolled in, in the vicinity of the 50 metres onto ATOMIC LOKADE, which was obliged to be steadied for several strides. Rider reminded of her obligations to keep her mounts straight in the finish.

MISS LABELLE (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly.

ATOMIC LOKADE (A. Chan) – inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 50 metres was obliged to be steadied for several strides as MISS LABELLE rolled in. As a result ATOMIC LOKADE was untested to the line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JUST LIKE HEAVEN (D. Tourneur) – laid in throughout the event.

RACE 7: ROMEO'S FAMILY RACE DAY - OCT 13 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1250 metres

LOVE CLUB (A. Chan) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung out under pressure in the straight.

MR HAMILTON (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped IT'S A MYTH.

IRON MAX (E. Finnegan) – slow to begin. Rider reported that she had become concerned with the gelding's action from in the vicinity of the 500 metres and therefore elected not to ride the gelding out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWIPE ME RIGHT (D. Tourneur) – laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BOOMER BEACH (G. Cartwright) – slow to begin.

IT'S A MYTH (K. Crowther) – bumped on jumping away as MR HAMILTON jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was obliged to alter course to the inside of LOVE CLUB, which hung out.

Race 7 – COOL MAVERICK, MR HAMILTON, BALLINACLASH, BOOMER BEACH.
