RACE 1: BUTTERFIELD FARM DIRECT HORSE FEEDS / SABOIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

BARB WIRE (R. Hurdle) – rider reported that his mount raced greenly throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

FLYING LOCO (S. Fawke) – slow to begin. Rider reported that his mount was under pressure throughout the event and finished the race off in a disappointing manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr T. Haddy, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding regarding its competitiveness.

TAJAVEDO (D. Caboche) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres had to be restrained after improving onto the heels of BEDLOE'S ISLAND. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was momentarily inconvenienced and obliged to shift wider to avoid the heels of BEDLOE'S ISLAND, which shifted in under pressure.

ANASTASIA SKILL (A. Lindsay) – raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BEDLOE'S ISLAND (J. Toeroek) – laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

LOVE ME HARDER (B. Sweeney) – laid out from the vicinity of the 500 metres until inside the straight.

RACE 2: BRIAN HARVEY AGENCIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

HARDASHIAN (B. Sweeney) – rider reported that his mount raced fiercely throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 800 metres shifted in despite the efforts of its rider contacting SHEZA PROPHET.

IKOHOLIC (K. Lau) – shifted in on jumping away contacting CLAREFELILLI. Momentarily inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 1000 metres when INVINCIBLE SUSHI shifted in abruptly.

WICKED KID (A. Chan) – reared behind the barriers and contacting its rider. A. Chan was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil his remaining engagements. WICKED KID was a late scratching at 2.22 pm. Trainer, Mr R. King, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its pre-race manners.

RACE 2: BRIAN HARVEY AGENCIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres (Cont'd)

GREENSBAY (G. Lo) – fractious in the barriers and became cast. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice GREENSBAY was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.20 pm. Trainer, Mr D. Carrison, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race. He was further advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

INVINCIBLE SUSHI (J. Toeroek) – shifted in abruptly in the vicinity of the 1000 metres momentarily inconveniencing IKOHOLIC. Raced greenly throughout the event.

SHEZA PROPHET (D. Caboche) – fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start. In the vicinity of the 800 metres was momentarily inconvenienced after HARDASHIAN shifted in. Laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until entering the home straight. Rider reported that his mount felt awkward in its action when placed under pressure and as a result he elected not to place SHEZA PROPHET under further pressure over the concluding stage. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CLAREFELILLI (K. Crowther) – shifted out on jumping away contacting IKOHOLIC.

JUST KAUTO (J. Maund) – fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice JUST KAUTO was a late scratching at 2.20 pm. Trainer, Mr P. Holtham, was advised that JUST KAUTO was required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump out prior to a future race start.

RACE 3: TUNARAMA COACHLINES CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1210 metres

GLOSSY GANODERMA (J. Maund) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres was taken in onto LONBERG by PUZZLIST, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

LONBERG (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of GLOSSY GANODERMA, which was taken in by PUZZLIST, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Over-raced for the remainder of the event. Momentarily inconvenienced on entering the straight when avoid the heels of DELAGO EDITION, which was weakening. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOTTABITON (S. Fawke) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

PUZZLIST (A. Lindsay) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of GLOSSY GANODERMA, which was taken in onto LONBERG, which was severely hampered. Rider severely reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding.

RACE 4: LOCAL LIQUID BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

INVINCIBLE ME (K. Lau) – laid out from the vicinity of the 400 metres. Continued to lay out in the straight.

LASANTA (S. Fawke) – laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres. Ran wide on entering the straight and continued to lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

KOODA STAR (D. Caboche) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

APOLLO HOPE (K. Bishop) – inconvenienced on jumping away after contacting the inside partition of the barriers.

RACE 5: LIBERTY RURAL PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1210 metres

LOCKS WELL (B. Sweeney) – rider reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out to the finish of the event.

RACE 5: LIBERTY RURAL PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1210 metres (Cont'd)

PENULTIMATE STAR (J. Toeroek) – rider reported that his mount felt awkward in its action on entering the home straight and as a result he elected not to place PENULTIMATE STAR under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KAILUA (S. Fawke) – in the vicinity of the 600 metres became awkward in its action and dipped when attempting to shift around the heels of SLIDE OF HAND. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TOUCH OF BELLA (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 700 metres had to be restrained when it improved onto the heels of KAILUA. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be mildly colic post-race. First aid administered.

ASH ROAD (D. Caboche) – slow to begin.

JUST PAST MIDNIGHT (A. Lindsay) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out on entering the straight and ran wider on the track.

RACE 6: GRAHAM BACCHUS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

EMOJI (R. Clark) – began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance of EMOJI, rider reported she was pleased with its effort but in her opinion, would be better suited over greater distances. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EYE THE WORLD (A. Lindsay) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

VINTAGE GROVE (G. Lo) – began awkwardly, shifted out and contacting GALAXY FALLS.

GALAXY FALLS (R. Hurdle) – contacted on jumping away by VINTAGE GROVE, which shifted out.

ONWARD (S. Fawke) – momentarily inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 100 metres by HETUKA ZARSHO, which sifted in when insufficiently clear.

HETUKA ZARSHO (D. Caboche) – laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of ONWARD. Rider was severely reprimanded.

RACE 7: 2018 RMHC RIDE FOR SICK KIDS / LINCOLN TO ADELAIDE BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

HANK'S NEPHEW (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of DEXTER YOU DEVIL. Rider was severely reprimanded. When questioned regarding the tactics adopted on HANK'S NEPHEW, rider reported he was instructed to attempt to find cover on his mount. He added that the gelding began extremely well, over-raced in the early stages and rather than restrain his mount in an attempt to find cover, elected to ride his mount where comfortable.

STONECAST (D. Caboche) – began awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of VICTOR VICTOR, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

NEVA DOUBT US (K. Crowther) - began awkwardly.

TOLSTOY (S. Fawke) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

DEXTER YOU DEVIL (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of HANK'S NEPHEW, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Rider was severely reprimanded.

VICTOR VICTOR (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of STONECAST. Rider was severely reprimanded.
