STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 20 October 2018

TRACK: Good 4

RAIL: Out 9 metres 1200 metres to winning post, sectional 612 metres

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: LAUGHING JACK WINES TWO-YEAR-OLD PLATE - 1000 metres

SEBRAKATE (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

POWER SCHEME (J. Kah) – dislodged its rider on return to the mounting yard and galloped riderless for a short distance prior to being recaptured. J. Kah was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

RACE 2: UBET MAIDEN PLATE – 1050 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

EQUIMOORE (F. Kersley) – laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 50 metres was taken wider by ZAGATO STAR, which had been taken out.

EUROGLIDER (J. Kah) – laid in under pressure in the straight. Momentarily lost the use of her off side rein in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

PAPALET (P. Gatt) – taken in on jumping away onto REGINA MARGHERITA. Lost its near hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REGINA MARGHERITA (D. Tourneur) – lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto RIZSKI by PAPALET. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YANKEE LOU (J. Toeroek) – reared on jumping away and was awkward into stride. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when SAPPHIRE MISS shifted in and then had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance.

ZAGATO STAR (T. Pannell) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 50 metres when taken wider by SAPPHIRE MISS.

GOTTA BE GOLD (R. Clark) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

PAM'S JOURNEY (G. Cartwright) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SAPPHIRE MISS (L. Riordan) – shifted in on jumping away onto PAPALET. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Held up for a short distance at the entrance to the straight. Laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in onto YANKEE LOU, and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto the heels of EUROGLIDER as it improved, and in being corrected shifted out onto ZAGATO STAR.

RACE 3: OKTOBERFEST BY BAROSSA FINE FOODS MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres

BLAZING ROW (L. Riordan) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that he had become concerned with the gelding over the concluding 100 metres as it commenced to weaken rapidly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BUSKER'S BALLAD (F. Kersley) – slow to begin.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly.

ALIRIS (E. Boyd) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIGHTING DRAGON (J. Kah) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting GOOD TIME MADAM.

FREE HAND (P. Gatt) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

IT'S MAGIC (J. Toeroek) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GOOD TIME MADAM (G. Cartwright) – contacted on jumping away.

HAVANA HEAT (K. Crowther) – laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: AAMI YOUNGCARE GRANTS HANDICAP - 2600 metres

TROPICAL LIGHTNING (E. Finnegan) – rider reported that she had become concerned with the gelding's action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr T. Doudle, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

WICKED RHYTHM (G. Cartwright) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 5: DARLEY HANDICAP - 2035 metres

DOCKER PAV (N. Farley) – laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in and contacted AMBISHOP. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AMBISHOP (E. Finnegan) – inconvenienced and had its hindquarters turned in the vicinity of the 300 metres when contacted by DOCKER PAV.

ANURADHA (F. Kersley) – hung out rounding the home turn and was reluctant to race for the remainder of the event. Rider explained that the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event but rounding the home turn had commenced to hang out and had become awkward in its action and was reluctant to stretch out despite his efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: AAMI REBEL RAIDER SERIES FINAL - 1200 metres

GYTRASH (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 600 metres rolled out and brushed ORBOST. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DANCER'S KIN (K. Crowther) – stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WRECKING CREW (T. Pannell) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

ORBOST (J. Kah) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 600 metres when contacted by GYTRASH and taken wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: AAMI REBEL RAIDER SERIES FINAL - 1200 metres (cont'd)

TONGSAI BOSS (C. Caserta) – slow to begin.

HUSSLIN HUMPH (F. Kersley) – laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: HIT107 HANDICAP – 1200 metres

ARTFUL RAMBLER (A. Chan) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

COLUMBIA (T. Pannell) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

TRIPLE DEEZ (J. Toeroek) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

PRICKLES (J. Holder) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr L. Kennewell, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 8: SO BRAVE BREAST CANCER AWARENESS HANDICAP – 1050 metres

COCKLES (R. Clark) – inside the 200 metres had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance when awkwardly placed on the heels of ATLANTICA, which had commenced to give ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ATLANTICA (A. Chan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JACKPOT JOHNNY (T. Pannell) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 100 metres.

SCOTTISH ROGUE (C. Caserta) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider explained that the gelding was off the bit throughout the event, which in his opinion was due to the fast tempo of the event. He added that he had difficulty obtaining clear ground at the entrance to the straight, but from the vicinity of the 150 metres SCOTTISH ROGUE failed to improve as he had anticipated when he was able to obtain clear running. He further added that in his opinion the gelding will be better suited over a longer distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: MJS FLOORCOVERINGS HANDICAP – 1600 metres

GALAXY GAZER (R. Clark) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

WITH A BIT OF DASH (G. Cartwright) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 1200 metres when UNSCOPEABLE was taken in.

CHAPAL (J. Holder) – became held up at the entrance to the straight and then had difficulty obtaining clear ground until inside the 100 metres.

DOUBLE THE MAGIC (C. Caserta) – slow to begin.

UNSCOPEABLE (J. Toeroek) – contacted on jumping away. Inconvenienced when taken in onto WITH A BIT OF DASH in the vicinity of the 1200 metres by SWEET KAISER.

VALLEY OF LIGHT (GB) (T. Pannell) – reared on jumping away and slow into stride.

WYLIE OL' COYOTE (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding had been a touch slower to begin than she had expected, and for this reason she found herself further back than anticipated.

RACE 9: MJS FLOORCOVERINGS HANDICAP – 1600 metres (cont'd)

ONCE IN A LIFETIME (J. Kah) – shifted in on jumping away onto UNSCOPEABLE. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance after entering the straight. Rider reported that when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 300 metres the filly failed to let down as she had anticipated and was disappointing to the line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr T. McEvoy, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

SWEET KAISER (A. Chan) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres shifted in onto UNSCOPEABLE, which was inconvenienced when taken in onto WITH A BIT OF DASH. Rider reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Stewards to view the vision of the start.
