RACE 1: NRC AGM 30TH OCTOBER 2018 / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 meters

TARDAVAUX (P. Marks) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced in over twelve months and was passed fit to start. In the vicinity of the 800 metres bumped by MANHATTAN MANNERS, which rolled in.

MANHATTAN MANNERS (S. Fawke) – inside the 800 metres rolled in and bumped TARDAVAUX.

PELLINA (K. Crowther) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced in over twelve months and was passed fit to start.

ZEMLYA (G. Lo) – taken wider in the vicinity of the 300 metres by JULINDUR, which laid out.

JULINDUR (A. Chan) – raced greenly throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 300 metres laid out taking ZEMLYA wider.

RACE 2: SOUTH EAST SADDLERY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1430 meters

BIANZEDA (S. Fawke) – late scratching at 8.20 am on confirmed advice that the gelding had a foot abscess and would be unfit to race.

SECRET BAR (K. Bishop) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: FINNS FINE FOODS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

CADWIL KID (P. Marks) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced in nearly twelve months and was passed fit to start.

LITTLE CRACKLES (G. Lo) – jumped away awkwardly contacting CASINO MAGIC, which shifted out. Shortly thereafter shifted out and away from CASINO MAGIC. In the vicinity of the 400 metres contacted by CASINO MAGIC, which shifted in abruptly.

NETRA'S BOY (A. Chan) – rider explained that the gelding travelled fairly throughout the event but was reluctant to improve between runners and finished the event off only fairly. He added that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited over longer distances.

CASINO MAGIC (E. Finnegan) – shifted out on jumping away contacting LITTLE CRACKLES. In the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted in abruptly contacting LITTLE CRACKLES.

RACE 3: FINNS FINE FOODS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres (cont'd)

SADUKA (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 800 was obliged to be restrained when it improved onto the heels of CADWIL KID.

RACE 4: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

CREANCE (T. Pannell) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 1500 metres inconvenienced and taken wider by ALLABOUTATTITUDE, which rolled out. Rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the race; however, failed to respond to his riding from the vicinity of the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALLABOUTATTITUDE (P. Marks) – in the vicinity of the 1500 metres rolled out and inconvenienced CREANCE.

I'M BULLETPROOF (D. Tournour) – inside the 1500 metres was obliged to be steadied when it improved onto the heels of QUEEN'S PALACE.

TOMMY GUN (S. Fawke) – slow into stride.

RACE 5: MINI JUMBUK BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

BEEOKAY (T. Pannell) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres rolled in contacting MONTRE. Rider explained that despite racing three wide throughout the event the gelding travelled well; however, did not let down over the final 200 metres as he had anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AKERBOY (E. Finnegan) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.

PHAR LINK (S. Fawke) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out from the 500 metres until the finish. In the vicinity of the 400 metres when racing in restricted room, laid out across the heels of MONTRE. Rider reported the gelding laid out rounding the home turn and finished the race of well when able to obtain clear ground in the straight.

MONTRE (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres raced in restricted room to the inside of BEEOKAY and to the outside of PHAR LINK, which laid out. Approaching the 200 metres was disappointed for a run between PANDEIA and BEEOKAY, which shifted in, and was unable to be fully tested to the finish.

RACE 6: HAPPY BIRTHDAY DANIEL MENZEL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

EXALTED LAURETTA (T. Pannell) – laid out under pressure from the 200 metres and approaching the 100 metres shifted out taking JACKTHEGIANTSLEYER wider on the track, resulting in JACKTHEGIANTSLEYER racing in restricted room from inside the 100 metres. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to correct his mounts sooner when they commence to shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIRST REWARD (K. Crowther) – laid out throughout the event. Inside the 100 metres shifted in after being corrected tightening JACKTHEGIANTSLEYER onto EXALTED LAURETTA. Rider reminded of her obligations when her mounts commence to shift ground.

JACKTHEGIANTSLEYER (A. Chan) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped HASTA LA BOUNTY. Approaching the 100 metres was taken wider by EXALTED LAURETTA, which shifted out. Inside the 100 metres was tightened and obliged to be taken hold of when racing in restricted room between EXALTED LAURETTA, which continued to shift out, and FIRST REWARD, which shifted in. As a result, JACKTHEGIANTSLEYER was unable to be fully tested until the finish of the race.

HASTA LA BOUNTY (G. Lo) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped JACKTHEGIANTSLEYER.

RACE 6: HAPPY BIRTHDAY DANIEL MENZEL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2000 metres
(cont'd)

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow A. Chan (JACKTHEGIANTSLAYER), placed fourth, and trainer, Mr G. Karayannis, to view the official vision. After doing so A. Chan lodged an objection against FIRST REWARD (K. Crowther) being placed first, and EXALTED LAURETTA (T. Pannell) being placed second on the grounds of alleged interference from the vicinity of the 100 metres until the finish. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* both objections.

RACE 7: CHANTLER HORSE BREAKING & PRE TRAINING BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1430 metres

GRAND ARMADA (G. Lo) – laid out in the straight.

CRYSTAL GLASS (T. Pannell) – stood-flat footed and was slow to begin. Trainer, Mrs S. Jaensch, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare.

FORCE OF THREE (D. Tourneur) – in the vicinity of the 300 metres raced in restricted for a short distance between GRAND ARMADA and SQUADRON LEADER, which rolled in.

SIR CHARLESTON (NZ) – late scratching at 3.02 pm as no rider was available.

COOLIDGE (A. Chan) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

KINGSGROVE – late scratching at 3.02 pm as no rider was available.

SQUADRON LEADER (P. Marks) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.
