STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 27 October 2018

TRACK: Good 4 (*Upgraded to a Good 3 @ 3.24 pm retrospective to Race 5*)

RAIL: Out 3 metres entire. Sectional 604 metres

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: THIRSTY CAMEL CUP LAWN PARTY DEC 21 AT MORPHETTVILLE MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 metres

WOKIT (T. Pannell) – rider reported the gelding made respiratory noises on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROYAL RING (R. Clark) – was inclined to lay in from in the vicinity of the 500 metres.

SIZZLING AFFAIR (K. Crowther) – laid out from approaching the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: MYPUNTER.COM HANDICAP – 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

CORE BREACH (P. Gatt) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced since June 2017 and passed fit to race. Raced very keenly in the early stages and laid both ways in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I'M A PRINCESS (J. Kah) – proved a little fractious in its barrier stall prior to the gates being released and as a consequence was slow to begin.

MYSTIFIED (T. Pannell) – had its hindquarters turned in the vicinity of the 700 metres when being contacted by THOMPSON'S REWARD, which rolled out and thereafter near the 400 metres, was again contacted by that gelding and had its hindquarters turned.

CERTAIN ELLIE (D. Tourneur) – became very awkward in its action and unbalanced approaching the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THOMPSON'S REWARD (K. Crowther) – rolled out in the vicinity of the 700 metres contacted the hindquarters of MYSTIFIED and thereafter near the 400 metres rolled out again and contacted the hindquarters of MYSTIFIED. Rider reported the gelding failed to let down and was disappointing in its performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: AAMI HANDICAP – 1000 metres

DANCER'S KIN (D. Caboche) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NO JOY (K. Crowther) – hampered and taken wider at the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near hind leg. Co-Trainers advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 3: AAMI HANDICAP – 1000 metres (Cont'd)

YANKEE EYES (J. Kah) – very awkward to begin, shifted out and hampered NO JOY, which was taken wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: FILLY AND FOX FUNDRAISER HANDICAP - 1950 metres

ROSELLI STING (L. Riordan) – laid in, in the straight.

DAKTARI (R. Clark) – tightened near the 500 metres.

MACROBIUS (F. Kersley) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 500 metres was taken in by PAMANDO, which laid in and was tightened onto DAKTARI. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OH SO UNFAIR (J. Maund) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Approaching the 500 metres became very awkward on the heels of SWEET KAISER as that horse had to be checked and lost its position and as a consequence was severely hampered. Thereafter approaching the 200 metres when attempting a run to the inside of MACROBIUS was obliged to alter course to that horses outside as that horse shifted in to improve. Thereafter had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance near the 100 metres. Rider was questioned regarding his riding of this gelding, with particular reference to his riding in the early part of the straight. He explained that after suffering interference near the 500 metres he had become concerned with the horse as it lost its action and also held concern that the horse may have been galloped on and for that reason, he allowed the gelding to find its stride in its own time. He further added that after electing for a run to the inside of MACROBIUS near the 200 metres, he was obliged to improve to that horses outside as it shifted in. Thereafter he had difficulty obtaining clear running and when obtaining a clear run, the race had been run. Stewards advised J. Maund that his explanation had been noted and that whilst Stewards can understand his predicament near the 200 metres and also over the concluding stages, he was nevertheless advised in the opinion of Stewards he should have commenced riding his horse with more vigour in the early part of the straight sooner than he did. He was further reminded of his obligations to report as soon as practicable all matters affecting his mounts in a race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

PAMANDO (D. Tourneur) – laid in near the 500 metres, shifted in and tightened MACROBIUS onto DAKTARI, which was inconvenienced when taken in onto SWEET KAISER, resulting in SWEET KAISER having to be checked and losing its position. As a consequence OH SO UNFAIR became awkwardly placed on the heels of SWEET KAISER for several strides, was severely hampered and unable to improve its position. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I HAVE ARRIVED (NZ) (C. Caserta) – tightened shortly after the start by SWEET KAISER as that horse was taken out by MACROBIUS, which shifted out and as a consequence, I HAVE ARRIVED (NZ) lost its position.

SWEET KAISER (A. Chan) – reared and was very awkward to begin and shortly thereafter was tightened onto I HAVE ARRIVED (NZ) by MACROBIUS, which shifted out. Thereafter raced very keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 500 metres was tightened and had to be checked losing its position.

RACE 5: SONS OF EDEN WINES HANDICAP - 1250 metres

MISS WAHOO (C. Caserta) – laid in, in the straight. Approaching the 200 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of TADWEEN and was obliged to stop riding and shift out to improve its position.

MR HAMILTON (T. Pannell) – laid in, in the straight.

SKILLFUL STEPS (P. Gatt) – hampered at the start. Weakened from near the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Co-Trainers were advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed SKILLFUL STEPS would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 5: SONS OF EDEN WINES HANDICAP - 1250 metres (Cont'd)

TADWEEN (F. Kersley) – awkward to begin, shifted out and tightened SKILLFUL STEPS onto JACKTHEGIANTSLAYER, resulting in SKILLFUL STEPS being hampered.

ANGEL'S WISH (J. Toeroek) – laid in, in the early part of the straight.

JACKTHEGIANTSLAYER (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CELEBRITY TYCOON (S. Fawke) – reared and awkward to begin.

RACE 6: HIT107 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

COMFORTABLE (F. Kersley) – very awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AKKACAN (A. Chan) – near the 300 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when crossed by HE IS GOLDEN.

ANAMNESIS (K. Crowther) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

HE IS GOLDEN (R. Clark) – laid out, in the early stages of the event and raced keenly. Approaching the 700 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of ANAMNESIS, shifted out slightly and thereafter became awkwardly placed on the heels of AKKACAN. As a consequence, shifted to the outside of that horse to avoid that horse's heels and contacted PARIS CRYSTAL, which shifted in, hampering that horse.

PARIS CRYSTAL (J. Kah) – near the 700 metres, when shifting in, was contacted by HE IS GOLDEN, which raced very keenly, shifted out and as a consequence was hampered. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lacerations to outside of near fore cannon. First aid administered.

OUR WITNESS (L. Riordan) – kicked by another runner on arrival at the barriers and was a late scratching at 3.54 pm by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice that the horse was lame in the near hind leg.

SAMBUCA SIREN (S. Fawke) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after arrival on course and found to have a small laceration to its near side hip, resulting from an injury in the float and was passed fit to race.

RACE 7: AAMI VIDDORA SERIES FINAL - 1300 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

PREPARE TO WIN (F. Kersley) – shifted out at the start and contacted ARTFUL RAMBLER. Rider reported the mare did not feel comfortable throughout the event and for that reason he did not persevere with his riding from in the vicinity of the 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AMBERDI (R. Clark) – laid out in the straight.

ARTFUL RAMBLER (A. Chan) – contacted at the start.

RIVER LEE (H. Coffey) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reported the mare laid out from in the vicinity of the 600 metres. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

TRUPT (C. Caserta) – awkward to begin. Laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLOP (J. Toeroek) – awkward to begin.

RACE 7: AAMI VIDDORA SERIES FINAL - 1300 metres (Cont'd)

KISSING GAME (P. Gatt) – laid out in the straight. Rider reported the mare did not stretch out in running and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 8: WHITE MARQUEE HANDICAP - 1400 metres

TROGIR (K. Crowther) – taken wider near the 1000 metres. In the vicinity of the 700 metres shifted in tightening ENKI onto GOING GAGA, resulting in both these horses being hampered for several strides and ENKI being unable to maintain its position. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday 3 November and to conclude at midnight on Thursday, 8 November 2018: a period of three meetings.

DEBT COLLECTOR (R. Clark) – was held up from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres.

ENKI (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly in the early stages. Laid out throughout the event. Made the turn near the 1000 metres awkwardly taking TROGIR wider and was hampered and obliged to race in restricted room near the 700 metres for a short distance when tightened by TROGIR, which shifted in and was unable to maintain its position.

GOING GAGA (J. Kah) – tightened and hampered and obliged to race in restricted room near the 700 metres inside ENKI, which was taken in by TROGIR.

PALE ALE (E. Finnegan) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

SPALDING COVE (J. Holder) – inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

ALL THAT SHE WANTS (F. Kersley) - rider reported the mare over-raced in the early stages of the event, settled near the 800 metres but thereafter was one paced to the line and disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
