Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse

RACE 1: VETS ON EYRE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1390 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

HARDASHIAN (B. Sweeney) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of RAYLEIGH. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) for shifting ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from midnight Sunday, 28 October 2018 and to conclude at midnight Tuesday, 6 November 2018; a period of three meetings. In the vicinity of the 850 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of SHARVANOS. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) for shifting ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from midnight Tuesday, 6 November 2018 and to conclude at midnight Saturday, 10 November 2018; a period of three meetings. Rider reported that his mount dipped on a number of occasions throughout the race.

WICKED KID (A. Chan) – a late scratching by order of Stewards at 1.17 pm after refusing to load. Trainer Mr R. King was advised that the gelding would be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future trial or race.

AMERICAIN SAPHIRE (R. Clark) – rider reported her mount felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a very small skin puncture on the near fore fetlock.

RAYLEIGH (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be steadied to avoid the heels of HARDASHIAN, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

SHARVANOS (K. Bishop) - in the vicinity of the 850 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of HARDASHIAN, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Raced greenly for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CLAREFELILLI (G. Lo) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres was disappointed for a run to the outside of RAYLEIGH and as a result had to shift in, in an attempt to improve into clear running.

RACE 2: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES / NT & DA DICKSON / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

HORIZON WATCH (G. Lo) – reared on jumping away. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a quartered medial heel on the off foreleg. First aid administered.

ACE DE JOUR (R. Hurdle) – raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES / NT & DA DICKSON / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE
- 1000 metres (Cont'd)

CRY OUT LOUD (S. Fawke) – laid in, in the vicinity of the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SCUSEE ME.

STURT'S PRIDE (A. Chan) – was slow into stride.

RACE 3: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

INVINCIBLE ME (K. Lau) – was held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres and had to shift in, in an attempt to improve into clear running.

TASSIE (B. Sweeney) – jumped away awkwardly making contact with the inside partition of the barriers. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and was passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 4: LEADER DISTRIBUTORS FLYING HANDICAP - 1210 metres

HANK'S NEPHEW (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of TOLSTOY. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) for shifting ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from midnight Tuesday, 6 November and to conclude at midnight Saturday, 10 November 2018; a period of three meetings. In the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of BURGUNDEE MISS. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding.

COPPER COAST RAIDA (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres was hampered by TOLSTOY, which shifted out.

TOLSTOY (D. Caboche) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres shifted out while over-racing contacting ROOBOY, which was taken out onto MAGNUS MAGIC. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of HANK'S NEPHEW, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

BURGUNDEE MISS (J. Maund) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of HANK'S NEPHEW, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

MAGNUS MAGIC (S. Fawke) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres was hampered by ROOBOY, which was taken out by TOLSTOY.

STAR MOVER (A. Chan) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out abruptly despite the efforts of its rider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: LOCAL LIQUID CLASS TWO HANDICAP – 1390 metres

CRAZY CULPRIT (B. Sweeney) – hampered on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small coronet skin laceration to the near hind hoof.

HEZA GUNN (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in marginally taking BOUTONNIERE in onto TILBURY. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

HOW JAMMY'S THAT (J. Maund) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metre and had to be restrained to avoid the heels of BOUTONNIERE, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

BOUTONNIERE (R. Clark) – in the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted in hampering of HOW JAMMY'S THAT.

TILBURY (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres was severely hampered by BOUTONNIERE, which was taken in by HEZA GUNN.

SYNERGY (A. Lindsay) – shifted in abruptly on jumping away contacting CRAZY CULPRIT.

RACE 6: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BM 64 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

EMOJI (R. Clark) – reared on jumping away and thereafter refused to jump and took no part in the race. Trainer Mrs J. Branford was advised that the gelding would be required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BRAMFIELD (J. Maund) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

Following Race 6 rider R. Clark was stood down.

RACE 7: PORT LINCOLN GOURMET MEATS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

THE SHOW GOES ON (S. Fawke) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by **WINE DANCE**, which shifted out in an attempt to improve.

NIPPY LIPPY (K. Crowther) – reared in the barriers getting both legs over the front gates. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. When questioned regarding the performance of **NIPPY LIPPY** rider reported her mount felt awkward in its action over the concluding stages and as a result elected not to place the mare under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EQUIDANT (G. LO) - a late scratching at 4.08 pm by order of Stewards on veterinary advice.

WINE DANCE (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out in an attempt to improve momentarily inconveniencing **THE SHOW GOES ON**.

KAILUA (G. Lo) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

ROSIE LOUISE (D. Caboche) – slow to begin.
