**TRACK:** Good 4 (*Upgraded to Good 3 at 2.53 pm retrospective to Race 4*)

**RACE 1: AAMI YOUNGCARE GRANTS HANDICAP - 1535 metres**

**OCEAN ESSENCE (NZ)** (C. Caserta) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**QUAFFANY** (J. Holder) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**STAR STATUS** (R. Clark) – jumped away awkwardly.

**RACE 2: HIT107 HANDICAP – 1200 metres**

**ICE GHOST** (A. Jordsjo) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto TENDERLY. Rider reminded of her obligations and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight when they commence to shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**TRIGUBOFF** (C. Caserta) – proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr D. Weir, was advised that a warning had been placed on the colt. Stood-flat footed and was slow into stride.

**KEMALPASA** (J. Toeroek) – laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**TENDERLY** (J. Holder) – in the vicinity of the 100 metres was hampered when tightened onto FIGHTING DRAGON by ICE GHOST.

**EILLOD** (K. Crowther) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed a higher than expected heart rate.

### **RACE 3: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP – 2500 metres**

**SASKO** (R. Clark) – stood-flat footed and was slow to begin. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

**MR STEAL (NZ)** (E. Boyd) – lost its near fore plate during the event.

**GOLD SEAL** (J. Potter) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**PELONOMENA** (C. Caserta) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

### **RACE 4: SEVENHILL CELLARS HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

**SO YOU TOO** (R. Clark) – held up from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 200 metres.

**TATOOSH** (K. Crowther) – Trainer, Mr W. Clarcken, advised after acceptance time that the gelding would not be wearing bar plates in front as advertised. Mr Clarcken was reprimanded under AR140B(3) for failing to amend the gear by the required time. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground approaching the 200 metres. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to alter course to the outside of SO YOU TOO to obtain clear ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the tongue.

**COUNTER PULSE** (J. Holder) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**MACHINEGUN JUBS** (J. Kah) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind leg. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

**COOL MAVERICK** (C. Caserta) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration below the left stifle. First aid administered.

### **RACE 5: M&J CHICKENS HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

**MODULATE** (P. Gatt) – became awkward in its action in the vicinity of the 600 metres and was eased out of the event at the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. First aid administered. MODULATE was referred to Morphetville Equine Clinic for further treatment. Co-trainers, Mr R. & Miss C. Jolly, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

**SIZZLING BULLET** (J. Holder) – rider reported that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited on a track with more give. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**STAR PATRIOT** (K. Crowther) – jumped away awkwardly.

### **RACE 6: TWILIGHT RACES AT MORPHETTVILLE - DEC 14 HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

**ANY GIVEN GLASS** (J. Toeroek) – lost its position on jumping away when tightened between PLAYFELLOW, which shifted in, and GHEEDAA, which shifted out.

**GALAXY GAZER** (R. Clark) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 50 metres was inconvenienced when taken wider by SPRINGFIELD LEW, which had been taken out.

**WANTED BY ALL** (D. Caboche) – shifted out under riding in the vicinity of the 50 metres onto SPRINGFIELD LEW, which was forced to check to avoid the gelding's heels. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 10 November 2018 to conclude midnight Saturday, 17 November 2018, a period of four meetings.

**PLAYFELLOW** (J. Holder) – shifted in on jumping away onto ANY GIVEN GLASS. Lost its near side winker in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

**EXALTED HONEY** (T. Pannell) – slow to begin.

## **RACE 6: TWILIGHT RACES AT MORPHETTVILLE - DEC 14 HANDICAP - 1600 metres (cont'd)**

**SPRINGFIELD LEW** (J. Potter) – had to be checked in the vicinity of the 50 metres to avoid the heels of WANTED BY ALL, which shifted out under riding.

**GHEEDAA** (J. Kah) – shifted out on jumping away onto ANY GIVEN GLASS.

## **RACE 7: AAMI RIZIZ SPRINT SERIES FINAL – 1100 metres**

**ZALMONA** (K. Crowther) – jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 150 metres was disappointed when attempting a tight run between the heels of STREET LIFE, which was taken in slightly at the same time as JUST A BIGGER DASH shifted out slightly, resulting in ZALMONA having to be steadied and alter course to the outside of STREET LIFE to obtain clear ground.

**IRISH MINT** (R. Clark) – slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 300 metres until the vicinity of the 100 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of EXPERIMENTATION. Shifted in under riding in the vicinity of the 100 metres onto ANAMNESIS, which was forced to be taken hold of and was taken in onto AKKACAN, which became severely unbalanced and was forced to be checked. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Sunday, 18 November 2018 immediately following the suspension she incurred at Port Lincoln on Sunday, 28 October 2018, and to expire midnight Friday, 30 November 2018, a period of six meetings.

**JUST A BIGGER DASH** (A. Jordsjo) – became awkward in its action and shifted in, in the vicinity of the 200 metres. In the vicinity of the 150 metres rolled out and contacted STREET LIFE. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was forced to be checked to avoid the heels of STREET LIFE, which had been taken in by ICELANDIC STAR. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**AKKACAN** (A. Chan) – in the vicinity of the 50 metres became severely unbalanced and had to be checked to avoid the heels of ANAMNESIS, which had been taken in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**STREET LIFE** (P. Gatt) – taken in from the 150 metres to the 50 metres by ICELANDIC STAR, resulting in P. Gatt having difficulty in riding his mount out in his normal manner. Taken in, in the vicinity of the 100 metres by ICELANDIC STAR onto JUST A BIGGER DASH, which was forced to be checked.

**ICELANDIC STAR** (C. Caserta) – shifted in under riding approaching the 100 metres onto STREET LIFE, which was taken into the running line of JUST A BIGGER DASH, which was forced to be checked. Rider charged with careless riding under AR137(a). The inquiry into this matter was adjourned to a date to be fixed to allow C. Caserta's master, Mr T. McEvoy, or a representative of the stable to be present.

**CHIC SALE** (E. Boyd) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

**GEORDIE'S SECOND** (K. Bishop) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 300 metres until the 100 metres.

**ANAMNESIS** (J. Potter) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 400 metres. Inside the 100 metres had to be taken hold of when tightened onto AKKACAN by IRISH MINT.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow P. Gatt (STREET LIFE) placed fifth, to view the official vision in the straight. After doing so P. Gatt lodged an objection against ICELANDIC STAR (C. Caserta) being declared the fourth placegetter on the grounds of alleged interference over the concluding 150 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards upheld the protest and amended the result.

**RACE 8: DAVID LOY HANDICAP – 1200 metres**

**LOCKDOWN JACK** (R. Clark) – shifted out shortly after the start onto COOL FONZY. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**LAURE ME IN** (C. Caserta) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to straight and then became momentarily held up in the vicinity of the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of ARROW LANE.

**PICTURE ME ROLLING** (A. Jordsjo) – acting on confirmed advice from Trainer, Mr J. Stephens, that the mare was developing a rash in its girth region and would be unfit to race, Stewards withdrew PICTURE ME ROLLING at 10.55 am. Mr Stephens was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

**MYSTICANO** (A. Chan) – laid out rounding the home turn.

**SWIPE ME RIGHT** (P. Gatt) – slow to begin. Had to be momentarily steadied in the vicinity of the 150 metres when COOL FONZY shifted out.

**COOL FONZY** (R. Hurdle) – lost its position shortly after the start when tightened between LOCKDOWN JACK, which shifted out, and VALLEY OF LIGHT (GB), which shifted in. Shifted out in the vicinity of the 150 metres onto SWIPE ME RIGHT, which had to be momentarily steadied. Rider reminded of his obligation when shifting ground.

**VALLEY OF LIGHT (GB)** (J. Kah) – shifted in shortly after the start onto COOL FONZY.

Correct weight was delayed to allow C. Caserta (LAURE ME IN) placed second, and Mr J. Cornell, representing trainer Mr T. McEvoy, to view the official vision in the straight.

**PORT LINCOLN RACING CLUB – SUNDAY, 28 OCTOBER 2018**  
**RACE 5: LOCAL LIQUID CLASS TWO HANDICAP – 1390 metres**

On Friday, 2 November 2018 Stewards concluded an inquiry into the circumstances of HOW JAMMY'S THAT was checked in the vicinity of the 1200 metres. After considering the evidence R. Clark, rider of BOUTONNIERE, was found guilty of a charge of Careless Riding under AR137(a) in that in the vicinity of the 1200 metres she allowed her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of HOW JAMMY'S THAT and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 10 November 2018 to conclude midnight Sunday, 18 November 2018, a period of five meetings.
