Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse

RACE 1: BRIAN HARVEY AGENCIES / SABOIS FOUR-YEAR-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 22 minutes owing to the First Care Medical Personnel having to attend to a TRSA staff member.

BLAZING ROW (T. Pannell) – contacted at the start as DESERT MINTY jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and ACE DE JOUR jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Shortly after the start rolled out onto DESERT MINTY, which was inconvenienced when it's hindquarters were turned. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DESERT MINTY (C. Caserta) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted BLAZING ROW. Shortly after the start was inconvenienced and had its hindquarters turned and was taken wider when BLAZING ROW rolled out.

HORIZON WATCH (G. Lo) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. At the entrance to the straight shifted out and bumped SCUSEE ME. Inside the 100 metres shifted in onto RAYLEIGH, which was obliged to be eased and shift out to obtain clear running. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future.

ACE DE JOUR (R. Hurdle) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted BLAZING ROW. Approaching the finish was inclined to lay out as SHEZA PROPHET rolled in marginally and was obliged to be steadied.

RAYLEIGH (S. Logan) – inside the 100 metres was obliged to be eased and shift out to obtain clear running when HORIZON WATCH shifted in.

SCUSEE ME (K. Bishop) – at the entrance to the straight bumped with HORIZON WATCH which shifted out. Inside the 100 metres was hampered and had its hindquarters turned in as SHARVANOS, which was racing greenly, shifted in abruptly.

SHARVANOS (G. Goomany) – raced greenly throughout the event. Inside the 100 metres, when racing greenly, shifted in abruptly and bumped SCUSSEE ME, which was hampered and had its hindquarters turned in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHEZA PROPHET (R. Clark) – approaching the finish rolled in marginally onto ACE DE JOUR.

RACE 2: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 14 minutes owing to the delay experienced in the previous event.

RACE 2: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1390 metres (Cont'd)

HEZA HUSSLER (R. Hurdle) – on jumping away lost its position when taken in onto MAGNUS MAGIC by PUZZLIST, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

STAR MOVER (A. Chan) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

KIRCHNER (G. Lo) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MAGNUS MAGIC. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small skin laceration to the off fore cannon. First aid administered.

PUZZLIST (S. Fawke) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto HEZA HUSSLER.

MAGNUS MAGIC (C. Caserta) – on jumping away lost ground when tightened onto HEZA HUSSLER by KIRCHNER, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

RACE 3: EP HIGH PRESSURE WATER CLEANING BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes owing to the delay experienced prior to the running of Race 1.

DELAGO EDITION (R. Hurdle) – rider reported that his mount hung out throughout the event and weakened from in the vicinity of the 800 metres despite his efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OUR FREEBIE (S. Fawke) – marginally slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from inside the 100 metres until the finish when racing between HARDASHIAN and LOCKS WELL.

RACE 4: ECO CLEAN / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

GOTTABITON (S. Fawke) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

AVORA SUN (R. Clark) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres, when racing keenly, the saddle slipped forward placing R. Clark at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BEDLOE'S ISLAND (K. Bishop) – required to be resaddled on arrival at the barriers.

KOODA MISCHIEF (S. Logan) – hung out rounding the home turn.

STURT'S PRIDE (C. Caserta) – required to be resaddle on arrival at the barriers. Slow into stride.

LOVE ME HARDER (K. Lau) – jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted in abruptly away from STREETS AFTER DARK, contacted the running rail and became awkward in its action unbalancing K. Lau for a number of strides. Ms A. Harder was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its racing manners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: JOHN'S QUICK CLEAN BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1210 metres

BURNRO (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed a higher than expected heart rate.

KID ME (D. Caboche) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from the near side nostril. Trainer, Ms J. Stoetzer, was advised that the gelding was required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race in accordance with AR53A(7).

PHANTOM DATE (S. Fawke) – laid out under pressure shortly after the entrance to the straight and thereafter was inclined to lay in under pressure until the finish.

RACE 5: JOHN'S QUICK CLEAN BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1210 metres (Cont'd)

GET PRONTO (S. Logan) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres became awkward in its action for several strides and appeared to jump a section of the track.

RACE 6: JP CABINETS BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

TOLSTOY (D. Caboche) – held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until inside the 200 metres when racing between MY LESSON and KINGSON.

RUBY'S REWARD (K. Lau) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed minor skin lacerations to the near hind pastern.

RACE 7: LEADER DISTRIBUTORS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

VINTAGE GROVE (K. Lau) – raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

CRAZY CULPRIT (R. Clark) – inclined to rear on jumping away.

HAND TO HAND (NZ) (A. Chan) – inclined to rear on jumping away.

BOUTONNIERE (G. Goomany) – laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SYNERGY (S. Fawke) – jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 8: JONES ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

O'REILLY'S REVENGE (NZ) (S. Fawke) – weakened from in the vicinity of the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr B Lear, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed O'REILLY'S REVENGE (NZ) would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

NEVA DOUBT US (R. Clark) – slow into stride.

RACE 9: MCHAPPY DAY SATURDAY 17TH NOVEMBER CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1000 metres

CHOUX BACQUAT (NZ) (R. Clark) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed small laceration to the near hind coronary band.

EQUIDANT (C. Caserta) – laid in throughout the event and inside the 800 metres dipped for no apparent reason.

LASANTA (K. Lau) – hung out rounding the home turn.

KOODA STAR (G. Goomany) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 400 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of CHOUX BACQUAT (NZ) for a short distance and was obliged to be restrained. Inside the 400 metres held up for clear running for a number of strides.
