RACE 1: UBET THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

BALLYBANE (C. Parish) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DESPACITO (E. Finnegan) – raced greenly during the event. Laid out in the straight.

MICHELLE JAYNE (J. Potter) – inside the 100 metres when improving was obliged to shift to the outside of STAR PARFAIT, which shifted in and weakened and when shifting to the outside of that horse reacted sharply and shifted out abruptly.

MISS FLATLEY (G. Cartwright) – rider reported the filly may have chocked down in running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an abnormal upper respiratory noise. Trainer advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the filly for a future trial or race.

STAR PARFAIT (J. Kah) - awkward to begin, shifted in and tightened WAR MISTRESS onto VEGAS SUNRISE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WAR MISTRESS (D. Caboche) – inconvenienced at the start.

VEGAS SUNRISE (A. Chan) – awkward to begin. Shifted out and tightened WAR MISTRESS onto STAR PARFAIT.

RACE 2: JAMES BOAGS 3YO C&G MAIDEN PLATE – 1050 metres

BEHEMOTH (D. Tourneur) – laid out approaching the 200 metres, shifted out under riding onto TRUE ILLUSION taking that horse running, resulting in TRUE ILLUSION having to be checked for several strides. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted out under riding when insufficiently clear of TRUE ILLUSION and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 10 November and to conclude at midnight on Friday, 16 November 2018: a period of three meetings. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for D. Tourneur's guilty plea, his good record and the manners of both horses. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EQUIMOORE (G. Cartwright) – held up for a short distance at the entrance to the straight when racing behind SMART ALICK and to the inside of TOMAHAWK LAD and was obliged to alter course to the inside of SMART ALICK to obtain clear running.

ETHICAL DILEMMA (C. Caserta) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EUROGLIDER (S. Cahill) – awkward to begin. Inside the 1000 metres shifted out slightly taking LOGAN RIVER wider onto SPICE TRADER. Thereafter was held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until approaching the 100 metres.

LOGAN RIVER (J. Kah) – inside the 1000 metres shifted out when taken wider by EUROGLIDER and inconvenienced SPICE TRADER to its outside. Rounding the home turn became awkwardly placed on heels of runners for several strides when racing keenly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SMART ALICK (K. Bishop) – awkward to begin, shifted in and inconvenienced TOMAHAWK LAD.

SPICE TRADER (C. Parish) – inside the 1000 metres was awkwardly placed between runners when racing in restricted room to the outside of LOGAN RIVER, which was taken out wider as that horse was taken out by EUROGLIDER, which shifted out slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TOMAHAWK LAD (P. Gatt) – hampered at the start by SMART ALICK, which shifted in.

TRUE ILLUSION (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 200 metres raced greenly, initially laid out thereafter shifted in and at the same time and was obliged to be checked off the heels of BEHEMOTH, which laid out and shifted out under riding, taking its running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: BURNSIDE VILLAGE MAIDEN PLATE – 1600 metres

CASTLE ROCK (C. Parish) – over-raced in the early stages. Held up for clear running from near the 500 metres until approaching the 300 metres.

JOHN THE RODENT (J. Potter) – near the 1100 metres had to be steadied for several strides when tightened by PHILTON, which shifted in. Thereafter was held up from approaching the 400 metres until shortly after the entrance to the straight and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

PERFECT AWARD (T. Pannell) - Trainer Mr W. Clarken was fined \$100 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the gelding. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Awkward to begin and over-raced in the early stages.

SIR GARFIELD (R. Hurdle) – shortly after the entrance to the straight laid in and became awkwardly placed outside the heels of JOHN THE RODENT, which rolled out slightly and thereafter shifted to the inside of JOHN THE RODENT and was then held up from near the 100 metres to the finish. Rider reported that from the 700 metres the horse laid in severely. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: BURNSIDE VILLAGE MAIDEN PLATE – 1600 metres (Cont'd)

STAR FLIGHT (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

HAVANA HEAT (J. Kah) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

MATAS (C. Caserta) - Trainer Mr M. Hickmott was reprimanded under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the filly. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards.

PHILTON (G. Cartwright) – near the 1100 metres shifted in and tightened JOHN THE RODENT, which had to be steadied for several strides. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground.

RACE 4: SCHWEPPE MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

BUSINESS CLASS (P. Gatt) – Trainer Ms K. Huxtable was fined \$100 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the gelding. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards.

INDIAN MO (D. Tootell) – near the 800 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of SHE'S NEVER LATE taking that horses running, resulting in J. Kah having to steady her mount to avoid the heels of INDIAN MO. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Thursday 8 November and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 14 November 2018: a period of three meetings. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ULTIMATE REALITY (J. Holder) – got its leg up after being loaded into its barrier stall was removed and underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race.

YANKEE LOU (D. Tourneur) – hampered at the start. Approaching the 100 metres was inconvenienced when improving to the outside of TYCOON TILY, which laid out and shifted out slightly. As a result shifted out onto KISSABLE EIGHT, hampering that horse resulting in it being taken out onto INDIAN MO.

JOANNA (A. Chan) – awkward to begin.

DREAM JOURNEY (S. Fawke) – laid out rounding the home turn and shortly after the entrance to the straight, shifted out abruptly of its own accord. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KISSABLE EIGHT (G. Cartwright) – approaching the 100 metres was hampered when taken out by YANKEE LOU.

SHE'S NEVER LATE (J. Kah) – over-raced in the early stages.

TYCOON TILY (C. Parish) – awkward to begin, shifted out and hampered YANKEE LOU. Laid out throughout in the straight. Shifted out near the 100 metres inconveniencing YANKEE LOU, which reacted when taken wider.

Correct weight was delayed to allow D. Tourneur (YANKEE LOU) and Trainer Mr D. Jolly to view the vision in the straight.

Following the running of Race 4, P. Gatt was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and declared unfit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 5: HIT107 HANDICAP - 1050 metres

CELEBRITY REIGN (C. Parish) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RACE 5: HIT107 HANDICAP - 1050 metres (Cont'd)

COCO GABRIELLE (R. Clark) – shifted out at the start and contacted ARTISTIC ESCAPE.

OUR WITNESS (D. Tourneur) – held up near the entrance to the straight and was obliged to shift to the inside of GOUGERS to gain clear ground and thereafter laid in, in the straight.

ARTISTIC ESCAPE (J. Potter) – contacted at the start.

RACE 6: AAMI HANDICAP - 1800 metres

OH SO UNFAIR (A. Chan) – hampered at the start. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

CHAPAL (J. Holder) – approaching the 100 metres improved onto the heels of UNSCOPEABLE and was obliged to shift out wider to gain clear running.

QUEEN'S PALACE (K. Bishop) – awkward to begin and inconvenienced near the 700 metres.

UNSCOPEABLE (G. Cartwright) – awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted OH SO UNFAIR, which was taken out onto SET TO CRUISE.

CENTRE DIVIDER (D. Caboche) – tightened at the start and lost its position.

HIDATSA (J. Kah) – near the 700 metres laid out, shifted out and inconvenienced QUEEN'S PALACE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWEET KAISER (R. Hurdle) – shifted out shortly after the start and inconvenienced CENTRE DIVIDER.

BALLAST (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SVETLANA'S ARROW (C. Caserta) – very awkward to begin, shifted in and tightened CENTRE DIVIDER onto SWEET KAISER, which shifted out.

SET TO CRUISE (T. Pannell) – Stewards granted permission for T. Pannell to ride this mare one and a half kilograms over the allotted weight as there was no other suitable rider available at the weight. Awkward to begin, shifted in and contacted OH SO UNFAIR.

CHASE SOPRANO (A. Jordsjo) – awkward to begin. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR175(k) the particulars being when weighing out for her ride on this mare, she was negligent by weighing out without a girth, which could have led to a breach of the rules and was fined \$400.

RACE 7: PIKE AND JOYCE WINES HANDICAP – 1100 metres

FLYING TORMENTA (S. Fawke) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after proving fractious after being loaded into its barrier stall and was passed fit to race. Laid out from near the 700 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MILLENIA (C. Parish) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KISS BANG LOVE (S. Cahill) – laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: AAMI SKYBEAU STAYERS SERIES FINAL – 2045 metres

DAKTARI (A. Jordsjo) – fractious in its barrier stall. Reared at the start and thereafter approaching the 1800 metres laid in and rolled in onto CREANCE tightening that horse. Raced wide without cover in the early stages and was inclined to over-race for a short distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed post-race colic. First aid administered.

BURN OFF (G. Cartwright) – held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until shortly after the entrance to the straight.

RACE 8: AAMI SKYBEAU STAYERS SERIES FINAL – 2045 metres (Cont'd)

THE GATTING BALL (C. Caserta) – laid in throughout in the straight.

AMBISHOP (E. Finnegan) – approaching the 1800 metres was taken out by DUQUESSA, which shifted out slightly and as a result was tightened onto CREANCE.

SANIMA STAR (A. Chan) – very awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted ROSELLI STING.

CREANCE (K. Bishop) – approaching the 1800 metres was tightened between AMBISHOP, which was taken out by DUQUESSA and DAKTARI, which laid in and rolled in. As a consequence had to be checked and lost its position.

ROSELLI STING (R. Hurdle) – contacted and inconvenienced at the start.

RACE 9: WHITE MARQUEE HANDICAP – 1200 metres

BUBBLERAP (T. Pannell) – slow into stride. Held up for clear running from near the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres.

KING RED (S. Fawke) – inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

KODAKHAN (E. Finnegan) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ASPALIS (A. Chan) - slow to begin losing two to three lengths and performed poorly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REGAL EAGLE (C. Parish) – held up for clear running from near the 400 metres until the finish and was untested in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DE JORVIK (D. Caboche) – awkward to begin.
