STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler and Barossa Jockey Club on Saturday, 12 January 2019

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Upgraded to a Good 3 @ 6 pm retrospective to Race 6 (Track with good grass coverage and cushion)

RAIL: Out 1 metre 1700 metres to 1500 metres, True remainder.

RACE 1: Z WINES HANDICAP - 1500 metres

PRETTY GLASS (J. Kah) - awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: SCHILD ESTATE WINES HANDICAP - 2102 metres

SCHERZOSO (C. Caserta) - slow to begin.

SHIMRANO (GER) (J. Kah) - rider explained the gelding travelled well in the early stages of the event but when placed under pressure inside the 600 metres was inclined to lay in and was disappointing in the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED CRAFTSMAN (C. Parish) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

BRONSKI (E. Finnegan) - laid in, in the straight and as a consequence became awkwardly placed on the heels of OLYMPIC ACADEMY over the concluding stages, placing it at a disadvantage.

RACE 3: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED HANDICAP - 1100 metres

MARTINIQUE (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RIZSKI (R. Clark) - re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. Inside the 200 metres improved onto the heels of PAPALET and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear ground.

RACE 4: COOPERS HANDICAP - 1200 metres

TILDY LAD (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin losing one to two lengths at the start. Raced keenly in the early stages and raced wide without cover. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate.

RACE 5: JASON PHILLIP SCHELL MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

HABANERO (D. Tourneur) - shifted out at the start and near the 800 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of EXALTED TRAIL for several strides as the pace slackened and was obliged to shift to the outside of the heels of EXALTED TRAIL. Laid out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BAR GEM (O. Ridge) - taken in by COUNTER DRIVE at the start and had its hindquarters turned by LOTS OF COIN, which shifted out and made with this gelding. Thereafter near the 1100 metres BAR GEM shifted in and tightened EXALTED TRAIL for a number of strides before being corrected and thereafter over-raced for a short distance. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

COUNTER DRIVE (R. Clark) - shifted in shortly after the start. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

EXALTED TRAIL (J. Potter) - shortly after the start shifted out abruptly away from HABANERO, which shifted out and near the 1100 metres was tightened for several strides by BAR GEM, which shifted in.

KIROSHIMA (E. Boyd) - rider reported the gelding laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LOTS OF COIN (C. Caserta) - awkward to begin and lost its position at the start as a result of being tightened, shifted in and contacted EXALTED TRAIL and was then hampered when taken out and tightened onto BAR GEM by EXALTED TRAIL, which shifted out abruptly and away from HABANERO.

SOPHINA DIVA (J. Toeroek) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

STOLEN AWAY (NZ) (J. Kah) - rider explained her instructions were to take up a forward position in running. She added, after beginning well she was able to settle forward as instructed but settled one pair closer than she would have preferred and without cover. She further added that the filly raced greenly throughout the event and laid in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: DEWY STATION WINES HANDICAP - 1702 metres

POLAR VORTEX (J. Toeroek) - near the 500 metres was inconvenienced and taken wider.

FLYING TORMENTA (K. Bishop) - inside the 400 metres, approaching the entrance to the straight shifted out to obtain clear running onto DOWNUNDER PRINCE taking that horse out into the running line of CAUSE WE CAN, which was severely hampered when awkwardly placed on the heels of DOWNUNDER PRINCE for several strides. As a consequence JETTABEL, which was following had to be steadied to avoid the heels of CAUSE WE CAN. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Thursday, 17 January and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 23 January 2019: a period of three meetings.

CAUSE WE CAN (C. Caserta) - near the entrance to the straight was severely hampered for several strides and had to be steadied to avoid the heels of DOWNUNDER PRINCE.

JETTABEL (R. Clark) - near the entrance to the straight had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of CAUSE WE CAN as a consequence of that horse suffering interference.

RACE 6: DEWY STATION WINES HANDICAP - 1702 metres (Cont'd)

DOWNUNDER PRINCE (D. Tourneur) - near the entrance to the straight was taken out by FLYING TORMENTA as that horse shifted out to improve and as a consequence shifted out into the running line of CAUSE WE CAN.

STRING THEORY (J. Kah) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: KAESLER WINES HANDICAP - 1100 metres

ICONIC (E. Finnegan) - laid out throughout the event.

VALLIANO (C. Parish) - contacted at the start.

ANAMNESIS (E. Boyd) - over-raced in the early stages of the event and was difficult to restrain. In the vicinity of the 800 metres raced in restricted room between ICONIC and JUST KAPPY for several strides.

BRIMARVI VEHERO (J. Toeroek) - held up for clear running from near the 400 metres until inside the 200 metres when racing between the heels of ICONIC and RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE and inside the 200 metres was obliged to shift to the outside of ICONIC to obtain clear running.

SEPTANGO (J. Holder) - awkward to begin shifted out and contacted VALLIANO.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (C. Caserta) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHALL WE HOPE (J. Potter) - rider reprimanded under AR137(b) for failing to ride his mount out to the finish over the concluding two strides of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed atrial fibrillation. Trainer advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

ARCTIC BLAZE (R. Clark) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from shortly after the entrance to the straight when following BRIMARVI VEHERO and was obliged to shift to the outside of that horse approaching the 200 metres, thereafter laid out in the straight.

RACE 8: POSSUM CREEK VINEYARD HANDICAP - 1200 metres

LORD TOPPER (J. Kah) - near the 200 metres was tightened by KEMALPASA and shifted in and was hampered for several strides. Rider reprimanded under AR91 for leaving the course without Stewards permission after her last engagement. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SENIOR COUNCIL (K. Bishop) - slow and awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JACKPOT JOHNNY (C. Lions) - laid out in the straight.

DEXTER YOU DEVIL (J. Holder) - laid out in the straight.

KEMALPASA (J. Toeroek) - near the 200 metres laid in and shifted in under riding taking LORD TOPPER in, hampering that horse for several strides. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when his mounts commence to shift ground.

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer Mr D Saxon was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.
