Qualifications

Racing Queensland RTO No. 31452 working collaboratively with Racing SA deliver qualifications:



RGR30218 Certificate III in Racing (Stablehand) - Traineeship

Students need competencies to work in a stable. Theory includes interpreting information, education in horse breeding, nutrition, equine anatomy and physiology. Practical tasks include daily stable routines and provide racehorse care and exercise.

RGR30518 Certificate III In Racing (Trackwork Rider) - Traineeship

Students need competencies to work in a stable. Daily stablehand routine tasks with focuses on developing riding skills and fitness to exercise racehorses at various paces; and implement the Racehorse Trainers instructions. Reporting on horse behaviour, performance and health.

RGR40118 - Certificate IV in Racing (Racehorse Trainer)

Focuses on training students in the various aspects of horse care, racing industry operations, and the development of racehorses to compete at their best potential. The course aims to equip students with practical expertise and theoretical understanding essential for racehorse training.



RGR40221 Certificate IV in Racing (Jockey)

This qualification reflects the role of individuals licensed to perform the role of a jockey to compete in the industry-regulated thoroughbred racing code. Jockeys are independent professional athletes who ride racehorses at race meetings, barrier trials and trackwork. Most are independent contractors offering their riding services to compate in the racing inductor regulated

compete in the racing industry regulated race meetings, with some retained by racing stables.






