

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 3 August 2019

TRACK: Soft 6

(Moist but not a badly affected track)

RAIL: Out 3 metres Entire. Sectional 606 metres

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 1: LEIGH AND BRIAN HOEY HANDICAP - 2014 metres

UP 'N' ROLLING (NZ) (T. Pannell) - has difficulty obtaining clear ground from inside the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

AAGAS (S. Price) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DANCE OF HEROES (GB) (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

KORODON (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - Stewards permitted rider to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

RACE 2: JOCKEY CELEBRATION DAY HANDICAP - 1600 metres

FRANCE'S BOY (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr J. Hickmott was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

RACE 3: GIA AND SOPHIA GONIS HANDICAP - 1200 metres

BURIED TREASURE (T. Pannell) - held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight.

KEMALPASA (K. Lau) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inconvenienced when taken wider in the straight by YULONG JUNE.

MYSTIFIED (S. Price) - held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. First aid administered. Trainer Mr R. Balfour was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 3: GIA AND SOPHIA GONIS HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

YULONG JUNE (B. Vorster) - difficult to load. Trainer advised a warning had been placed on the gelding. Hung out severely under pressure in the straight inconveniencing KEMALPASA, which was taken wider on the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had lost some medial hoof wall on the off fore. Lost its off fore plate during the event. Rider explained that the gelding hung out throughout the event and he had difficulty keeping it straight when placed under pressure. He added that over the concluding stages he had stopped riding in an effort to keep his mount straight and avoid impacting other runners.

RACE 4: IAN RICARDO HANDICAP - 1050 metres

BAROOD (D. Tourneur) - held up in the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

FREEHEARTED (G. Cartwright) - dipped shortly after the start.

SILENT ICE (K. Lau) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

THOMPSON'S REWARD (K. Crowther) - rider explained the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however when placed under pressure at the entrance to the straight, failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: SKIPPY'S RUN THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

DAWN SALUTE (J. Toeroek) - inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

DERR PHONZ (T. Voorham) - hampered and lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto INZAGHI by VILANELLE.

MAVETTE (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AUTUMN SPLENDOUR (K. Crowther) - inclined to rear on jumping away. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

INZAGHI (R. Clark) - contacted by DERR PHONZ on jumping away resulting in the filly's hindquarters being turned, unbalancing the rider.

LUNAR LIGHT (T. Pannell) - held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until inside the 300 metres.

VILANELLE (L. Riordan) - shifted in on jumping away contacting DERR PHONZ.

RACE 6: BRIAN POOLE HANDICAP - 1050 metres

AKKACAN (L. Riordan) - inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

FRENCH ROCK (K. Crowther) - approaching the finish was forced to race in restricted room between TURF TAPPER, which shifted out slightly at the same time as ANAMNESIS rolled in slightly.

MISS LABELLE (T. Voorham) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BRIMARVI VEHERO (D. Tourneur) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out over the concluding 100 metres.



RACE 6: BRIAN POOLE HANDICAP - 1050 metres (Cont'd)

ANAMNESIS (K. Lau) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 200 metres shifted in slightly onto FRENCH ROCK, which was steadied. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

GOODGEE (R. Clark) - rider reported the mare laid out when making the home turn.

ROWSTHORN (B. Vorster) - rider explained that after jumping away well the filly was not stretching out as comfortably as he had hoped approaching the 900 metres and for this reason elected to gain cover in an attempt to have ROWSTHORN settle. He added that when asked for an effort in the vicinity of the 600 metres, the filly had not responded and commenced to drop out of its own accord. Lost its near fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TURF TAPPER (J. Holder) - shifted out slightly onto FRENCH ROCK approaching the finish.

CRY OUT LOUD (J. Maund) - Stewards permitted rider to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg.

RACE 7: LACHLAN HARRIS HANDICAP - 1511 metres

BORRIS IN OSSORY (T. Pannell) - momentarily inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 1200 metres.

LORD SUNDOWNER (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NUDGE BAR (NZ) (L. Riordan) - in the vicinity of the 1200 metres shifted in onto BORRIS IN OSSORY, which was momentarily inconvenienced. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

SILVERHAWK (D. Tourneur) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Momentarily inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

RIKIBOBBY (J. Toeroek) - contacted on jumping away. Held up from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

DESPACITO (B. Vorster) - shifted out on jumping away and bumped RIKIBOBBY. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

DOUBLE POCKETS (R. Clark) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROTHMOORE (P. Gatt) - laid in under pressure in the straight and approaching the 100 metres shifted in inconveniencing SILVERHAWK.

RACE 8: DAVID DONALD HANDICAP - 1200 metres

BAYOU (K. Lau) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

READY SUNSHINE (S. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MOVANDI (G. Lo) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from approaching the 200 metres until the vicinity of the 100 metres when racing behind AMBERTONE, which was inclined to shift about.

JACKPOT JOHNNY (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 8: DAVID DONALD HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

RUSSIAN ROMEO (T. Pannell) - rider could offer no explanation for the performance of the gelding other than in his opinion, it may not have appreciated the soft track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WITH HOPE (L. Riordan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

AMBERTONE (G. Cartwright) - rider dislodged en route to the barriers. Rider examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagement. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.
