Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse

RACE 1: NORTHPOINT FLEURIEU / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 2050 metres

FRANK GOES BOOM (B. Vorster) - slow to begin. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

HEZ A WOLF (L. Neindorf) - began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

HIERO (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR QUEST (T. Voorham) - struck a fence in the mounting yard prior to the event. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start. Approaching the finishing post veered outwards abruptly resulting in its rider becoming very unbalanced and having to stop riding in an attempt to straighten the gelding.

OUR RHYTHM (J. Chau) - began awkwardly.

RACE 2: GOOLWA CENTRAL MEATS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

AHIGA (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

TRUE ILLUSION (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres had to be eased after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DAANIA. Held up for clear running from near the 350 metres until passing the 250 metres.

RACE 2: GOOLWA CENTRAL MEATS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres (cont'd)

MANOR KING (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted IN THE SUN. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and near the 700 metres had to be eased off the heels of DAANIA.

LOMON TEMBY (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IN THE SUN (J. Toeroek) - Stewards permitted J. Toeroek to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5 kg.

RACE 3: BLEASDALE / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1100 metres

GARVOC (T. Pannell) - bumped by PARTY SET at the start. Inside the 800 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of PARTY SET, resulting in that horse, which was racing keenly, having to be checked. Rider severely reprimanded under AR131(a). In arriving at their decision Stewards took into account that GARVOC was laying in.

THE PUBLIKIN (B. Vorster) - hung in, in the straight resulting in the rider having to stop riding and straighten the mare on a number of occasions.

PARTY SET (C. Lions) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped GARVOC. When racing keenly inside the 800 metres had to be checked to avoid the heels of GARVOC, which shifted in.

RACE 4: CHRISTMAS TWILIGHT 18TH DECEMBER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

BACK POCKET (R. Hurdle) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

STAY THE CAUSE (J. Chau) - Stewards acceded to a request from co-trainer, Mr A. Gluyas, that blinkers be fitted to the gelding for today's event. Co-trainers, Mr L. Macdonald and Mr A. Gluyas, were fined \$200 under AR206(3). Shortly after the start was bumped by JOMMADOSH, which shifted out. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Inclined to lay out throughout the event. Rider reported that the horse raced greenly throughout the event.

BUJOLASS (P. Gatt) - fractious en route to the barriers dislodging its rider and galloping riderless for some distance. Late scratching by order of Stewards at 2.25 pm. Trainer, Ms K. Mooney, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its pre-race behaviour. P. Gatt was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

JOMMADOSH (J. Toeroek) - shifted out shortly after the start and bumped STAY THE CAUSE. Near the 400 metres had to be eased to avoid the heels of STAY THE CAUSE when that gelding weakened. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: LAKE BREEZE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2050 metres

PEARL BANDIT (J. Chau) - when questioned regarding the gelding's performance rider explained that his mount travelled well in the early stages; however, when asked for an effort failed to improve and was one paced over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PIERRO'S PROMISE (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. When questioned regarding the gelding's performance rider explained that his mount travelled well until placed under pressure near the 1000 metres from which point the gelding was disappointing. He added that PIERRO'S PROMISE did not feel comfortable in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lacerations to the off fore fetlock.

RACE 5: LAKE BREEZE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2050 metres (cont'd)

KARAOKE EXPRESS (R. Hurdle) - on arrival at the barriers was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported that the gelding was lame in the near foreleg. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew KARAOKE EXPRESS at 3.02 pm. Trainer, Mr G. Richards, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

I'M BULLETPROOF (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that I'M BULLETPROOF had a tendency to hang out throughout the event.

ANNAMAN (L. Neindorf) - raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

RACE 6: LANGHORNE CREEK WINE REGION BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

MAORI MAGIC (NZ) (G. Lo) - approaching the 200 metres, when attempting a tight run between TOORAK ROAD and FLORID, became awkward on the heels of FLORID, which rolled out slightly. As a result MAORI MAGIC (NZ) became unbalanced and had to be checked.

THE RAVEN (T. Voorham) - raced greenly in the early stages of the event. Dipped on a number of occasions under pressure in the straight. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

AVALON DOWNS (J. Holder) - shifted in shortly after the start bumping TOORAK ROAD and becoming unbalanced.

JUST CHIPPING AWAY (K. Crowther) - held up for clear running from the 400 metres until near the 300 metres. Raced greenly in the straight. Had difficulty obtaining clear running from the 100 metres until near the 50 metres.

FLORID (E. Boyd) - rolled out slightly near the 200 metres. Rider reported that she had become concerned with the gelding's action inside the 200 metres and for this reason she had eased FLORID down over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TOORAK ROAD (S. Fawke) - shortly after the start was bumped by AVALON DOWNS and ARTISTIC ESCAPE.

ARTISTIC ESCAPE (J. Potter) - shortly after the start shifted out and bumped TOORAK ROAD.

RACE 7: BREMERTON WINES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1350 metres

JACK'S SISTER (C. Lions) - shortly after the start was tightened for room between CENTRE SCOOTA and ADOZENROSES, which both shifted slightly.

ASHADY HUSSY (J. Toeroek) - Stewards permitted J. Toeroek to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5 kg. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out to the end of the race.

MINNAMOSA (NZ) (S. Fawke) - laid in, in the early stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

PANZER PRINCESS (G. Lo) - shortly after the start bumped with GET IN THE BOWL and as a result became unbalanced and dipped. Laid out under pressure from the 400 metres.

FANDANGO (S. Logan) - laid out under pressure from the 400 metres.

GET IN THE BOWL (J. Potter) - shortly after the start bumped PANZER PRINCESS.

RACE 8: GIPSIE JACK BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

KING RED (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Ms N. Pollock, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

LINE DANCER (J. Toeroek) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JAYEFFKAY (B. Vorster) - rider reported that the gelding raced keenly in the early stages of the event. He added that he found a comfortable position and travelled well until near the 600 metres from which point his mount failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr M. Hickmont, advised that JAYEFFKAY would now be spelled.

PLAYFUL HOST (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground at the start.

SLIPPERY JOURNEY (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight.

WALKABOUTCREEK (K. Crowther) - rider reported that the gelding travelled well until asked for an effort in the vicinity of the 400 metres from which point on WALKABOUTCREEK failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
