

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 12 September 2020

RACE 1: MAGIC MILLIONS 2YO SALE HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

CHOSEN BLONDE (J. Toeroek) - was awkward to begin, shifted in and tightened THE MULTIPLIER onto YULE MY HERO. Laid out in the straight.

RICHED (C. Jones) - approaching the 500 metres was contacted by THE MULTIPLIER, which shifted out slightly, had its hindquarters turned, and was hampered as a consequence.

THE MULTIPLIER (T. Pannell) - which proved fractious in its barrier stall, was awkward and slow to begin. Shortly after the start was tightened between CHOSEN BLONDE, which shifted in, and YULE MY HERO. Approaching the 500 metres was brushed by SMOKIN' VAL to its inside, which attempted to shift out, and shifted out slightly as a consequence and contacted the hindquarters of RICHED. As a further consequence THE MULTIPLIER was hampered in the incident.

YULE MY HERO (S. Logan) - approaching the 500 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously for a number of strides. Near the 200 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of RICHED and was obliged to shift in to obtain clear running.

SMOKIN' VAL (K. Zechner) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. Approaching the 500 metres attempted to shift out and brushed THE MULTIPLIER, which became awkward and contacted the hindquarters of RICHED, which raced to its immediate outside. Held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until approaching the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 1: MAGIC MILLIONS 2YO SALE HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

When questioned about his instructions for today's event and in relation to the filly's performance, K. Zechner advised that he was given no specific instructions but to allow the filly to settle where comfortable. He stated that he anticipated FREE TO DANCE would lead in the event and was mindful to not change the racing pattern in relation to his filly, when compared to its first start, and to allow it to settle behind the lead. He added that whilst he was able to obtain cover behind FREE TO DANCE, the filly commenced to over-race for some distance racing to the 700 metres. He added, thereafter he had attempted to obtain a position to the outside of FREE TO DANCE and follow CHOSEN BLONDE with a view to improve to the outside of CHOSEN BLONDE; however, approaching the 500 metres, owing to the position of THE MULTIPLIER he was unable to improve to the outside of CHOSEN BLONDE, brushed with THE MULTIPLIER, and was obliged to be held up behind CHOSEN BLONDE, and as a consequence was unable to test his mount until after straightening and approaching the 300 metres, where he was able to obtain clear running. He added that the filly, in his opinion, did not finish the race off as expected.

RACE 2: PLYMPTON CRASH REPAIRS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

APPLIED (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Inside the 300 metres was obliged to alter course and shifted to the inside of MUSTARI after becoming awkward on the heels of that runner, which shifted out and away from FRANKIE PINOT to its inside. Thereafter, inside the 100 metres, was obliged to race in restricted room between MUSTARI, which shifted in slightly, and LYRICKIN'S DREAM, which shifted out slightly, and was unable to be tested over the final 50 metres of the event.

FRANKIE PINOT (B. Vorster) - inside the 300 metres shifted out to improve and contacted MUSTARI. Shortly thereafter continued to shift out resulting in MUSTARI shifting out and away from FRANKIE PINOT into the running line of APPLIED, which was obliged to alter course. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

ARCTIC FLORA (S. Logan) – on arrival at the barriers was examined by the Veterinary Surgeon who reported that the mare was lame in its near foreleg. ARCTIC FLORA was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice at 12.42pm. Trainer, Mr R. Atkinson, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

JONQUEST (J. Holder) - was awkward to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

LYRICKIN'S DREAM (J. Eaton) - Trainer, Mr G. Kluske, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle further back due to its wide barrier. Shifted out slightly over the concluding stages.

MUSTARI (P. Gatt) – was contacted inside the 300 metres by FRANKIE PINOT, which shifted out to improve. Thereafter, shifted out and away from FRANKIE PINOT into the running line of APPLIED. Shifted in slightly over the concluding stages.

RACE 3: TAB SUPPORTS THE NATIONAL JOCKEYS TRUST HANDICAP - 2500 Metres

BERTWHISTLE (S. Logan) - rider dropped her whip in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

FRANKED (GB) (E. Boyd) - was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA FIORENTE (D. Tourneur) – when questioned regarding his riding of this gelding, D. Tourneur explained that he had no set instructions other than to allow the gelding to settle where comfortable. He stated that on his own assessment and knowledge of the horse's racing manners he intended to allow the horse to jump neutral; however, stated that the gelding began better than expected and, being mindful that the horse can over-race when being restrained, he allowed it to find its own rhythm in the early stages of the event and take up a forward position.



RACE 3: TAB SUPPORTS THE NATIONAL JOCKEYS TRUST HANDICAP - 2500 Metres (Cont'd)

He added that he consciously slackened the pace on his mount from in the vicinity of the 1600 metres to the 1400 metres, and also added that the gelding was inclined to lay out throughout the event, and on pulling up gave the appearance of soreness in its shoulders. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Ms. S. Murphy, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

OURKHANI (J. Toeroek) - laid in, in the straight.

NEGASI (J. Holder) - rider reported that the gelding felt uncomfortable in its action from in the vicinity of the 600 metres and commenced to change stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a strain to the superficial flexor tendon in the off foreleg (lame off foreleg). First aid was administered. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

MATAS (J. Eaton) - was slow to begin.

RACE 4: STORM WATER SOLUTIONS HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

AKKACAN (C. Jones) – over-raced in the middle stages of the event and approaching the 700 metres was initially obliged to race in restricted room outside the heels of CARTIER TIARA, and shortly thereafter was inconvenienced as CARTIER TIARA shifted out slightly when racing to the outside of LANCASTER SOUND, which rolled off on the turn. As a consequence AKKACAN became awkward on the heels of CARTIER TIARA and was unable to maintain its position. Thereafter became held up for clear running and was unable to improve its position in the straight when racing behind DAWN SALUTE and CARTIER TIARA, and was obliged to shift out to the outside of RITORNO near the 200 metres to obtain clear running and in doing so contacted SUNMATE, resulting in that horse becoming momentarily unbalanced. Rider was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

RITORNO (S. Cahill) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. First aid was administered. Trainer, Mr C. Reardon, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

LANCASTER SOUND (T. Pannell) - rolled out near the 700 metres, and laid out in the straight.

ANTRIM'S SECRET (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUNMATE (J. Potter) - was contacted near the 300 metres by AKKACAN, which shifted out, and became momentarily unbalanced.

GOUGERS (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

UNBOUNDED (J. Toeroek) - was awkward and slow to begin.

CARTIER TIARA (B. Vorster) – near the 700 metres was obliged to shift out slightly when racing to the outside of LANCASTER SOUND, which rolled out.

WORLD FORCE (S. Fawke) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RACE 5: STOCKMOL MOLASSES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

SEBONNA (J. Eaton) - was awkward and slow to begin, losing approximately two lengths. Rider partially lost her footing from her near side iron but regained it shortly thereafter. Had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 250 metres and was obliged to shift in to obtain clear running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CAN'T BLUFF ME (S. Logan) - proved very difficult to load. Trainer, Mr M Seyers, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its loading manners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MELODY MAN (T. Pannell) - raced keenly and wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

BARRYMORE (K. Zechner) - was contacted and inconvenienced at the start. Laid in, in the straight. Shifted in over the concluding stages.

LEORBIT (S. Cahill) - was contacted and inconvenienced at the start. Rider explained that the pace in the event was too slow in the early stages and did not suit the gelding. He added that the gelding does have a history of breathing difficulty and, in his opinion, stepping up to the distance of 1800 metres of today's event, and him having to restrain his mount owing to the pace in the event, added to the breathing difficulties experienced by the horse during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIZZLING BULLET (P. Gatt) - rider reported that the saddle shifted forward on the gelding after the start, but corrected itself shortly thereafter. Was inconvenienced over the concluding stages and was unable to be fully tested when awkward on the heels of BARRYMORE, which shifted in.

UNCLE BOB (A. Jordsjo) - was contacted and inconvenienced at the start and as a consequence rider lost her footing from her near side stirrup iron and was only able to regain purchase of her near side iron a short distance thereafter. Rider explained that as a consequence of the interference experienced at the start she was unable to take up a slightly more forward position than she was able to.

WAIKATO EXPRESS (E. Boyd) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of E. Boyd's whip use and noted that she had used her whip on four occasions over the last 100 metres of the event. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

ALIRIS (J. Holder) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. Hung out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BACK POCKET (B. Vorster) - had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the straight.

DUKE OF CHRISTOPHE (S. Fawke) - was awkward to begin and shifted in onto BARRYMORE, which was tightened onto UNCLE BOB, which in turn was tightened onto LEORBIT. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards noted that S. Fawke had used his whip on three occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

MAORI MAGIC (NZ) (C. Lions) - slow into stride.

RACE 6: PFD FOOD SERVICES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

CARAK (D. Caboche) - stood flat-footed and was slow to begin losing three to four lengths at the start.



RACE 6: PFD FOOD SERVICES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

KINGSON (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

PINDARIC (E. Boyd) - had its tongue tie adjusted on arrival at the barriers. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight.

INCAS (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PIVOTAL FORCE (J. Toeroek) - had its tongue tie adjusted on arrival at the barriers.

CARLALUISA (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE RAVEN (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed abrasions to the off hind hock. First aid was administered.

SOWPODS (S. Fawke) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

BELEURA DEMON (D. Tourneur) - which had not raced since December 2019, underwent a prerace veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Was awkward to begin and knuckled at the start.

RACE 7: SUBLIME COFFEE ON BRAY STREET HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

CAMPOBASSO (NZ) (S. Cahill) - The Thoroughbred Identification Card was not available for inspection. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards.

LORD VLADIVOSTOK (NZ) (T. Pannell) - The Thoroughbred Identification Card was not available for inspection. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards.

SCORPIUS (J. Eaton) - was awkward to begin and shifted out onto SWEET MISCHIEF tightening that horse onto PEWTER.

CANFORD (D. Tourneur) – approaching the 100 metres was obliged to shift to the outside of PEWTER to obtain clear running. Over the concluding stages was taken wider by PEWTER, which was taken out by GALAHAD GURU as that horse received tightening from its inside.

STEINBRENNER (NZ) (D. Caboche) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

DR DEE DEE (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid out in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted out and tightened GALAHAD GURU onto PEWTER, resulting in GALAHAD GURU having to be steadied for several strides. Rider was reminded of her obligations when her mounts commence to shift ground. As a further consequence of being tightened, GALAHAD GURU shifted out onto PEWTER, which in turn shifted out onto CANFORD, resulting in these two horses being inconvenienced. After the running of the event S. Logan reported that she had struck her right knee on the barrier structure when her horse entered its barrier stall. S. Logan was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and declared fit to fulfil her engagements.

SWEET MISCHIEF (C. Lions) - was awkward to begin and shortly thereafter was taken out by SCORPIUS, which began awkwardly, and was tightened onto PEWTER. As a consequence PEWTER was tightened onto GALAHAD GURU, which rolled in slightly, resulting in PEWTER losing its position.



RACE 7: SUBLIME COFFEE ON BRAY STREET HANDICAP - 1600 Metres (Cont'd)

GALAHAD GURU (E. Boyd) - rolled in slightly at the start and had its hindquarters contacted at the start by PEWTER, which was taken out. In the vicinity of the 100 metres when improving to the outside of DR DEE DEE was tightened by DR DEE DEE, which laid out and shifted out, and shifted out onto PEWTER which had to be steadied for several strides as a consequence.

PEWTER (S. Fawke) - taken out and tightened at the start and lost its position when contacting the hindquarters of GALAHAD GURU. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was inconvenienced by GALAHAD GURU as that horse was tightened and inconvenienced by DR DEE DEE, which shifted out, and had to be steadied for several strides. As a consequence PEWTER shifted out onto CANFORD, taking that horse wider on the track.

RACE 8: SEYMOUR BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

CHAROSSA (T. Pannell) - was awkward to begin. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANGER DEAL (J. Holder) – raced very keenly in the middle stages of the event. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr L. Macdonald and Mr A. Gluyas, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

EXTREME THRILL (A. Jordsjo) - co-trainer, Mr G. Kent, was reprimanded for the stable's late declaration of rider.

JUST CHIPPING AWAY (J. Potter) – was very awkward to begin. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the entrance to the straight when racing behind EXCELTARA and to the inside of EXTREME THRILL, and was only able to improve its position from in the vicinity of the 200 metres and was obliged to shift to the inside of EXCELTARA and STREET LIFE to obtain clear running. Thereafter, just prior to the winning post, was inconvenienced and as a consequence J. Potter had to momentarily stop riding owing to the position of DANGER DEAL, which shifted out under pressure.

RITRATTO (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

RACE 9: SAJA SUPPORTING NJT HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

VIDUKA (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ECUMENICAL (J. Holder) - laid in, in the early part of the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GUESS AGAIN (T. Pannell) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

MOVING ON UP (P. Gatt) – was contacted at the start. Rider reported that the gelding felt awkward in its action over the final 200 metres of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BEAUTY BETTY (NZ) (J. Eaton) - was resaddled on arrival at the barriers. Was awkward to begin, shifted in and contacted MOVING ON UP and became unbalanced as a consequence. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

INSTANT CELEBRITY (J. Toeroek) - had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance after the entrance to the straight.

MASTERATI (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Was inclined to lay in, in the straight.
