Report on Race Meeting held at Oakbank Racecourse
by the Oakbank Racing Club on Sunday, 13 September 2020

Upgraded to a Soft 7 at 1.20pm (Rain affected track that will chop out)

(Moist but not a badly affected track)

RACE 1: O'LEARY WALKER WINES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

OUR BOY BAILEY (D. Tourneur) - laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres rolled in and brushed **LIKE A HEARTBEAT** as that gelding shifted out slightly.

LIKE A HEARTBEAT (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out slightly to improve in the 200 metres and brushed **OUR BOY BAILEY**.

EIGHTBALSIDEPOCKET (S. So) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in both forelegs. Trainer, Mr T. Doudle, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RACE 2: NEUTROG BIOLOGICAL FERTILISERS BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

MYSTICANO (J. Opperman) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

STAR OF MONSOON (S. So) - slow to begin. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

EQUUS D'ORO (S. Fawke) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

EXALTED MAXINE (C. Jones) - laid out under pressure over the concluding 200 metres.

ATOMIC LOKADE (M. Collett) - slow to begin.

PANAGIOTA (E. Annells) - lost its near fore plate during the event. Rider reported that in her opinion the mare had not handled the soft track condition.

RACE 3: C U @ OAKBANK EASTER WEEK 2021 / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

JUSTEDEE (D. Caboche) - laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in on LEANNA BELLE. Rider severely reprimanded and advised in future to make an effort to straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground.

LEANNA BELLE (J. Eaton) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres had to be steadied off the heels of JUSTEDEE, which shifted in, and was obliged to alter course to that gelding's outside.

LUCKY DOG (A. Jordsjo) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 600 metres had to be steadied momentarily when SWEET MINSKY (NZ) shifted in.

SWEET MINSKY (NZ) (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 600 metres shifted in onto LUCKY DOG. Rider was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHE'S TRICKY (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4: THOMAS FOODS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

ATOMIC TEXIE (J. Eaton) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr P. Hardacre, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

BONIFACE (NZ) (M. Collett) - laid in, in the straight.

JIMMY WITHA DASH (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 200 metres. Rider explained after obtaining clear ground in the vicinity of the 200 metres, the gelding did not respond to his riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KING SLIM (J. Toeroek) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

DITZY DANIELLA (E. Annells) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

LADY ADELE (S. Logan) - stood flat-footed and missed the start several lengths. Co- Trainer Ms S. Jaensch was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SAMARAS STYLE (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

SARNIA (P. Gatt) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5: MELBAS CHOCOLATES RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

PORTAMAGGIORE (J. Eaton) - rider explained that the gelding was disappointing and in her opinion, may not have handled the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GEDE - acting on advice from Co-Trainer Mr T. McEvoy that the gelding had a temperature and would be unfit to race. Stewards withdrew GEDE at 7.50 am.

SADUKA (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

ARISTOCAT (J. Opperman) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: #STARTANEWTRADITION - OAKBANK MEMBERSHIP RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

SEMINOLES (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

IKNOW WHERE YOULIV (S. So) - laid in under pressure over the concluding 150 metres.

AL MA BELLE (T. Pannell) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

GROSVENOR BRIDGE (NZ) (D. Cabcohe) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was inconvenienced when contacted by GUEST LIST. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

HAHNDORF (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly.

AMERICAN STORM (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

HOBO BOB (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto GUEST LIST.

THE BLUES BROTHER (J. Eaton) - difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 300 metres.

GUEST LIST (J. Potter) - taken out on jumping away onto GROSVENOR BRIDGE (NZ).

RED DAZZLE (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7 ECYCLE SOLUTIONS BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1900 Metres

ZOFFALA (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto AMMO LOCO.

COFFEE AMOUR (A. Jordsjo) - acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Ms K. Huxtable that the mare had injured itself in its yard prior to being loaded onto the float and would be unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew the gelding at 1.33pm.

DROP THE ORANGE (J. Potter) - laid out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

AMMO LOCO (S. Fawke) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 100 metres.

FANTASTIC MAGIC (D. Tourneur) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres was forced to race in restricted room for a short distance when AMMO LOCO was taken in.

RACE 8: KLOSE'S SUPERMARKETS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

LOVE MAGIC (J. Holder) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was inconvenienced when taken in onto COUNTER SPIN by DOUG'S JOURNEY. Rider reported that he had become concerned with the gelding's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NEVER SHORT (P. Gatt) - shortly after the start shifted in and bumped MAGNETIC EDGE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOUG'S JOURNEY (D. Caboche) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was taken in onto LOVE MAGIC by SHINING MANE.

MAGNETIC EDGE (S. Fawke) - shortly after the start shifted out slightly and contacted NEVER SHORT.

RACE 8: KLOSE'S SUPERMARKETS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

PALE ALE (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

KILOWATT (A. Jordsjo) - lost it off fore plate during the event.

SHINING MANE (M. Vassallo) - rolled in, in the vicinity of the 400 metres onto DOUG'S JOURNEY.

LITTLE HEATH (E. Annells) - laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reported the gelding had made excess respiratory noise during the event and on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abnormal upper respiratory noise. Trainer Mr S. Whittle advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

COUNTER SPIN (D. Tootell) - slow to begin. Forced to race in restricted room for a short distance in the vicinity of the 400 metres when LOVE MAGIC was taken in.
