Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Jockey Club on Friday, 27 November 2020

RACE 1: COMPLETE BUSINESS AND ACCOUNTING SERVICES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

ROCKFACE LOUIE (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event and was inclined to hang out over the concluding 800 metres.

LINE DANCER (T. Pannell) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HAND TO HAND (NZ) (K. Zechner) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

HARDASHIAN (D. Caboche) - Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

STURT'S PRIDE (K. Crowther) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from rounding the home turn until inside the 200 metres.

URBAN ARMOUR (NZ) (S. Fawke) – Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg. Raced in restricted room for a number of strides inside the 400 metres when awkwardly placed between LINE DANCER and GIVEPEACE A CHANCE.

RACE 2: VETS ON EYRE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 Metres

DIVINE SUCCESS (S. Logan) - contacted on jumping away.

ANASTASIA SKILL (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

DARK SENTRY (K. Zechner) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed mild tying up in the hindquarters.

DRESSMAKER (E. Annells) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROCK STORM (M. Collett) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

STOLE MY HEART (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out shortly after the start bumping DIVINE SUCCESS.

SWEET MINSKY (NZ) (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: MCDONALDS PORT LINCOLN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately two minutes.

FOLLOW THE PROMPTS (L. Halliday) - slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WIFE FREE ZONE (C. Jones) - was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers who reported that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew WIFE FREE ZONE at 3.08 pm. Co-trainers, Mr J. Dunn and Miss K. Bishop, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RAMBLER GAMBLER (T. Pannell) - rider reported that the gelding raced flat. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RIGHT TURN (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

CONFINEMENT (K. Zechner) - was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival on course who reported that the mare had on oedema and swelling to its nearside neck and was unfit to start. He added that he was comfortably satisfied that this was not caused by recent treatment. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew CONFINEMENT at 2.20 pm.

RACE 4: JACK KEMP MEMORIAL / SABOIS+ BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

MIRTHDALE (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DANCE OF HEROES (GB) (A. Jordsjo) - rider reported that the gelding had raced flat.

EMOJI (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REIGNING IN PARIS (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 300 metres improved onto the heels of EMOJI, which had commenced to give ground, and was obliged to be steadied and alter course to obtain clear running.

RACE 5: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS BM54 HANDICAP - 1390 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

MISTA KNOWITALL (E. Boyd) - re-saddled on arrival at the barriers.

SHINSEKI (S. Logan) - re-saddled on arrival at the barriers.

CRAZY CULPRIT (C. Lions) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LIPPSY SHUFFLE (T. Pannell) - rider reported that the gelding over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event, had cornered poorly and had felt uncomfortable in its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr S Gower, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

MISS ELEGANCE (M. Collett) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres had to be steadied for a short distance when it improved onto the heels of SPENCER GULF, which had commenced to give ground. Rider reported in her opinion the mare would be better suited over further ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RELAXED (T. Voorham) - shifted out on jumping away contacting HE'S ABEL. Inconvenienced when contacted by HE'S ABEL in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

SPENCER GULF (K. Crowther) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abnormal upper respiratory noise. Trainer Mr B. Cozamanis advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

HE'S ABEL (S. Fawke) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by RELAXED. Approaching the 100 metres shifted out and contacted RELAXED, which was inconvenienced.

RACE 6: EP TEMPERATURE CONTROL BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1390 Metres

LUGA LAD (D. Caboche) - held up from in the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

WITCH KID (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the coronary band on near fore heel. First aid administered.

CALL ME HERBIE (K. Crowther) - became awkward in its action inside the 1300 metres and lost ground. Rider reported that she had become extremely concerned with her mounts action inside the 1300 metres after putting in an awkward stride and was of the opinion that the gelding may have broken down. She added that after easing the gelding for some distance, it became freer in its action and for this reason she had continued to contest the race. She further added, that she had again become concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MY MATE SONNY (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BONIFACE (NZ) (S. Logan) - held up from approaching the 300 metres until the entrance to the straight.

ANGEL'S WISH (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

BRAZEN HEAD (M. Collett) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: LEADER DISTRIBUTORS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

HEAVENS FLIGHT (C. Jones) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres shifted in onto ALL THINGS NICE, which was forced to be steadied. Rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.



RACE 7: LEADER DISTRIBUTORS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (Cont'd)

STAR PARFAIT (S. Logan) -rolled out slightly approaching the 100 metres onto ALL THINGS NICE.

MY LESSON (L. Halliday) - jumped away awkwardly. Inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 50 metres when taken wider by BEDLOE'S ISLAND. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BEDLOE'S ISLAND (E. Boyd) - reared on jumping away and was slow into stride. Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres when taken wider by ARTISTIC ESCAPE.

CHEVITE (T. Pannell) - inside the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied and altered course to avoid the heels of ALL THINGS NICE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALL THINGS NICE (A. Jordsjo) - approaching the 100 metres was disappointed when attempting a tight run between the heels of STAR PARFAIT, which rolled out slightly at the same time as HEAVENS FLIGHT shifted in slightly, and as a result had to be steadied. Shortly after being steadied ALL THINGS NICE shifted out into the running line of CHEVITE, which was obliged to alter course, and then continued out inconveniencing ARTISTIC ESCAPE, which was taken wider. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future that she would be expected to take hold of her mount and not shift out and pass her predicament onto other riders.

ARTISTIC ESCAPE (S. Fawke) - inconvenienced when taken wider in the vicinity of the 100 metres by ALL THINGS NICE.

SERIOUS MOONLIGHT (C. Lions) - slow into stride.

RACE 8: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

SCENIC MINT (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MASTER (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Dipped for no apparent reason in the vicinity of the 600 metres.

ARTFUL AMBITION (K. Zechner) - slow into stride.

SCARY GO ROUND (T. Voorham) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

TILBURY (M. Collett) - shifted out on jumping away onto BOTTLE AND BIRD. Laid out under pressure over the concluding 200 metres.

BOTTLE AND BIRD (C. Lions) - contacted on jumping away.

CRY OUT LOUD (S. So) - slow into stride.

RACE 9: MITAVITE - LEADERS ON EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

WOTUWANT (T. Pannell) - Trainer, Mr D. Carrison, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to settle behind midfield with cover if possible in today's event. Settled forward of mid-field. Jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OLD TRIESTE (S. Fawke) - shifted out at the entrance to the straight onto CHINESIS, which had to be steadied. Rider reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was clear prior to shifting ground.



RACE 9: MITAVITE - LEADERS ON EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres (Cont'd)

JUSTICA (T. Voorham) - became fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to start. JUSTICA was a late scratching at 6.41 pm.

CHINESIS (S. So) - at the entrance to the straight had to steady and alter course when OLD TRIESTE shifted out.

DASKULYA (K. Crowther) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground in the vicinity of the 200 metres and was obliged to alter course to the outside of runners.

GENERAL:

Stewards opened an inquiry in relation to Horse Handler, Mr A. Jolly providing a breath sample, which was above the threshold level for alcohol under AR137(d). Stewards adjourned the inquiry until a date and time to be determined.
