Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Friday, 11 December 2020

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)

RAIL: Out 3 metres from the 800 metres to the winning post, out 2 metres remainder.

RACE 1: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 78 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

ARTFUL RAMBLER (E. Annells) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VICTOR VICTOR (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly.

FEARLESS AL (A. Jordsjo) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

TICKLE ME ERNIE (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay out from the vicinity of the 700 metres until the entrance to the straight.

RACE 2: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS/ SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

ACUMINATE (T. Pannell) - laid out rounding the home turn and then rolled back to its original position on straightening.

JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S (A. Jordsjo) - rider was reminded of her obligations in riding her mounts out to the finish in accordance with AR131(b).

NORTHERN SUPERSTAR (D. Caboche) - shifted out in the vicinity of the 100 metres and bumped STRIP CLUB, which was inconvenienced. Stewards questioned the rider into relation to his riding of the gelding in the straight, and in particular his failure to take a run between ACUMINATE and JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S inside the 200 metres. D. Caboche explained that on straightening it was his intention to improve to the inside of ACUMINATE; however, he was disappointed for that run and was obliged to alter course when ACUMINATE rolled back to its original position. He added that approaching the 200 metres he was looking to improve between ACUMINATE and JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S, however, formed the view that JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S would roll in closing that run, and for this reason he elected to come to the outside of that gelding's heels. He further added that after obtaining clear ground the gelding finished the event off strongly. D. Caboche was advised that in future he should ride in a manner that did not invite question.

RIGHT TURN (C. Jones) - slow into stride.



RACE 2: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS/ SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

CONGE (E. Annells) - rider reported that the filly was inclined to lay in throughout the event.

MY CAT BALLOU (C. Lions) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

STRIP CLUB (S. So) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Bumped by NORTHERN SUPERSTAR in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

TELEPORTATION (K. Zechner) - slow to begin.

RACE 3: MCDONALDS PORT LINCOLN / SABOIS FOUR-YEAR-OLD AND UP MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

FOSSHIO (S. So) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

GET AROUND HIM (L. Halliday) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RASHYATHERE (C. Jones) - dipped on jumping away.

CONFINEMENT (K. Zechner) - shifted in on jumping away onto DRESSMAKER.

DRESSMAKER (E. Annells) - contacted on jumping away. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

MISSED ME (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 4: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1390 Metres

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

BONIFACE (NZ) (E. Boyd) – laid out rounding the home turn. Laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in slightly onto WINTER HARBOUR.

WINTER HARBOUR (D. Caboche) - had to be momentarily steadied in the vicinity of the 100 metres when BONIFACE (NZ) shifted in slightly at the same time as ARTFUL TEEPA shifted out. Rider reported that the gelding raced flat. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIR GARFIELD (S. Fawke) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near hind pastern.

SPENCER GULF (E. Annells) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ARTFUL TEEPA (K. Zechner) - shifted out slightly in the vicinity of the 100 metres onto WINTER HARBOUR.

RACE 5: COLLINS' BIRTHDAY BASH CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1390 Metres

OLD TRIESTE (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

ARTFULABEERS (T. Pannell) - contacted on jumping away.



RACE 5: COLLINS' BIRTHDAY BASH CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1390 Metres (cont'd)

DESERT MINTY (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto VICTORY SPOILS. Shortly after shifted out and lost ground and was then unable to maintain contact with the field. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S ABEL (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was hampered when tightened onto VICTORY SPOILS by AMERICAN XPRESSX. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Fawke and noted that he used his whip on 13 occasions over the last 100 metres.

AMERICAN XPRESSX (S. So) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto HE'S ABEL.

HARDASHIAN (L. Halliday) - shifted out on jumping away onto ARTFULABEERS.

VICTORY SPOILS (C. Lions) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto HE'S ABEL by DESERT MINTY.

SPIRITOS (D. Caboche) - Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg.

RACE 6: PB & KG GASKELL CONTRACTORS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

IRON LION (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto ART MUSIC. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MASTER (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

MAIDEN GRACE (S. So) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

AQUANAUT (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SCARY GO ROUND (T. Pannell) - rider reported that the mare had never travelled throughout the event and failed to let down when asked for an effort. He added that the mare felt awkward in its action on return to scale. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARTFUL AMBITION (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BOTTLE AND BIRD (C. Lions) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

ART MUSIC (L. Halliday) - contacted on jumping away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7: RAISE A GLASS FOR WES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

STAR PARFAIT (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr J. Dunn and Miss K. Bishop, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

SHEZA LITTLE POSH (D. Caboche) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted CHOUX BACQUAT (NZ).

FLYING LOCO (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Approaching the finish improved onto the heels of CHOUX BACQUAT (NZ) and had to be steadied.



RACE 7: RAISE A GLASS FOR WES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres (cont'd)

DERR PHONZ (S. So) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed minor laceration to the coronet.

CHOUX BACQUAT (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - contacted on jumping away.

RACE 8: IMPACT SIGNS BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1390 Metres

DIAMONDS ARE (E. Annells) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MY MATE SONNY (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

CRAZY CULPRIT (C. Lions) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

RACE 9: TOD DAWSON MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

LADY CONQUISTADOR (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LUGA LAD (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres had to be steadied when TYCOON DREAMING hung out.

ONWARD (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding laid out throughout the event.

TYCOON DREAMING (E. Boyd) - which was racing in restricted room to the inside of GOTTABITON in the vicinity of the 400 metres, laid out and became awkwardly placed on that gelding's heels for a number of strides. As a result TYCOON DREAMING shifted wider onto LUGA LAD.

GOTTABITON (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.
