Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

RACE 1: PIRATE LIFE MAIDEN PLATE - 1008 Metres

MY BOY PERCEY (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted ATTACK THE PIN. Laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

DARK ACE (S. Fawke) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S (S. Metcalfe) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Co-trainers, Mr J. Dunn and Miss K. Bishop, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

ATTACK THE PIN (K. Crowther) - contacted on jumping away. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

 ${\it KI\,EVIL\,ANGEL}$ (C. Lions) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

NIKE BELLE (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly.

VIRAGO MISS (D. Caboche) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: MILLIE MAE'S PANTRY MAIDEN PLATE - 1360 Metres

NOAH'S HEART (B. Price) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Approaching the 400 metres was taken wider out onto KATE'S VALLEY by MYSTIC KNOT. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: MILLIE MAE'S PANTRY MAIDEN PLATE - 1360 Metres (cont'd)

MUFFLA (D. Tourneur) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres commenced to shift out when, in the opinion of Stewards, there was doubtful room between BR'ER RABBIT and MYSTIC KNOT, resulting in the gelding making contact for a number of strides with MYSTIC KNOT, which was hampered. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future that he was required to ensure there was sufficient room prior to attempting runs. Hung out rounding the home turn and shifted wider on the track.

KATE'S VALLEY (F. Atkinson) - approaching the 400 metres had to be eased and altered course back to the inside of NOAH'S HEART when that gelding was taken wider.

VICARIUM (K. Zechner) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Ms A. Downing, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

MYSTIC KNOT (D. Caboche) - in the vicinity of the 500 metres commenced to be contacted by MUFFLA, which shifted out, resulting in the filly being hampered and becoming unbalanced. Inclined to lay in over the concluding 200 metres of the event.

RACE 3: G&J EAST STRATHALBYN BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1880 Metres

WICKED RHYTHM (B. Price) – inconvenienced on jumping away when NOSTROVIA shifted out. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. When questioned regarding his riding in this event rider explained that he had been instructed that the gelding was reluctant when racing inside of runners and to take up a forward position if possible. He added that after finding his position in the vicinity of the 1400 metres he had become awkwardly placed on the heels of OWL ON THE PROWL when that rider eased, and as a result he elected to come out to a position four wide to allow the gelding to have room. He further added that he had considered an option to restrain and come back in behind OWL ON THE PROWL; however, due to his instructions he felt that the gelding would not be comfortable when restrained. Trainer, Mr K. Healy, advised that the instructions he provided were to have the gelding positioned forward, preferably in a position one-one if possible, and that he had added that WICKED RHYTHM did appreciate room. He stated that at no stage did he instruct B. Price at the gelding would not appreciate being restrained. B. Price was advised in future to ride in a manner that did not invite question, and to confirm and understand fully the instructions provided by trainers.

OWL ON THE PROWL (E. Wong) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Made the turn passing the winning post in the vicinity of the 1500 metres awkwardly and shifted wider on the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mrs H. Lehmann, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed OWL ON THE PROWL would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

ANTIPAS (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin.

MAORI MAGIC (NZ) (K. Crowther) - made the turn past the winning post in the vicinity of the 1500 metres awkwardly and shifted wider on the track. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the gelding had not handled any of the turns during the event.

NOSTROVIA (M. Vassallo) - shifted out on jumping away onto WICKED RHYTHM. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: KANGAROO ISLAND FREIGHT SERVICES BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1360 Metres

A LITTLE CHUNKY(S. Logan) - raced in restricted room over the concluding 150 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of MISS ELEGANCE, and was untested to the line.

TRIVAGO GIRL (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

AQUESTFORVALUE (F. Atkinson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: KANGAROO ISLAND FREIGHT SERVICES BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1360 Metres (cont'd)

MISS CATASTROPHI (S. Fawke) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Fawke and noted that he used it on one occasion over the final 100 metres of the event.

LIBERTY'S TORCH (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

VILANELLE (A. Chung) - slow to begin.

RACE 5: DUDLEY WINES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1008 Metres

VALENTINA STAR (D. Caboche) - taken in on jumping away onto FARSTAR.

EXALTED GOLD (E. Wong) – jumped away awkwardly. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Stewards questioned E. Wong in relation to his riding in this event. E. Wong advised that he was instructed to lead, and after being a touch awkward away he had elected to drive the mare forward in an attempt to lead rather than be caught four-wide. He added that after making an assessment he was of the opinion that he would not be able to obtain the lead by himself and for that reason he sat to the outside of FARSTAR. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VEXATIOUS BOY (S. Logan) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting VALENTINA STAR. In the vicinity of the 150 metres shifted in slightly and became awkwardly placed on the heels of FARSTAR, which rolled out slightly as it commenced to give ground.

SYLVITE (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly.

FARSTAR (A. Jordsjo) - contacted on jumping away. In the vicinity of the 150 metres rolled out slightly as it commenced to give ground.

RACE 6: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

JACK'S A CRACKER (E. Wong) – contacted on jumping away. Passing the winning post on the first occasion shifted in and away from TABLE OF WISDOM onto MISTA KNOWITALL. Shortly after made the turn in the vicinity of the 1500 metres awkwardly and shifted wider on the track.

TABLE OF WISDOM (M. Vassallo) – passing the winning post on the first occasion shifted in and away from POWER GLEN onto JACK'S A CRACKER. In the vicinity of the 1500 metres was inconvenienced when taken wider on the track. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

EL DESPERADO (A. Livesey) - approaching the winning post on the first occasion had to be steadied for a short distance when GO BOO BOO shifted in.

POWER GLEN (K. Crowther) - shifted in slightly passing the winning post on the first occasion onto TABLE OF WISDOM. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GO BOO BOO (D. Tourneur) - approaching the winning post on the first occasion shifted in onto EL DESPERADO. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

MISTA KNOWITALL (A. Jordsjo) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was hampered when tightened onto the running rail by JACK'S A CRACKER, which had been taken in. Shortly after made the turn in the vicinity of the 1500 metres awkwardly and shifted wider on the track. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: ATKINS FREIGHT SERVICES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1215 Metres

REGINA DEL DRAMMA (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Approaching the 50 metres shifted out under pressure onto MR RANGER. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 7: ATKINS FREIGHT SERVICES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1215 Metres (cont'd)

TAIPAN TOMMY (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out slightly onto UNDESIRE. Rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground. Hung in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto MOSSBELLE. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight when they commence to shift ground in future.

MR RANGER (D. Tourneur) - in the vicinity of the 300 metre shifted out in an attempt to improve and in doing so contacted the hindquarters of UNDESIRE. As a result MR RANGER was disappointed for that run and obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground. Approaching the 50 metres was taken out onto WICKED SCANDAL by REGINA DEL DRAMMA.

MOSSBELLE (S. So) - approaching the 50 metres shifted in and away from TAIPAN TOMMY onto WICKED SCANDAL.

WICKED SCANDAL (B. Price) – approaching the 50 metres had to be checked, clipped heels and lost its position when tightened for room between MR RANGER, which had been taken out, and MOSSBELLE, which had been taken in.

UNDESIRE (S. Fawke) – Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5 kg. Inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 300 metres when its hindquarters were contacted by MR RANGER. In the vicinity of the 200 metres had to be momentarily steadied when TAIPAN TOMMY shifted out.
