## RACE 1: HILL LIVESTOCK RATING 0 - 62 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

I AM IMPINGE (NZ) (A. Chung) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was obliged to be eased as SCOUT'S HONOUR shifted in.

MULLAGHMORE (B. Price) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Rider could offer no explanation in regard to the gelding's performance and expressed that he was disappointed with its performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MARYMOUNT LASS (M. Henderson) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (E. Boyd) - over-raced throughout the event. Passing the winning post on the first occasion shifted in onto I AM IMPINGE (NZ), which was obliged to be eased.

## RACE 2: TAYLORS DISTANCE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

SOLICITOR (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly. Hung out from near the 300 metres until the entrance to the straight.

MAVEN MISSILE (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OSIRIS (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be exhibiting signs of heat stress. First aid administered.

ABERAMA GOLD (C. Lions) - passing the winning post on the first occasion became awkward when being restrained and shifted out taking LEWANDOWSKI wider.



## RACE 2: TAYLORS DISTANCE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (cont'd)

FOLLOW THE PROMPTS (E. Wong) - in the vicinity of the 700 metres became awkward in its action, dipped resulting in its rider becoming unbalanced and FOLLOW THE PROMPTS losing ground.

LEWANDOWSKI (M. Henderson) - shifted about in the early stages of the event. After passing the winning post on the first occasion was taken wider by ABERAMA GOLD, which shifted out when being restrained.

## RACE 3: MAGIC FM/5CS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

AVOSTAR (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BIGNOTA (E. Annells) - rider was questioned in relation to the gelding leading in today's event. She explained that BIGNOTA began well and with the addition of blinkers and the early formation of the field she elected to allow the gelding to stride forward and settle in a position in the lead.

FIGHTING MCLAREN (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly.

JIM BEEN (C. Lions) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LA FEMME (S. So) - took charge of its rider en route to the barriers and was restrained some distance away from the barriers. On return to the barriers underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Required to be resaddle at the barriers.

HOPE WAITS (A. Jordsjo) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

## RACE 4: ACTIVOT FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

ARABIAN DAWN (A. Livesey) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have the thumps. First aid administered.

DITZY DANIELLA (B. Price) - shortly after the start rolled in and bumped SWEET MINSKY (NZ).

GIRLINTHEMIRROR (F. Atkinson) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

HEY ADELAIDE (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.


SUGAR GLIDER (E. Boyd) - inside the 400 metres was awkwardly placed inside the heels of SWEET MINSKY (NZ) and ARABIAN DAWN for a short distance.

SUGAR WITH THAT (M. Henderson) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres became awkward on the heels of LEAVE IT TO ME and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.


SWEET MINSKY (NZ) (A. Chung) - shortly after the start rolled out and bumped DITZY DANIELLA. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TROUBLED TIMES (E. Annells) - rider reported that the filly was inclined to hang out rounding the home turn.

## RACE 5: JIM BARRY WINES 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres



CALL ME DEXTER (A. Livesey) - approaching the 1100 had its hindquarters turned by CENTRE SCOOTA.

CRYPTO CURRENCY (A. Jordsjo) - inside the 800 metres was obliged to be take hold when taken in onto KISSABLE EIGHT as EQUICHUNK shifted in when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KISSABLE EIGHT (F. Atkinson) - inside the 800 metres was hampered when awkwardly placed to the inside of CRYPTO CURRENCY for a number of strides as that gelding was taken in by EQUICHUNK, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

EQUICHUNK (M. Aitken) - began well. Inside the 800 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear onto CRYPTO CURRENCY, which was obliged to be taken hold of and was taken in onto KISSABLE EIGHT, which was hampered for a number of strides. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Monday, 5 April 2021 and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 14 April 2021, a period of three meetings.

BIRD OF WAR (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was awkwardly placed on the heels KISSABLE EIGHT for a number of strides and from that point on had difficulty obtaining clear running to the inside of that mare until in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

CHICK IN CHARGE (S. So) - jumped away awkwardly.

SLIPPERY JOURNEY (E. Wong) - slightly slow to begin.

RACE 6: RAY WHITE CLARE VALLEY BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

ALLAYEZ (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out taking LOVE IN THE CITY wider. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RAPID RIDE (C. Lions) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DINNER LAKE (E. Boyd) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barrier by request of its rider and was passed fit to start. Passing the winning post on the first occasion got its head up when being restrained for a number of strides. Rider was questioned regarding her riding of the gelding over the concluding stages of the event. After considering her explanation Stewards issued a reprimand under AR131(b) in that she failed to ride her mount out to the end of the event.

HE'S ALL READY (M. Henderson) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto ANTIPAS as LOVE IN THE CITY was taken out.

ANTIPAS (A. Jordsjo) - on jumping away was inconvenienced when contacted by HE'S ALL READY, which was taken out.


LOVE IN THE CITY (F. Atkinson) - on jumping away was taken out by ALLAYEZ onto HE'S ALL READY. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

NOSTROVIA (S. So) - in the vicinity of the 700 metres dipped for no apparent reason.

RACE 7: MERCHANT ACCOUNTANTS & BUSINESS ADVISERS BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to a false running rail having to be readjusted in the vicinity of the 1000 metres.

JAY PEE BEE (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



HABANERO (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 700 metres bumped with MIGHTY MOSHE, which rolled in. Held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of VIETTI and OPHELIA BLUES.

RACE 7: MERCHANT ACCOUNTANTS & BUSINESS ADVISERS BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP -  
1100 Metres (cont'd)

MIGHTY MOSHE (M. Henderson) - in the vicinity of the 700 metres rolled in and bumped HABANERO.

RAHEEBA (A. Jordsjo) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VIETTI (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OPHELIA BLUES (E. Annells) - rider reported that the filly raced greenly throughout the event.

LADY CORNELIA (E. Wong) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres was taken wider by LIBERTY'S TORCH, which rolled out. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was awkwardly placed between the heels of HABANERO and RAHEEBA for a short distance.

LIBERTY'S TORCH (A. Chung) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres rolled out taking LADY CORNELIA wider. Rider reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and to ensure to keep his mounts straight in future.

ICE HUNT (S. So) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres was disappointed when attempting a run to the inside of SQUADRON LEADER and was obliged to be restrained for a number of strides.
