RACE 1: MILHINCH HOURGLASS JEWELLERS MAIDEN PLATE - 1396 Metres


The start of this event was delayed approximately two (2) minutes owing to the barriers being required to be placed into position.

CYCLONE LES (D. Tootell (Snr)) - near the 1200 metres got its head up when being restrained.

REDENZO BULLET (E. Annells) - post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DITZY DANIELLA (S. Fawke) - on jumping away bumped with SCARLET RIVER which shifted out. Was slow into stride.

SCARLET RIVER (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped DITZY DANIELLA.



RACE 2: CINEMA AUGUSTA BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP.- 1600 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately six (6) minutes.

FULTON STREET (E. Annells) – rider M. Collett was injured on mounting and was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled unfit to fulfill her engagement. Stewards permitted E. Annells as the replacement rider of the gelding in today's event.

MALVADO (A. Livesey) - post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off-hind leg. Trainer, Mr. R. Balfour, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to a future race start or trial.

BELLS 'N' BOWS (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

TYCOON FLUTTER (NZ) (D. Tootell (Snr)) - slow to begin.

Following this event, M. Collett was re-examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled unfit to fulfill her remaining engagements.

RACE 3: DATGAW SERVICES MAIDEN HANDICAP- 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two (2) minutes owing to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

AQUAMOSS (M. Henderson) - hung out rounding the turn in the vicinity of the 900 metres and again rounding the home turn.

SEA HOFFA (F. Atkinson) – rider reported that the gelding raced greenly and was inclined to lay in during the event.

PERFECT VOYAGE (S. Fawke) - raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

TIANA GIA (S. So) - commenced to give ground from in the vicinity of the 600 metres. Rider reported that the mare did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZIPADEE (A. Livesey) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LADY HUNTSMEN (E. Annells) - In the vicinity of the 700 metres became very awkward in its action and lost approximately two to three lengths.

Following the running of this event, SEA HOFFA became fractious on return to its tie-up stall, struck its head and fell. The gelding was examined by the Veterinary Surgeon who reported SEA HOFFA was deceased. Stewards ordered a post-mortem sample be taken from the gelding.

RACE 4: DARRYL FULLERTON MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP RACE (HEAT 8 AUTUMN SERIES) - 1396 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four (4) minutes owing to the incident with SEA HOFFA following Race 3.

BUDGET KING (B. Price) - on jumping away bumped with JAAMINT. In the vicinity of the 800 metres was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto ALPHAEUS as IT'S HUMPHREY hung out despite the efforts of its rider. In the vicinity of the 400 metres was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto SIZZLING BULLET as IT'S HUMPHREY hung out.

IT'S HUMPHREY (E. Wong) - shortly after jumping away shifted out and bumped JAAMINT. Hung out for the remainder of the event and in the vicinity of 800 metres shifted out onto BUDGET KING. In the vicinity of the 400 metres continued to hang out and shifted out onto BUDGET KING. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in future. Trainer, Mr. T. Trenowden was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

LEONARDA (F. Atkinson) - bounded on jumping away.



RACE 4: DARRYL FULLERTON MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP RACE (HEAT 8 AUTUMN SERIES) - 1396 Metres (Cont'd)

JAAMINT (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped BUDGET KING shortly after bumped with IT'S HUMPHREY which shifted out.

RACE 5: SCA LISTNR APP BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP- 1396 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two (2) minutes owing to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

JAY PEE BEE (NZ) (A. Livesey) - hung out under pressure in the straight.

GALAXY FALLS (D. Tootell (Snr) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped NORTHSET.

NORTHSET (E. Boyd) - on jumping away bumped with GALAXY FALLS which shifted in and was taken in onto BIRD OF WAR.

ORLEANS (K. Zechner) - on jumping away knuckled slightly.

CURTAIN CALL (S. Fawke) - on jumping away had its hind quarters turned when contacted by BIRD OF WAR which was inconvenienced when taken in.

GUEST LIST (M. Henderson) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200. In determining penalty, Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by M. Henderson and noted that he used his whip on twelve occasions over the last 100 metres. Rider also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

BIRD OF WAR (E. Annells) - on jumping away was inconvenienced when taken in by NORTHSET which was taken in and was tightened onto CURTAIN CALL.

SCALLOP (A. Chung) - began well.

FALLOW (B. Price) - on jumping away knuckled slightly. Rider was questioned in relation to his riding of the gelding to the finish line. He pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(b) in that he failed to ride his mount out to the end of the race for the last approximately six strides and was reprimanded.

RACE 6: PORT PIRIE BUS SERVICE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP (HEAT 7 SA SPRINT SERIES)- 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two (2) minutes owing to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

SCARY GO ROUND (E. Annells) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto HEART LIKE MINE as RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE which was hanging in rolled in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AUGUSTA ROCK (F. Atkinson) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of A THOUSAND DEGREES.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (E. Wong) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres was inclined to hang in and rolled in onto SCARY GO ROUND. Hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HEART LIKE MINE (S. So) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to alter course as A THOUSAND DEGREES rolled out and RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE which hanging in, shifted in.



RACE 6: PORT PIRIE BUS SERVICE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP (HEAT 7 SA SPRINT SERIES)-
1100 Metres (Cont'd)

RUSHWA (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200. In determining penalty, Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Fawke and noted that he used his whip on twelve occasions over the last 100 metres.

RACE 7: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP.- 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three (3) minutes owing to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

ROCKFACE LOUIE (E. Annells) - jumped away very awkwardly and shifted in onto SERIOUS MOONLIGHT which lost its position. Approaching the 800 metres when being steadied by its rider was checked and lost ground when DERR PHONZ shifted in slightly. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action at any stage during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SERIOUS MOONLIGHT (D. Tootell (Snr)) - on jumping away lost its position as ROCKFACE LOUIE jumped away very awkwardly and shifted in and THE MOSHIRE jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported that he had concerns with the gelding's action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer. Mr. R. Dawson was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to a future race start or trial.

PAM'S JOURNEY (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out onto ICE HUNT which lost its position.

PREDICTS (S. Fawke) - on jumping away dipped. Hung out throughout the event and proved difficult for its rider to ride out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DERR PHONZ (E. Wong) - approaching the 800 metres shifted in slightly onto ROCKFACE LOUIE which was being steadied and was subsequently checked by its rider and lost ground. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in future.

ICE HUNT (S. So) - on jumping away lost its position when taken out onto THE MOSHIRE by PAM'S JOURNEY.

BROOKE (K. Zechner) - acting on confirmed advice from Trainer, Mr. B. Holtham, that the mare had a laceration to its off-hind leg due to an incident in its stable and the mare would be unfit to race. Stewards withdrew the BROOKE at 10:10 am. Mr. Holtham was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to a future race start or trial.

CHICK IN CHARGE (A. Chung) - in the vicinity of the 50 metres was obliged to alter course when awkwardly placed on the heels of THE MOSHIRE.

THE MOSHIRE (M. Henderson) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out onto SERIOUS MOONLIGHT which lost its position.
