RACE 1: THE SEBASTOPOL MACHINERY FOR GOLDACRES DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2100 Metres

BACK IN ACTION (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

FAST FOILS (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – over- raced throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 150 metres was inconvenienced when awkwardly placed on the heels of BACK IN ACTION which was inclined to lay out. Approaching the finish was inconvenienced as BACK IN ACTION which was laying out, rolled out.

FASTNET PRINCESS (A. Jordsjo) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported that the mare did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

M'LADY LOIS (J. Opperman) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

NORFOLK LOVE (S. Logan) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow D. Tourneur, the rider of second-placed horse FAST FOILS (NZ) to view the vision in the straight.



RACE 2: SOMERSET HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

I'M A FIGHTER (J. Potter) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TARASQUE (E. Annells) - shortly after the start became awkward on the heels of MUTINOUS as MONTIGN rolled out. Approaching the 600 metres shifted out across the heels of BEAUMIS.

MONTIGN (A. Jordsjo) - shortly after the start rolled out.

MUTINOUS (T. Pannell) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. Rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, in his opinion the gelding seemed to be having breathing difficulties. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BEAUMIS (J. Opperman) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: FESTIVAL HIRE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

DUGGEE'S BOY (J. Opperman) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres was taken wider by DUCK DIVE which was inclined to lay out. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

SEDATE SUN (S. Logan) - jumped way awkwardly.

KEETTOM (M. Aitken) - on jumping away bumped with WYNTER LADY.

NED AND POWER (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Approaching the finish became awkward on the heels of WYNTER LADY.

NIMIR (K. Walters) - as it had not raced since April 2020 underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event when being restrained.

LADY ADELE (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OUR GEM (S. Wiseman) - jumped away awkwardly.

WYNTER LADY (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly shifted out and bumped KEETTOM.

AEROPORT (A. Chung) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was disappointed when attempting a tight run between NED AND POWER and KEETTOM and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

DUCK DIVE (E. Finnegan) - laid out from in the vicinity of the 600 metres taking DUGGEE'S BOY wider.

SCHLEER (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

ATOMIC WIZARD (J. Opperman) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a spasm of the lips on the left side of its mouth.

ANKARA FOX (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly.

ROSSTART (E. Boyd) - as it has not raced since May 2019 underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start.

OUR BENEVENTO (S. Logan) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground over the concluding stages of the event.

CEALLACH (A. Jordsjo) - as it has not raced since May 2020 underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start.

RACE 5: THE GEORGE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

DARILJON (C. Puls) - acting on confirmed advice from Trainer, Mr C. Ryan that the gelding was difficult to load on transport Stewards withdrew DARILJON at 8:14 am.

OUR BOY BAILEY (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

GROSVENOR BRIDGE (NZ) (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and, as a result, was slow into stride.

SISTER DEE (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly. On return to the mounting yard rider was dislodged. E. Finnegan was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled fit to fulfill her remaining engagements.

THE ARMANI (NZ) (L. Halliday) - jumped away awkwardly.

SPOTAKOVA (J. Maund) - lost its near hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ELIZA'S GOLD (E. Boyd) - slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: 3MP STEEL, ROOFING AND FENCING SUPPLIES MILLICENT CUP - 2100 Metres

VON COSTA GLASS (M. Aitken) - jumped away awkwardly.

BRIGADIER (NZ) (L. Halliday) – acting on confirmed advice from Co-trainer, Mr K. Post that the gelding had injured itself on the off-foreleg and would be unfit to race, Stewards withdrew BRIGADIER (NZ) at 10:00 am. Mr Post was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to any future race or trial.

RACE 7: JOHN CHAY AND CO LIVESTOCK BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

ROHLON DRUNK (J. Opperman) - knuckled on jumping away. Approaching the finish rolled out. Rider was reminded of his obligations in allowing his mount to roll about under pressure in the straight.

OLATUNJI (J. Maund) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BLACK SYRAH (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin (approximately three to four lengths). Approaching the winning post shifted out and away from ROHLON DRUNK which rolled out and bumped with PEWTER.

RHYTHMATIC (S. Wiseman) - held up for clear running for a short distance rounding the home turn.

PEWTER (C. Jones) - approaching the finish bumped with BLACK SYRAH and shifted out and away from that gelding and bumped THIS KID ROCKS on a number of occasions.

CARAK (T. Pannell) - inconvenienced on jumping away as WILD COLONIAL BOY shifted in. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight for a short distance. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from in the vicinity of the 150 metres until near the 50 metres.

THIS KID ROCKS (G. O'Loughlin) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the finish bumped with PEWTER on a number of occasions.

WILD COLONIAL BOY (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

PRETTY GLASS (E. Boyd) - held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 300 metres until in the vicinity of the 150 metres where it raced in restricted room and was tightened and lost its position when racing between PEWTER and STAR JAN which rolled out marginally. Unable to be fully tested to the finish when awkwardly placed on heels.

STAR JAN (S. Fawke) - in the vicinity of the 150 metres rolled out.

RACE 8: NED, NAN & SUE MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

LONGMIRE (J. Opperman) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

ACTION IN CAIRNS (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in, in the early part of the straight.

MAGIC REWARD (M. Aitken) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WEEKEND BANG (G. O'Loughlin) - got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained in the early stages of the event. Inside the 400 metres rolled out slightly.

PAINT THIS CITY (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly. Inside the 400 metres was momentarily steadied when tightened between WEEKEND BANG which rolled out slightly and BUT BEAUTIFUL which rolled in slightly.

BUT BEAUTIFUL (E. Boyd) - inside the 400 metres rolled in slightly.

GOLDEN RIPPLES (E. Finnegan) - rider reported that the mare did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
