

# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphetville Parks  
Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on  
Saturday, 5 June 2021

## RACE 1: JIMMY'S BAR & GRILL HANDICAP 2YO - 1250 Metres

RUNAMIGO (J. Opperman) - rider explained that he was instructed to be in a forward position however, the gelding did not begin as well as expected and, as a result, it had to work hard to obtain its position outside the leader. He added the horse only travelled fairly until the 400 metres and when placed under pressure, failed to respond. He further stated in his opinion the horse may be towards the end of its campaign. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STARION (J. Eaton) - hindquarters were bumped heavily at the start by EYES NEVER LIE resulting in the gelding becoming unbalanced. Rider reported the gelding failed to travel throughout the event due to the fast tempo and proved disappointing when placed under pressure.

EYES NEVER LIE (J. Holder) - on jumping was buffeted between ALASKAN STORM and STARION resulting in the filly being severely hampered and racing further back than intended.

SOMEWATT FABULOUS (J. Toeroek) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

ALASKAN STORM (C. Jones) - jumped awkwardly, shifted in and heavily contacted EYES NEVER LIE, which was tightened onto STARION. Laid in in the straight.

GOULBURN RIVER (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



## RACE 2: LECONFIELD HANDICAP 3YO - 1000 Metres

The start of this race was delayed two minutes due to TANJA'S DREAM becoming fractious in the barriers. Both TANJA'S DREAM and R. Hurdle were examined and passed fit to take their place in the event.

GREAT DIVINER (T. Pannell) - shifted out near the 400 metres and carried CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR and SEA WITNESS wider.

TANJA'S DREAM (R. Hurdle) - shifted in under pressure near the 100 metres when insufficiently clear of DANA POINT which had to be steadied. Rider reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

SEA WITNESS (C. Jones) - slow to begin. Forced wider rounding the turn near the 400 metres

CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR (J. Opperman) - forced wider rounding the turn near the 400 metres.

DANA POINT (J. Eaton) - crowded near the 100 metres when weakening and had to be steadied. Rider explained that the filly travelled well throughout the event however, when placed under pressure, failed to respond and although steadied near the 100 metres, weakened quickly from the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

## RACE 3: G.H. MUMM MAIDEN PLATE 3YO & Up - 1300 Metres

TURN TABLE (T. Pannell) - contacted at the start. Raced wide rounding the home turn.

GOLIOTUS (C. Jones) - made the turn awkwardly near the 1000 metres and shifted out.

JAKAZONE (J. Potter) - jumped awkwardly and shifted out. Approaching the 700 metres when racing keenly, became very awkwardly placed on the heels of CHARGING FIRE for a number of strides and was obliged to be restrained.

RED PATROL (NZ) (K. Walters) - slow to begin, losing two lengths.

PERFECT ZED (J. Eaton) - Trainer was advised a warning had been placed on the filly which proved fractious behind the barriers. On straightening was steadied when momentarily crowded by CHARGING FIRE which shifted out slightly. Rider reported the filly felt very awkward in its action during the event and failed to finish the race off as a consequence. Trainer, Mr. P. Hardacre advised Stewards that the filly would now be going for a spell. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TURFITT (J. Holder) - jumped awkwardly shifted out and made contact with TURN TABLE. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide rounding the home turn. Rider reported the filly raced keenly and proved disappointing when placed under pressure. He added that, in his opinion, TURFITT may be better suited, after a freshen up, over a shorter distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

## RACE 4: ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

EITILT (NZ) (T. Pannell) - tongue tie was refitted behind the barriers. Rider reported the horse worked hard in the early stages of the event when being challenged for the lead and subsequently failed to respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TRUMPSTA (C. Jones) - shifted in slightly approaching the 900 metres. Contacted near the 250 metres by CASHIN' CHEX (NZ) on its inside.

THANASI (J. Opperman) - was awkward to begin. Lost its near-hind plate during the event.

KEEN ON GOLD (K. Zechner) - shifted out on jumping away and shortly thereafter clipped the heels of FREE OF SIN which rolled in slightly away from SPIRITED MATCH, and knuckled.

FREE OF SIN (J. Eaton) - was unable to obtain clear racing room and had to be steadied from the 400 metres until near the 200 metres where the filly shifted out to improve.



#### RACE 4: ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (Cont'd)

SPARKUP (K. Crowther) - steadied approaching the 900 metres when momentarily crowded between SCOUT'S HONOUR and TRUMPSTA both of which shifted ground.

CASHIN' CHEX (NZ) (J. Potter) - attempted to improve into restricted room between TRUMPSTA and THANASI between the 300 metres and 200 metres and was subsequently disappointed for clear running, obliging its rider to steady and shift in to obtain clear running. Rider was advised to take more care when attempting to improve into restricted room. Rider was reminded of his obligation under AR132(6)(b) in regards to using his whip with an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Shifted out slightly approaching the 900 metres.

#### RACE 5: TAB HANDICAP 3YO - 1400 Metres

THRILL KILL (C. Jones) - raced very keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

COOL MAGNUM (J. Holder) - post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SILENT DON (K. Zechner) - post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YULE MY HERO (J. Maund) - knuckled severely on jumping. Rider reported as a result the gelding raced further back than intended. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GHETTO (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 6: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

The start of this race was delayed by approximately five minutes due to OCTANE having to be reshod at the barriers.

OCTANE (S. Logan) - lost its near fore plate at the barriers and was required to be reshod. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run. On jumping was crowded between ARROW LANE and HYPERSONIC which shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FREE OF DEBT (J. Toeroek) - was declared a late scratching at 12:56 pm by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice that the gelding had injured its off-hind leg in the tie-up stalls. Trainer, Mr. C. Bieg, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to a future trial or race start.

KABINI (E. Finnegan) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

HYPERSONIC (C. Jones) - began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted OCTANE.

CONCRETE (K. Zechner) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.


HE'S A BALTER (T. Pannell) - Stewards permitted T. Pannell to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5 kg.

ZARACE (K. Crowther) - was held up for clear racing room from near the 400 metres when racing behind HARD LANDING and to the inside of HYPERSONIC and was only able to obtain clear running near the 100 metres.

#### RACE 7: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

HARBOUR EXPRESS (R. Hurdle) - was steadied near the 200 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of SEVEN LETTERS which shifted in slightly.

OUR DEEP AGENDA (S. Logan) - raced wide without cover from near the 1000 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 7: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1250 Metres (Cont'd)

TWO ODD SOX (J. Potter) - was steadied near the 500 metres to avoid the heels of the weakening WINTER HARBOUR.

TAJAVEDO (E. Boyd) - awkward and slow to begin. Raced wide throughout the event.

SEVEN LETTERS (J. Maund) - shifted in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

ZOUSTORM (D. Tootell (Snr)) - slow to begin.

RACE 8: DAVID 'DT' THOMAS MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes due to R. Hurdle having to be replaced by A. Jordsjo.

DEBT COLLECTOR (S. Logan) - held up for clear racing room between the 300 metres and the 200 metres.

POET'S LANDING (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed a bi-lateral bleed. Trainer, Mr. T. Doudle, was advised that, as this was the geldings first bi-lateral bleed POET'S LANDING would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

GOING GAGA (J. Eaton) - steadied momentarily near the 400 metres away from the heels of CLASSY JOE which shifted out.

HIGHLY DISCREET (K. Crowther) - jumped awkwardly and lost ground. Rider explained that after being a little slow to begin, the filly settled at the tail of the field as expected and after initially being keen, relaxed well in the middle stages. She added she was then obliged to shift out from the 600 metres and raced wide for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TUBBY TWO TRACKS (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROBE BAY (T. Pannell) - slow to begin.

RACE 9: CHARLIE HOILE CUP - 2250 Metres

LORD BOUZERON (NZ) (J. Eaton) - shifted in on jumping away, contacted TURF MAN and, as a consequence had its hindquarters turned. Rider reported that she was obliged to race wide rounding the first turn.

CEARDAI (NZ) (T. Pannell) - post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AZZUREOUS (K. Crowther) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted TURF MAN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TURF MAN (S. Logan) - was tightened and hampered at the start between AZZUREOUS which shifted out and LORD BOUZERON (NZ) which shifted in.

EXALTED FIRE (E. Boyd) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Awkward to begin. Saddle shifted forward shortly after the start when racing keenly. As a consequence E. Boyd was unable to ride her horse in her normal manner and, in the vicinity of the 1500 metres was obliged to remove both her feet from her irons and thereafter raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event, placing her at a disadvantage.

HAPPY ATOM (E. Finnegan) - was awkward and slow to begin.
