Trainers

After 1st July 2021 you will need to access your application through your Stable Assist account - under the subheading of RENEW LICENCE.

Jockeys

Will receive an email offer for their 2021 - 2022 Licence after 1st July 2021.

You will need to login and complete the online application.

You will also need to complete and submit the Racing SA "Medical Report Form" prior to the application being approved for the new season.

Stable Employees / Track Riders / Forepersons

Will receive an e-mail offer for their 2021 - 2022 Licence.

You will need to login and complete the online application.

If you intend to ride Trackwork you will also need to download the Racing SA "Medical Report Form" from our website "racingsa.com.au/industry/licensing" and submit prior to being licensed to ride Trackwork.
