Conditions Governing Official S.A.J.C., O.R.C. and Provincial Barrier Trials

1. Trials to be conducted under the supervision of Stipendiary Stewards.
2. **No horse shall take part under any but the correct registered name and a stable return must be lodged prior to the closing time of entries.**
3. Only Jockeys and Apprentices will be permitted to ride in Trials.
4. Every rider shall wear the colours as stated on the Horse's Stable Return.
5. Flat Trials in the Metropolitan area commence at 9:00 AM (unless otherwise advised) irrespective of whether there is a Hurdle Trial. Approximately 15 minutes between trials. Trials in the Provincial Area to commence at 9.00 AM (unless otherwise advised).
6. Trainers **MUST** confirm riders at Acceptance or Secretary's Office before the running of the previous Trial or half an hour before the first Trial or horse may be withdrawn by Stewards.
7. Nominations for all Trials close with the Trainers Service Centre (TSC) on 1800 138 704 or online via StableAssist at www.risa.com.au
8. No horse may be substituted for one originally nominated.
9. Fields will not be altered following their finalisation without the Stewards permission.
10. Any SAJC Trial may be abandoned if less than five nominations are received excluding two-year-old and hurdle trials wherein four nominations will be required to ensure the trial is conducted.



Notice: Barrier Trials

(Country Barrier Trials will run after the last race on raceday)
Effective immediately the administration of all barrier trials in South Australia will be brought into line with the way that races are administered. Trial nominations and payments will no longer need to be done through the Club holding the trials.

Nominations close 1 hour after acceptances close for the same raceday.
