## RACE 1: LINCOLN WINDOW TINT BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

MY MATE SONNY (E. Boyd) - near the 400 metres rolled in and contacted MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ). Rider reported that the gelding may have slipped behind inside the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - near the 400 metres was inconvenienced when contacted by MY MATE SONNY. Rolled out rounding the home turn and became awkwardly placed on the heels of MY MATE SONNY for a number of strides.

RUBY'S REWARD (K. Zechner) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MIRTHDALE (B. Price) - anticipated the start and jumped away well.

ISA SECRET (C. Murray) - Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declare weight of 54.0 kg.



## RACE 2: GREAT NORTHERN ORIGINAL MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

GOOD APPROACH (C. Lions) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. When questioned in relation to the improved performance of the gelding trainer, Mr M. Seyers, advised that he could offer no explanation other than he felt the gelding appreciated the better barrier draw today, which resulted in the rider being able to better comply with the instructions provided. He added that the instructions provided today and at the gelding's previous start at Port Lincoln were to push forward from the barrier and try to obtain a position on pace.

I GOT STRINGS (G. Lo) - rider explained that the mare had never travelled during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TELEPORTATION (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

RECLUSIVE LAD (D. Caboche) - slow to begin and shortly after was contacted by SMART ACE.

SMART ACE (E. Boyd) - reared on jumping away and shifted in contacting RECLUSIVE LAD.

## RACE 3: XTREME KITES & PADDLE MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

DEFIANT CAESOUR (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly.

JUSTEDEE (C. Murray) - held up from near the 300 metres until approaching the 50 metres.

OUR JOURNEYMAN (S. Logan) - contacted on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RIGHT TURN (E. Annells) - slow into stride. Made the home turn awkwardly and shifted wider on the track.

ROGUE I AM (E. Wong) - backed through a perimeter fence in the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to start. Trainer, Mr R. King, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its pre-race manners. Slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. Lost its off hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Mr R. King was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to it being uncompetitive.

INOTELL (K. Crowther) - shifted out to improve near the 400 metres and in doing so brushed ZIGGING AROUND.

JOURNEY TO RIO (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

TIAMAT (A. Jordsjo) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the mare was inclined to lay in throughout the event and raced greenly.

ZIGGING AROUND (A. Chung) - shifted out on jumping away contacting OUR JOURNEYMAN. Inconvenienced near the 400 metres when taken wider by INOTELL.

## RACE 4: JP CABINETS BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

TANNER (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained that the gelding only travelled fairly and was disappointing when asked for an effort in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MR WHITACRE (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RED DYNAMO (NZ) (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly.

KINGSON (E. Annells) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.





RACE 4: JP CABINETS BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres (Cont'd)

TAJAVEDO (G. Lo) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

Following the running of this event S. Logan was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel, was ruled unfit to fulfil her remaining engagements and was transported to hospital for further observation.

RACE 5: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

FALLOW (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

L'IL PIPER (D. Caboche) - shifted in shortly after the start onto FREE WILMA. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

WANDERING EYE (A. Chung) - shifted out shortly after the start onto FREE WILMA. In the vicinity of the 150 metres rolled in and became awkwardly placed on the heels of ORIENTAL GIFT for a short distance.

FREE WILMA (K. Zechner) - inconvenienced shortly after the start when tightened between WANDERING EYE, which shifted out slightly at the same time as L'IL PIPER shifted in slightly. Held up for a short distance inside the 200 metres and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

AMANI FARASI (C. Lions) - jumped away awkwardly.

SERIOUS MOONLIGHT (E. Boyd) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: LOCAL LIQUID CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

COMPARDY (E. Boyd) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Hung out throughout the event.

CAPTAIN SOLO (NZ) (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

WIFE FREE ZONE (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HAYZELLE (J. Toeroek) - near the 200 metres was inclined to lay in for a short distance.

CONFINEMENT (K. Zechner) - shifted in approaching the 100 metres onto ARTFUL TEEPA, which was obliged to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight.

ANJAH (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly.

ARTFUL TEEPA (E. Annells) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres. In the vicinity of the 100 metres had to be steadied to avoid the heels of CONFINEMENT, which shifted in. In being steadied shifted out and was forced to be taken hold of when it became awkwardly placed on the heels of CONFINEMENT for a number of strides.

RACE 7: ECO CLEAN RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres


AXECAPITAL (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - laid in under pressure in the straight and inside the 100 metres shifted in onto BRAZEN HEAD.

LOFTY TYCOON (J. Toeroek) - inconvenienced on jumping away.

BONIFACE (NZ) (A. Chung) - shifted out abruptly shortly after the start onto LOFTY TYCOON.

ONWARD (C. Lions) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

OUR BENEVENTO (D. Caboche) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped UP.



#### RACE 7: ECO CLEAN RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres (Cont'd)

UP (T. Voorham) - shifted out on jumping away and bumped OUR BENEVENTO. Rider explained that she was given no firm instructions in this event however, after finding herself caught wide without cover in the early stages, she elected to roll forward to obtain the lead. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DAM RELIABLE (NZ) (G. Lo) - slow into stride.

BRAZEN HEAD (M. Collett) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres when it was obliged to alter course. Inside the 100 metres was inconvenienced and obliged to alter course when AXECAPITAL (NZ) shifted in.

#### RACE 8: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

SIR JOHNSON (E. Wong) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 400 metres was inconvenienced and taken wider when contacted by UNSCOPEABLE. Laid in under pressure over the concluding 200 metres.

GIVEPEACE A CHANCE (M. Collett) - rider reported that in her opinion, the gelding did not handle the soft track condition.

ROAR (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OBLIQUE LINE (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

TYCOON DREAMING (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPENCER GULF (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

UNSCOPEABLE (F. Atkinson) - laid out in the vicinity of the 400 metres brushing SIR JOHNSON. Continued out and rounding the home turn, shifted out and became awkwardly placed on the heels of SIR JOHNSON for a short distance.

#### RACE 9: TUNARAMA COACHLINES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

THE MASTER (K. Crowther) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

TREMBLING (E. Boyd) - rider reported the gelding slipped behind rounding the home turn.

KIROSHIMA (C. Lions) - shifted out on jumping away contacting LICORICE BULLET. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 700 metres rolled out and contacted LICORICE BULLET, which had to momentarily steady.

MAIDEN GRACE (T. Voorham) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was found to be unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew MAIDEN GRACE at 4.19 pm.

ARTFULABEERS (D. Caboche) - held up form inside the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight.

SYLVITE (A. Jordsjo) - refused to proceed to the start. A late scratching by order of Stewards at 5.24 pm. Co-Trainer Mr J. Dunn was advised the mare would be required to proceed to the start in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

BEDLOE'S ISLAND (S. Metcalfe) - rider struck the inside partition of the barriers on jumping away and the horse shifted out slightly, resulting in the rider becoming unbalanced and dislodged. S. Metcalfe was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel who advised that she was uninjured.

LICORICE BULLET (F. Atkinson) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by KIROSHIMA. In the vicinity of the 700 metres was inconvenienced and got its head up when contacted by KIROSHIMA.
