

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln
Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on
Sunday, 24 October 2021

RACE 1: AVIS PORT LINCOLN MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

ALMARHOE (C. Lions) - raced greenly throughout the event.

GOD OF ROCK (E. Annells) - jumped away very awkwardly and shifted out onto ARTFUL CATE.

PERFECT VOYAGE (J. Toeroek) - on jumping away shifted in. Near the 400 metres and was taken wide by ZARAFSHAN, which shifted out. Shortly after the entrance to the straight, was inclined to lay in and brushed with ZARAFSHAN.

ARTFUL CATE (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto LADY HUNTSMEN. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

CASSANDRA ISABEL (M. Collett) - dipped shortly after the start.

LEAVE IT TO ME (E. Wong) - inside the 800 metres shifted in onto ZARAFSHAN which was hanging out and was obliged to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in the future.

REBEL'S HONOUR (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

ZARAFSHAN (A. Chung) - hung out from inside the 800 metres then shifted out and was obliged to be steadied as LEAVE IT TO ME shifted in. Near the 400 metres, shifted out off the heels of LEAVE IT TO ME, taking PERFECT VOYAGE and SMART ACE wider. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mount straight. Shortly after the entrance to the straight, was inclined to lay out and brushed with PERFECT VOYAGE.

SMART ACE (E. Boyd) - on jumping away, reared and shortly after clipped the heels of PERFECT VOYAGE, which shifted in as LADY HUNTSMEN was taken out. Near the 400 metres was taken wider by PERFECT VOYAGE, which was taken wider by ZARAFSHAN. Rider explained that it was her intention to settle further forward on the filly in today's event, however was unable to comply due to the way that SMART ACE began.



RACE 1: AVIS PORT LINCOLN MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

LADY HUNTSMEN (A. Jordsjo) - on jumping away was taken out by ARTFUL CATE.

RACE 2: IMPACT SIGNS MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

ONEMORE MARSHALL (S.Metcalf) - shortly after being loaded became fractious in its barrier and attempted to bury under the front of its barriers and made heavy contact with its head. Was examined by the vet who ruled the gelding to be unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew ONEMORE MARSHALL at 1:41pm. Co-trainer, Mr J Dunn, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manner.

TIAMAT (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped OUR JOURNEYMAN.

INOTELL (K. Crowther) - rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

AXESTOCK Girl (NZ) (A. Chung) - held up for clear running from near the 150 metres until approaching the finish.

MARGIN OF ERROR (D. Caboche) - inside the 600 metres, shifted out, taking RIGHT TURN wider. Rider reported that the gelding changed stride on a number of occasions during the event.

JUSTEDEE (C. Murray) - Stewards granted C. Murray permission to ride the gelding 0.5kg over its declared weight of 54.0kg. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OUR JOURNEYMAN (K. Zechner) - on jumping away, bumped with TIAMAT which shifted out. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RAMBLER GAMBLER (B. Price) - rider reported that the gelding laid out during the event.

RIGHT TURN (E. Annells) - slow in to stride. Inside the 600 metres was taken wider by MARGIN OF ERROR, which shifted out.

RACE 3: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

PAULO PACE (K. Zechner) - near the 200 metres was disappointed for a run between ISA SECRET and MIDNIGHT BRAWLER, which shifted out slightly. As a result was obliged to shift in and then became held up from the 150 metres until near the finish.

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ) (S. Metcalfe) - near the 200 metres rolled out.

MIRTHDALE (B. Price) - began well.

FEARLESS AL (A. Chung) - reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin.

ISA SECRET (A. Jordsjo) - rider explained in relation to the mares performance that it travelled well during the event, however when asked for an effort from just prior to entering the home straight the mare failed to let down as she had anticipated and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIR JOHNSON (E. Wong) - prior to the running of this event, Co-trainer, Mr G. Searle, advised Stewards that he would instruct the rider to be more forward in today's event. Settled midfield. Mr G. Searle was advised under AR100 of his obligations to notify Stewards of a change of instruction, no later than 30 minutes prior to the race. From the 900 metres, raced wide without cover.





RACE 4: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210

Metres

KINGSON (E. Annells) - on jumping away was crowded between SASSY MANEUVER and ANGEL'S WISH, which both shifted ground. Near the 1100 metres, when racing keenly, was obliged to be steadied as SCARY GO ROUND shifted in slightly. From that point on, over raced in early and middle stages of the event. Near the 900 metres rolled in when racing keenly and being steadied. Was held up for clear running from 150 metres until the finish of the race. When questioned in relation to her riding of the gelding in the straight, rider explained her instructions were to lead on the gelding as is its normal pattern. However, being crowded at the start and receiving early interference, she was obliged to settle further back. As a result the gelding did not race genuine and had a tendency to over race. Rider said that she became held up from rounding the home turn for a short distance and from shortly after the entrance to the straight. She elected to attempt a run to her inside between RED DYNAMO and COMPARDY. However, that run did not eventuate due to both runners shifting ground. Therefore near the 150 metres, she elected to shift out to attempt a run to the outside of COMPARDY and inside SCARY GO ROUND. However, shortly after she positioned herself between those runners, that run also appeared to close. She continued on an outwards path. She was only able to obtain clear running just prior to the winning post and as a result, the horse was not fully tested to the line. Stewards noted the rider's explanation.

CAPTAIN SOLO (NZ) (K. Crowther) - jumped away very awkward and reared. As a result was slow to begin, losing approximately 2-3 lengths. Rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer, Mr S. Cahill was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

L'IL PIPER (D. Caboche) - rider reported that the mare felt sore in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities

SCARY GO ROUND (J. Toeroek) - near the 1100 metres, shifted in onto KINGSON which was racing keenly and was obliged to be steadied. The rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in the future.

ANGEL'S WISH (A. Jordsjo) - near the 900 metres was obliged to be steadied when awkwardly placed between the heels of REGINA DEL DRAMMA and KINGSON which rolled in slightly when racing keenly.

REGINA DEL DRAMMA (E. Wong) - bounded on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities

RACE 5: MAGIC 89.9 THE HIT MUSIC STATION BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

WINTER HARBOUR (E. Wong) - near then 1000 metre dip, for no apparent reason. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

BRUTAL POWER (D. Caboche) - fractured in its barrier after being loaded. Was examined by the vet and passed fit to start.

AVORA SUN (K. Zechner) - rider reported that the mere felt short in its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NEEDA (T. Voorham) - dipped on jumping away and as a result the rider became unbalanced. Rider reported that it was her intention to settle more forward in today's event. However, given the mare commenced awkwardly, she was obliged to settle further back.





RACE 6: MCDONALDS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP (1) - 1350 Metres

LOFTY TYCOON (J. Toeroek) - rider explained in relation to the gelding performance that it jumped well and travelled fairly in the early stages of the event. However, from inside the 1000 metres, he began to become concerned with the gelding's action and it had commenced to hang in. He added that he allowed the horse to travel into the event, however, was off the bridle and continued to hang in. After putting the gelding under strong riding approaching the 400 metres, he continued to be concerned with the gelding's action and from shortly after the entrance to the straight elected to ease the horse out of the event and not ride it out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROAR (E. Boyd) - rider explained that it never travelled during the event. It was her intentions to lead or settle on pace, however the gelding failed to show any early speed which is inconsistent with its previous races. She added that the gelding felt comfortable in its action during the event. However, when placed under pressure in the straight, the gelding dipped on a number of occasions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPENCER GULF (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

ART MUSIC (C. Lions) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination in its tie-up stall as it appeared to have blood in its mouth and was passed fit to start.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (B. Price) - rider explained in relation to the geldings performance that it travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event. However, when asked to improve from inside the 400 metres it failed to let down and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have atrial fibrillation. Trainer, Mr M. Cornell, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

BRAZEN HEAD (M. Collett) - hung out under pressure in the straight and near the 150 metres, shifted out abruptly.

HARDASHIAN (T. Voorham) - Stewards questioned trainer, Mrs A. Harder, in relation to the gelding's improved performance in today's event. She explained that the gelding was given a let up prior to its last start at Port Lincoln and may have been lacking some fitness. She added that during that run on 3 October, the horse ran wide without cover and was given a hard run during that race. She added that in relation to today's performance that the gelding benefited from last start with the additional fitness, the better barrier draw today and had a more favourable settling position in running.

RACE 7: PORT LINCOLN GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP (2) - 1350 Metres

TREMBLING (E. Boyd) - slow into stride.

UNSCOPEABLE (F. Atkinson) - held up for clear running for a short running distance at the entrance to the straight. Laid in for the remainder of the event.

RACE 8: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

MAJESTIC MISSILE (R. Hurdle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MASTER (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped with WANDERING EYE. Near the 150 metres, laid in for a short distance and brushed MAIDEN GRACE.

WANDERING EYE (C. Murray) - on jumping away, was taken out by THE MASTER and bumped with CHATAFOX.

MR PIQUET (C. Lions) - jumping away, lost its position when tightened onto MAJESTIC MISSILE as CHATAFOX was taken out.



RACE 8: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

MAIDEN GRACE (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly. Hung out under pressure in the straight. Near the 150 metres, brushed with THE MASTER.

SYLVITE (B Price) - shortly after the start was unable to improve its position when awkwardly placed between BEDLOE'S ISLAND and MAJESTIC MISSILE.

CHATAFOX (M. Collett) - on jumping away was taken out by WANDERING EYE onto MR PIQUET.
