TRACK: Soft 5 (Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)
Upgraded to Good 4 at 12.10 pm retrospective to Race 1 (Track with some give in it)

INTERIM REPORT

RACE 1: WHITE CLAW HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BROTHER'S SHADOW (NZ) (J. Opperman) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RESIDUE (P. Gatt) - taken in onto STRATISFACTION on jumping away by MAKING CONTACT. Approaching the 200 metres was inconvenienced when contacted by EYES NEVER LIE and was forced to race in restricted room between that filly and the heels of BROTHER'S SHADOW (NZ) until near the 150 metres.



RACE 1: WHITE CLAW HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

MAKING CONTACT (T. Pannell) - shifted in shortly after the start onto RESIDUE.

ZYCLONIC (R. Hurdle) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, from the vicinity of the 300 metres did not respond to his riding and had weakened from the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EYES NEVER LIE (J. Holder) - laid in under pressure in the straight and approaching the 200 metres shifted in and contacted RESIDUE. Rider reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised he would be required to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight in future.

VALENTIGRA (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure over the concluding 100 metres.

STRATISFACTION (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was hampered when RESIDUE was taken in. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 2: CANADIAN CLUB HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute owing to a delay with an interstate race.

DEBT COLLECTOR (J. Opperman) - contacted on jumping away.

REYNOLDS (GB) (T. Pannell) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

AZZUREOUS (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and brushed DEBT COLLECTOR.

BIARCHI (S. Logan) - laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the race.

RACE 3: DAVID LOY HANDICAP - 2038 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes due to a delay with an interstate race.

BRAMFIELD (G. Lo) - slow to begin. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

STAR STATUS (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto BRAMFIELD, and shortly after was hampered when taken onto the heels of JACK'S A CRACKER by EXALTED RUTH.

EXALTED RUTH (R. Hurdle) - on jumping away shifted out and away from FLOW METER onto STAR STATUS.

JACK'S A CRACKER (J. Opperman) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DON'T WAIVER (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early stages whilst being restrained. Laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLOW METER (J. Maund) - shifted out on jumping away onto EXLATED RUTH.

PLYMPTON (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres.

APPLIED (J. Holder) - Stewards permitted J. Holder to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg.





RACE 4: IRISH SPRING FLING AT MORPHETTVILLE - SATURDAY NOVEMBER 6TH HANDICAP - 1530 Metres

BOLT BY (T. Voorham) - raced in restricted room between AZZURO BIANCO and COLD BEERS, which shifted in, from near the 250 metres until the 200 metres and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

JAAMINT (K. Crowther) - rider explained that she had intended to settle on pace; however, after being crossed early, and due to the speed of other runners to her outside, she had found herself further back than she had anticipated.

AXECAPITAL (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly.

WHISKEY 'N' WOMEN (J. Opperman) - lost its off side winker near the 250 metres.

COLD BEERS (S. Logan) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 300 metres when it shifted in to obtain clear ground, and in doing so inconvenienced BOLT BY.

ZOUSTORM (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 5: THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

TOORAK WARRIOR (C. Jones) - slow to begin and shortly after was hampered and lost its position when ASTON RAPOVA was taken in across its running line. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance at the entrance to the straight and inside the 300 metres dipped for no apparent reason. Rider reported that the gelding made excess respiratory noise throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIDARM (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ASTON RAPOVA.

ASTON RAPOVA (B. Vorster) - contacted on jumping away and taken in onto TOORAK WARRIOR. Inclined to shift about under pressure over the concluding 200 metres.

A THOUSAND DEGREES (C. Lions) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

EXALTED GOLD (S. Logan) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

AKKACAN (K. Zechner) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres.

LADY PAVLI CHENKO (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Lost its off fore plate during the event.


CIBACHROME (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 6: MELBOURNE CUP DAY AT MORPHETTVILLE - TUESDAY NOVEMBER 2ND HANDICAP - 1200 Metres


The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

OCEAN REWARD (J. Opperman) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 100 metres.

PERFECT COMMAND (T. Pannell) - rider explained that he had been instructed to obtain a position on pace; however, after jumping away well the gelding was off the bridle and as a result he found himself wide without cover and in a position much further back than he had hoped.



CROWNED MONARCH (K. Crowther) - lost its near fore plate en route to the start and required to be re-plated. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 6: MELBOURNE CUP DAY AT MORPHETTVILLE - TUESDAY NOVEMBER 2ND HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

STORM VOYAGER (B. Vorster) - following the declaration of acceptances Trainer, Mr D. Carrison, made a gear application to remove winkers from the mare's race gear. Stewards acceded this request and acting under AR206(2) fined Mr Carrison \$200.

DEEVINE (J. Holder) - Stewards permitted J. Holder to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 300 metres.

HARBOURING (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7: QUBE LOGISTICS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately one minute due to a delay with an interstate race.

SESAR (J. Opperman) - hampered on jumping away when contacted by SAVS FINALE.

BOLD STAR (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that it was her intention to obtain a position behind midfield; however, after jumping away well the gelding improved into a forward position of its own accord.

EXTRA TIME (J. Holder) - held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.

GEM OF SCOTLAND (G. Lo) - laid out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SAVS FINALE (C. Jones) - shifted in on jumping away onto SESAR. Rider reported that the gelding made excess respiratory noise during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TAKEN OFF (K. Crowther) - near the 600 metres was hampered and forced to stop riding for a number of strides when racing in restricted room between SAVS FINALE, which shifted out slightly at the same time DESIGNER CHEF was taken in slightly by BOLD STAR. Shortly after was unable to improve its position when it commenced to lay out and was only able to obtain clear ground on straightening.

DESIGNER CHEF (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly.

ROCK THE RING (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Correct weight was delayed to allow R. Hurdle to view the official image and the vision in the straight.

RACE 8: JOHN LETTS CUP - 1800 Metres

CHAPEL CITY (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

REGALO DI GAETANO (J. Toeroek) - laid out under pressure over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

MONGOLIAN MARSHAL (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - near the 100 metres accidentally dropped his off side rein when pulling his whip through to his right hand.

RITRATTO (J. Holder) - trainer, Mr M. Huxtable, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle midfield with a cover. Settled last with cover.





RACE 8: JOHN LETTS CUP – 1800 Metres (cont'd)

CLASSY JOE (J. Maund) – rider explained that the gelding felt uncomfortable throughout the event and he became concerned with its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIGN OF USSURI (B. Vorster) – laid in under pressure in the straight and near the 200 metres shifted in onto PERFECT ROUTE.

PERFECT ROUTE (P. Gatt) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 200 metres had to be momentarily steadied when tightened onto MONGOLIAN MARSHAL (NZ) by SIGN OF USSURI.

BLOW TORCH (C. Murray) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

MEEHNI (K. Crowther) – fractious in the horse transport en route to the course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was ruled unfit to start. First aid administered. Co-trainers, Messrs T & C McEvoy, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

Correct weight was delayed to allow the Stewards to review the vision over the concluding 200 metres of the event.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES RIZIZ SPRINT SERIES FINAL – 1100 Metres

MUM'S MY HERO (G. Lo) – contacted at the start.

AADELAD (B. Vorster) – slow to begin, and shortly after was inconvenienced when tightened between BRYAN'S BABE, which shifted out, and HARPUNA, which shifted in. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out rounding the home turn.

TRYGVE (T. Pannell) – near the 800 metres shifted out slightly at the same time as SPIN THE REWARD shifted in and as a result raced in restricted room for a short distance.

CALL ME CURTIS (T. Voorham) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted MUM'S MY HERO.

SPIN THE REWARD (R. Hurdle) – near the 800 metres shifted in slightly onto TRYGVE. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

BRYAN'S BABE (J. Holder) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and approaching the 600 metres shifted out and away from HELLO LADIES onto CALYPSO REIGN. Held up from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres, and then became held up again over the concluding 50 metres.

RANGER FRANK (J. Potter) – raced in restricted room over the concluding 50 metres resulting in the rider was unable to test his mount.

HARPUNA (K. Zechner) – near the 150 metres eased and altered course to the outside of GAZE GRISE to obtain clear ground.

HELLO LADIES (M. Aitken) – raced fiercely in the middle stages and became awkwardly placed between heels. Near the 200 metres was disappointed for a run to the outside of SPIN THE REWARD when that gelding rolled out slightly and was obliged to alter course to its inside to obtain clear ground.
