RACE 1: ENERGETIC LIGHTING / NORDLUX THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

HOT SPARKY (E. Boyd) - awkward to begin. Raced keenly and wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

RUSHAWAY LAD (C. Murray) - slow to begin. Approaching the 600 metres, improved onto the heels of ARRAN BAY, and when being restrained away from the heels of ARRAN BAY, got its head up and raced ungenerous for a number of strides.



RACE 1: ENERGETIC LIGHTING / NORDLUX THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres (cont'd)

MIKKI MOUSE (B. Vorster) - the filly broke down approaching the 200 metres and was eased out of the event by its rider immediately thereafter. The filly was attended to by a race day veterinarian. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a fracture to its near hind tibia and consequently the filly was humanely euthanased. Rider reported that the filly travelled well during the event, however approaching the 200 metres, became awkward in its action behind and broke down, and consequently he eased the filly from the event.

SADLER'S SONG (T. Voorham) - Rider reported that the filly raced greenly during the event.

RACE 2: REXCO PEOPLE MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres

ANGRY ANT (A. Livesey) - shifted in near the 1400 metres tightening CARRY THE MUSKET, which was taken in slightly and tightened onto TIAMAT making slight contact with that horse. As a consequence CARRY THE MUSKET was obliged to be steadied for several strides to avoid the heels of ANGRY ANT. Rider was severely reprimanded for shifting ground when insufficiently clear.

CARRY THE MUSKET (E. Wong) - near the 1400 metres was tightened by ANGRY ANT which shifted in and as a consequence made slight contact with TIAMAT and had to be steadied for several strides to avoid the heels of ANGRY ANT.

FAMILY ADDITION (P. Gatt) - shifted in at the start and contacted AXESTOCK GIRL (NZ). Lost its near fore plate in running.

AXESTOCK GIRL (NZ) (K. Zechner) - contacted at the start by FAMILY ADDITION. Near the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve and crossed the running of THE MARKLE SPARKLE which was taken wider as a consequence. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

ROCK STORM (G. Lo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MARKLE SPARKLE (S. Metcalfe) - near the entrance to the straight was inconvenienced when crossed by AXESTOCK GIRL (NZ) and as a consequence was taken wider on the track.

TIAMAT (A. Jordsjo) - was inclined to race keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 1400 metres was obliged to race in restricted room to the inside of CARRY THE MUSKET, and was contacted by that gelding, as that horse received pressure from ANGRY ANT which shifted in. Was momentarily inconvenienced near the entrance to the straight by THE MARKLE SPARKLE which was taken wider by AXESTOCK GRIL (NZ) which shifted out.

RACE 3: MCMAHON SERVICES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

SEBONNA (K. Zechner) - inside the 600 metres had its hindquarters brushed by IOWA HAWKEYE which was taken out by COMFORT GIRL as that horse received pressure from its inside.

TATALINA (NZ) (A. Chung) - inside the 600 metres shifted out to improve to the outside of DETENTORE (NZ) and in doing so tightened COMFORT GIRL onto IOWA HAWKEYE which was obliged to be checked and lost its position when tightened onto SEBONNA. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding for shifting ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Thursday, 4 November 2021 and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 10 November 2021, a period of 3 meetings. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IOWA HAWKEYE (D. Caboche) - lost its near fore plate during the event. Inside the 600 metres was obliged to be checked and lost its position when tightened by COMFORT GIRL which was taken out by TATALINA (NZ). As a consequence IOWA HAWKEYE was tightened onto SEBONNA which maintained its line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 3: MCMAHON SERVICES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (cont'd)

COMFORT GIRL (J. Holder) - contacted at the start. Inside the 600 metres was taken out by TATALINA (NZ) which shifted out to improve and as a consequence shifted out onto IOWA HAWKEYE, tightening that horse onto SEBONNA resulting in IOWA HAWKEYE having to be checked losing its position.

DETENTORE (NZ) (D. Tootell) - near the 1200 metres was momentarily inconvenienced and was obliged to shift to the outside of CHARMED INDIVIDUAL (NZ) as that horse shifted in to take up a position closer to the rail. Rider reported that the gelding travelled well, however, when asked for an effort, did not respond in the manner he expected and added that he became concerned with the gelding's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

CHARMED INDIVIDUAL (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - awkward to begin. Shifted out and contacted COMFORT GIRL. Raced keenly in the early stages. Near the 1200 metres shifted in and inconvenienced DETENTORE (NZ) which was obliged to shift out as a consequence. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to shift ground only when sufficiently clear.

RACE 4: TOYOTA AUSTRALIA HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

TRADEWIND (A. Livesey) - very awkward to begin and raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

NOT A ZAK (NZ) (P. Gatt) - shifted in at the start and contacted SANBUCK.

MONTIGN (A. Jordsjo) - was awkward to begin.

BIG ACHEEVA (T. Pannell) - was awkward and slow to begin. Contacted shortly after the start by MORPHETT ROAD which shifted in. Rider explained that after suffering a little interference shortly after the start, the gelding travelled only fairly and when the field sprinted, his mount felt disunited in its action and did not respond in the manner he expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected heart rate.

SANBUCK (C. Jones) - awkward to begin. Shifted out and contacted NOT A ZAK (NZ).

MORPHETT ROAD (E. Finnegan) - shifted in at the start, contacted BIG ACHEEVA and thereafter laid in throughout the event.

RACE 5: RINNAI MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

JOHNNY THUNDER (G. Lo) - proved a little unruly after leaving the mounting yard, galloped for some distance enroute to the barriers before dislodging its rider, and then galloped riderless for a short distance before being captured behind the barriers. Examined by the veterinary surgeon at the barriers who declared the gelding unfit to start. Acting on veterinary advice, Stewards declared the horse a late scratching at 2:57pm. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and was declared fit to fulfil his remaining engagements. Trainer, Mr W. Clarken was advised that a warning had been placed on this gelding in relation to its pre-race manners.

JOURNEY TO PETRA (J. Holder) - awkward to begin, shifted in and contact BELLAVARDO (NZ).

SIPSMITH (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

WICKED ADDICTION (J. Potter) - awkward to begin. Near the 900 metres shifted in and crossed the running of VINTAGE FOLLY which was momentarily inconvenienced. Approaching the 100 metres had its hindquarters turned when contacted by RISING LEGEND, which was tightened and taken in by VINTAGE FOLLY, which shifted in. Was inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

CHEF MILITAIRE (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event and raced in restricted room for a short distance in the vicinity of the 300 metres.





RACE 5: RINNAI MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

RISING LEGEND (T. Pannell) - from near the 200 metres, attempted to improve into running between WICKED ADDICTION to its inside and VINTAGE FOLLY to its outside. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to be restrained when racing in restricted room as VINTAGE FOLLY shifted in gradually for some distance. As a consequence had to be steadied and was unable to maintain its momentum for a number of strides.

TEA RAV (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - raced very greenly in the straight and was inclined to lay in.

VANILLA MYSTIC (A. Chung) - commenced to race very keenly from near the 1000 metres and approaching the 800 metres became awkward on the heels of JOURNEY TO PETRA and when being restrained, shifted out abruptly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the horse bled from both nostrils. First aid was administered. Trainer, Ms M. Ruberry, was advised that as this was the mare's first bi-lateral bleed VANILLA MYSTIC would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

VINTAGE FOLLY (B. Vorster) - lost its near hind plate during the event. Near the 900 metres was obliged to alter course to the outside of WICKED ADDICTION, which shifted in, and thereafter raced in restricted room for a short distance between WICKED ADDICTED and JOURNEY TO PETRA, and was hampered. Approaching the 100 metres, shifted in gradually and tightened RISING LEGEND onto WICKED ADDICTION resulting in RISING LEGEND contacting the hind quarters of WICKED ADDICTION and having to be steadied. =Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future when his mounts commence to shift ground.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (T. Voorham) - contacted at the start.

RACE 6: HOMEWARD FINANCE HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

CHUCKY (E. Wong) - rider reported that the gelding made excess respiratory noises from the middle stages and on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YOU ES MARSHAL (A. Chung) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by A. Chung and noted that he used it on four occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

RACE 7: COMPNOW HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

DIAMONDS (F. Atkinson) - began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted BUBBLES MCGINTY. Laid in, in the straight. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

CHAMPS D'OR (A Livesey) - raced very keenly in the early stages. Near the 300 metres when inconvenienced by SOMETHING FOXY which shifted out and away from GATSBY'S GIRL, which shifted out, was obliged to shift out over the heels of ULTIMATE ADDICTION.

GINNY ANN (P. Gatt) - shifted out near the 300 metres to improve its position, resulting in GATSBY'S GIRL shifting out and away from it.

ULTIMATE ADDICTION (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early stages. Rider reported that the mare hung out rounding the home turn.

GATSBY'S GIRL (M. Aitken) - near the 300 metres shifted out and away from GINNY ANN, which shifted out to improve and then shifted out onto SOMETHING FOXY, which was taken out onto CHAMPS D'OR, which was hampered.

BUBBLES MCGINTY (A. Chung) - shifted out at the start and contacted DIAMONDS. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to its near fore pastern.

SOMETHING FOXY (J. Maund) - near the 300 metres shifted out and away from GATSBY'S GIRL, which shifted out and inconvenienced CHAMPS D'OR.



RACE 8: MRS PROPERTY SKYBEAU STAYERS SERIES FINAL - 2500 Metres

SLIPINTOTHIS (NZ) (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the early stages and had difficulty obtaining clear running from rounding the home turn until near the 300 metres.

EXALTED AMBITION (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early stages.

SMILING ASSASSIN (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MARYMOUNT LASS (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ALL HARD WOOD (J. Maund) - raced wide without cover throughout. Laid in, in the straight.

BALDY (F. Atkinson) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: WHITE CLAW HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

WE WILL REMEMBER (C. Jones) - awkward to begin. Raced very keenly in the early stages of the event.

SPANGIRL (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

LEORBIT (E. Wong) - which had not raced since September 2020 was examined by the veterinary surgeon prior to the event and passed fit to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BARTENDER BLUES (A. Chung) - awkward to begin.
