RACE 1: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60
HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

BROTHER'S SHADOW (NZ) (B. Price) - following the declaration of acceptance trainer, Mr T. Doudle, made application to the Stewards that a cross-over nose band be added to the gelding's gear. Stewards acceded to the request. Mr Doudle was fined \$200 under AR206(2).

GOOD APPROACH (C. Lions) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained that the gelding showed no early speed and changed stride on a number of occasions. She added that after putting the gelding under hard riding from approaching the 600 metres it responded well and finished the event off strongly.

BOLD DISCENT (E. Wong) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr W. Drewitt, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

BLOOMIN' JOHNNEY (S. Metcalfe) - on jumping away bumped with ORIEDOS. Rider explained that the gelding never travelled during the event and felt awkward in its action, particularly in the hind legs. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the off fore cannon.

CHASING STARS (T. Voorham) - hung in throughout the event.

ORIEDOS (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped with BLOOMIN' JOHNNEY. Raced greenly in the straight.

MR MAVAHEEDY (A. Jordsjo) - proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Jumped away awkwardly. Raced greenly in the straight.



RACE 2: EYRE PENINSULA 765.5CC RADIO FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

BEERS ON BILL (K. Crowther) - near the 700 metres dipped.

CROWNED KING (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped SWEET MINSKY (NZ). Hung in under pressure in the straight and proved difficult to ride out.

EL REY (E. Wong) - dislodged its rider after exiting the mounting yard. E. Wong was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements. Slow to begin.

GOD OF ROCK (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and became awkward on the heels of SWEET MINSKY (NZ), which shifted in.

ALSAMENU (B. Price) - required to have its bridle adjusted on arrival at the barriers.

MAKE A SPLASH (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Rider explained that the mare had breathing difficulties during the event and therefore was inclined to hang out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWEET MINSKY (NZ) (S. Logan) - on jumping away bumped CROWNED KING, which shifted out.

TERELLI (F. Atkinson) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

ZARAFSHAN (K. Zechner) - near the 700 metres dipped.

Following this event E. Wong was re-examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 3: TOWN & RURAL FENCING BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

COMPARDY (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover and hung out throughout the event.

FIRE THUNDER (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

RACE 4: RAISE A GLASS TO SCOTT ALDRIDGE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

ONEMORE MARSHALL (K. Crowther) - on jumping away bumped with ALMARHOE, which shifted out.

POCKET PENNY (E. Wong) - hung out at the entrance to the straight and contacted DUGGEE'S BOY, which was inconvenienced.

ALMARHOE (C. Lions) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped ONEMORE MARSHALL. Hung out from near the 1200 metres for the remainder of the event.

DUGGEE'S BOY (C. Murray) - at the entrance to the straight was inconvenienced when tightened onto BURNING HARD as POCKET PENNY, which was hanging out, shifted out. Laid in for the remainder of the event.

RAMBLER GAMBLER (B. Price) - on jumping away was taken wider by BURNING HARD, which shifted out.

TELEPORTATION (K. Sardelic) - slow to begin approximately two lengths. Rider reported that the mare laid out during the event.

ANGRY ANT (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

BURNING HARD (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out taking RAMBLER GAMBLER wider.





RACE 4: RAISE A GLASS TO SCOTT ALDRIDGE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1350 Metres (cont'd)

RIGHT TURN (E. Annells) – failed to muster speed in the early stages of the event. Rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it was off the bridle from shortly after the start and commenced to hang in from the 1200 metres for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: IN MEMORY OF GEORGE DAWSON BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP (1) - 1250 Metres

SORRIDERE (A. Chung) – jumped away awkwardly.

BRUTAL POWER (D. Caboche) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

AVORA SUN (K. Zechner) – laid out over the concluding stages of the event.

TREMBLING (F. Atkinson) – trainer, Mr B. Lear, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to be more forward in this event. Settled forward of midfield.

DINNER LAKE (E. Wong) – slow into stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JAY PEE BEE (NZ) (E. Boyd) – on jumping away dipped. Laid in at the entrance to the straight for a short distance and was inclined to lay in over the concluding stages of the event. Approaching the finish was inconvenienced as BRAZEN HEAD shifted out and away from BRUTAL POWER.

BRAZEN HEAD (K. Sardelic) – shifted out and away from BRUTAL POWER from near the 200 metres until the finish.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow E. Boyd (JAY PEE BEE (NZ)), placed fourth, and stable employee, Mr B. Pumpa, to view the vision in the straight.

RACE 6: PB & KG GASKELL CONTRACTORS BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP (2) - 1250 Metres

LOFTY TYCOON (E. Annells) – rider explained in relation to the gelding's poor performance that it travelled well in the early stages of the event; however, from the 600 metres dropped the bridle and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed superficial skin abrasions to the near side stifle.

TAJAVEDO (G. Lo) – inside the 200 metres was taken wider by CHONCAPE, which shifted out.

TYCOON DREAMING (A. Chung) – inside the 200 metres was inconvenienced when attempting to improve to the outside of TAJAVEDO, which was taken out.

CHONCAPE (F. Atkinson) – inside the 200 metres shifted out taking TAJAVEDO wider. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in future.

SERIOUS MOONLIGHT (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported that the gelding dipped on a number of occasions during the event.

RACE 7: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

PAULO PACE (K. Zechner) – near the 300 metres hung in and shifted in abruptly onto NEAR MAGIC, which was hampered for a number of strides.

SCARY GO ROUND (E. Annells) – near the 300 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of NEAR MAGIC, which was hampered. Near the 200 metres was disappointed for a run between PAULO PACE and OBLIQUE LINE, which both shifted ground, and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

MISS ELEGANCE (E. Wong) – on jumping away dipped and as a result its rider became unbalanced for a number of strides.



RACE 7: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres (cont'd)

NEAR MAGIC (C. Lions) - near the 300 metres was hampered and lost ground as PAULO PACE shifted in abruptly.

SHINSEKI (A. Chung) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

HARDASHIAN (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISTA KNOWITALL (A. Jordsjo) - contacted a perimeter fence in the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

OBLIQUE LINE (S. Logan) - approaching the 1200 metres, when racing keenly, became awkwardly placed on heels and was obliged to be restrained.

RACE 8: VETS ON EYRE FOUR-YEAR-OLD & UP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

FALLOW (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in abruptly onto FOSSHIO, which lost its position.

FOSSHIO (R. Hurdle) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto STAR PARFAIT by FALLOW, which shifted in abruptly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

THE MASTER (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out abruptly onto STAR PARFAIT, which lost its position. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR PARFAIT (A. Chung) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto FOSSHIO as THE MASTER shifted out abruptly. As a consequence the rider partially lost the use of his near side iron. Approaching the 400 metres, when racing keenly, the rider's left foot came free from his near side iron, and as a result he was dislodged from STAR PARFAIT. A. Chung was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled uninjured in the incident. A post-race veterinary examination of STAR PARFAIT revealed no visible abnormalities.

KIROSHIMA (C. Lions) - on arrival at the start required its tongue-tie to be replaced; however, it was unable to be refitted. Acting on confirmed advice from trainer, Mr M. White, that the gelding could compete in the event without the tongue-tie and Stewards permitted the gelding to race without it.

MAIDEN GRACE (T. Voorham) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.
