## RACE 1: JONES ELECTRICAL MAIDEN PLATE (1) - 1250 Metres

ROMPER STOMPER (B. Price) - raced wide without cover throughout majority of the event.

SOLIS ORTUS (R. Hurdle) - forced wide rounding the home turn.

TWO HANDS (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

CASSABELLA (A. Chung) - forced wide rounding the home turn when awkwardly placed on the heels of ANGRY ANT which shifted out.

I GOT STRINGS (C. Lions) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the horse laid in, in the straight.

JULIEJULIEJILLY (F. Atkinson) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

STRIP CLUB (G. Lo) - shifted ground when placed under pressure in the straight.

## RACE 2: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES MAIDEN PLATE (2) - 1250 Metres

EXPRESS ZONE (R. Hurdle) - tightened at the start between SOUMAH and TIAMAT which shifted in, resulting in the horse losing ground.

PRESCIENT (C. Murray) - hung out from the 800 metres and raced greenly. Rider dropped his whip near the 100 metres.

SOUMAH (B. Price) - tightened and bumped by EXPRESS ZONE at the start.

YOUNG SHELDON (A. Chung) - fractious behind the barriers and bumped heavily with ROCK STORM. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.



RACE 2: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES MAIDEN PLATE (2) - 1250 Metres (cont'd)

ROCK STORM (T. Voorham) - fractious behind the barriers and bumped heavily with YOUNG SHELDON. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TIAMAT (K. Zechner) - on jumping away, shifted in and tightened EXPRESS ZONE onto SOUMAH.

WITCH QUEEN (E. Boyd) - rider reported that she had concerns with the horse's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small lesion to the near hind leg.

FREE STANCE (A. Jordsjo) - refused to load. Acting on this advice Stewards declared FREE STANCE a late scratching at 1.25 pm. Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt, was advised that the filly must load without delay in an official barrier trial prior to a future race start

ROWDY DIVA (E. Wong) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages and got its head up on several occasions.

RACE 3: MCMERRY CHRISTMAS MAIDEN/CLASS ONE PLATE - 1750 Metres

ONEMORE MARSHALL (J. Toeroek) - rider reported the gelding hung out for majority of the event and laid in under pressure in the straight.

SHOWBAG (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

VANCOUVER VELVET (K. Zechner) - near the 1400 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of HAYZELLE.

HAYZELLE (D. Caboche) - raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

RAMBLER GAMBLER (B. Price) - raced wide from the 900 metres.

RACE 4: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

MY MATE SONNY (E. Annells) - shifted in near the 1200 metres and bumped RED DYNAMO (NZ). Shifted in between the 200 metres and 100 metres when placed under pressure, resulting in MESSERSCHMITT running awkwardly on its heels. Rider reported that the horse raced greenly throughout the event. Rider was advised to exercise more care.

RED DYNAMO (NZ) (A. Chung) - near the 1200 metres shifted out and bumped MY MATE SONNY.

MESSERSCHMITT (B. Price) - held up for clear running between the 500 metres and 250 metres behind ISA SECRET and to the inside of RED DYNAMO (NZ). From the 200 metres to the 100 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of MY MATE SONNY, which shifted in under pressure.

LEONARDA (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly.

ISA SECRET (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities other than the mare losing its left hind plate.

LADY CONQUISTADOR (T. Voorham) - near the 250 metres was disappointed for a run behind MIRTHDALE and to the inside of RAISE AN ARMY. Near the 200 metres got its head up when reluctant to improve to the inside MIRTHDALE.

RACE 5: CELEBRATE NYE AT PORT LINCOLN RACING CLUB BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

ALKAAMEL (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

TAJAVEDO (F. Atkinson) - near the 900 metres shifted in and away from JOURNICA and tightened LUGA LAD on its inside.





RACE 5: CELEBRATE NYE AT PORT LINCOLN RACING CLUB BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres (cont'd)

JOURNICA (S. Callow) - rider reported that the horse hung out throughout the event and over the concluding stages of the race and felt uncomfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LUGA LAD (C. Murray) - near the 900 metres was tightened and obliged to be steadied on the inside of TAJAVEDO.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

RELAXED (C. Lions) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SHEZA LITTLE POSH (A. Chung) - contacted a gate on leaving the parade ring. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race.

CHUCKLES (E. Wong) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration on the off fore pastern.

RACE 6: SHIELDS SECURITY CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

THE MASTER (K. Zechner) - fractious in the barrier and got its head and shoulders underneath the front gate. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew THE MASTER at 3.56 pm. Trainer, Mr B. Cozamanis, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

FREE WILMA (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly.

BRAZEN HEAD (D. Caboche) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TRIVAGO GIRL (E. Boyd) - rider explained, upon entering the straight, she was initially hesitant to obtain a run inside BRAZEN HEAD, which shifted in slightly; however once the run opened up, her horse improved quickly into that run.

RACE 7: TOWN AND RURAL FENCING BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

EFFORTKAT (J. Toeroek) - rounding the turn near the 400 metres was tightened and obliged to be steadied between GOOD TIME MADAM, which changed legs and shifted out slightly, and VIRAGO MISS, which momentarily shifted in.

WAR CHEVAL (C. Lions) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and tightened MAIDEN GRACE onto STAR PARFAIT. Hung out rounding the home turn.

TROUBLED TIMES (E. Boyd) - rider explained that in the early stages of the straight, she attempted to improve into a run between WAR CHEVAL and MAIDEN GRACE; however that run closed so she elected to shift to the outside of WAR CHEVAL, which again shifted out and as a result she was unable to test her mount fully to the end of the race.

LULU DESIGN (K. Crowther) - laid in, in the early stages of the straight.

MAIDEN GRACE (G. Lo) - tightened at the start between STAR PARFAIT and WAR CHEVAL, which shifted out. Trainer, Mr T. Jolly, reported that after the race, the horse returned with its tongue over the bit. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR PARFAIT (K. Zechner) - tightened at the start between MAIDEN GRACE and RAHEEBA.

VIRAGO MISS (E. Wong) - shifted in momentarily near the 400 metres. Rider was advised to exercise more care.

SOMETHING FOXY (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination upon arrival at the barriers and passed fit to start.

RAHEEBA (S. Callow) - tightened at the start and lost ground.



RACE 8: JOHN MARMION MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

FEARLESS AL (B. Price) - hung in in the straight and proved difficult to ride.

BONIFACE (NZ) (K. Zechner) - near the 1200 metres overreacted, got its head up and lost ground when racing in restricted room between GIVEPEACE A CHANCE and CENTRE SCOOTA, which shifted in slightly.

ONWARD (E. Boyd) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SASSY MANEUVER (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped NEAR MAGIC.

CHONCAPE (F. Atkinson) - laid in, in the straight.

SORRIDERE (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

CENTRE SCOOTA (D. Caboche) - on jumping away was buffeted between BONIFACE (NZ) and SORRIDERE, which shifted in, causing the gelding to lose ground. Near the 1200 metres tightened on the inside of SASSY MANEUVER.

NEAR MAGIC (G. Lo) - when jumping away was hampered on the inside by SASSY MANEUVER and lost ground.
