Racecourse by the Ceduna Racing Club on
Saturday, 15 January 2022

RACE 1: TERRYWHITE CHEMMART/ WCT RURAL/ WILKINSON PLUMBING/ DEMPSEY'S SADDLERY & FEED SUPPLIES MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

GOOD TIME MADAM (S Callow) - near the 250 metres was taken wider by SUBUKI.

SUBUKI (D. Tootell) - slow to begin. Near the 250 metres shifted out to obtain clear ground taking GOOD TIME MADAM wider. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by D. Tootell and noted that he used it on four occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

RACE 2: VITERRA AUSTRALIA BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

LANCER (J. Doyle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

A THOUSAND DEGREES (D. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

WAR CHEVAL (C. Murray) - Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg.

RACE 3: TOYOTA AUSTRALIA FEATURE SPRINT - 1200 Metres

TANNER (J. Doyle) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. When questioned in relation to her tactics in this event, rider explained that she was instructed to obtain a position in the lead or settle on pace. Trainer, Mr. T. Montgomerie, confirmed the instructions and added that he advised his rider not to restrain the gelding. After taking evidence from all parties and viewing the official footage, Stewards advised J. Doyle that in their

opinion she had set too quick a tempo in the early and middle stages. J. Doyle acknowledged, in hindsight, she may have set too quick a tempo and in future would be more cautious in giving effect to her instructions.

FIRE THUNDER (C. Murray) - Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the mare 1.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg. Refused to proceed to the start. Stewards withdrew FIRE THUNDER at 2.16pm. Stewards ordered that the monies invested on FIRE THUNDER prior to the time of its withdrawal be subject to the deductions 42 cents in the dollar for the win. Trainer, Mr T. Trenowden, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare with regards to its pre-race behaviour.

RACE 4: NUMERICAL REAL ESTATE BENCHMARK 52 TROPHY RACE - 1300 Metres

ALKAAMEL (F. Atkinson) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

ART MUSIC (C. Murray) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages in the event however, when placed under pressure, failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TREMBLING (M. Vassallo) - slow to begin. Rider explained when placed under pressure over the concluding stage failed to respond to riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUKE OF CASTILLE (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

ARTFUL TEEPA (P. Crich) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR132(6)(b) in relation to using the whip forward of the rider's horse's shoulder.

RACE 5: CEDUNA FORESHORE HOTEL CEDUNA CUP - 1600 Metres

KALAMON (S. Callow) - rider explained the gelding never travelled in today's event. She added that in her opinion, KALAMON may have resented the kickback and failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IT'S HUMPHREY (J. Doyle) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BELLS 'N' BOWS (D. Tootell) - stood flat footed as the start was affected and was slow to begin, losing approximately five lengths. Trainer Mr T. Montgomerie was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

RACE 6: LETCHER MORONEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS/ MIDSEC FINANCIAL ADVISORS BENCHMARK 52 TROPHY RACE - 1600 Metres

RELAXED (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly.

ICE HUNT (F. Atkinson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE LEPRECHAUN (C. Murray) - Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the gelding 1.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg. Hung in under pressure and proved difficult to ride out in his normal manner over the concluding stages of today's event.
