TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Downgraded to a Soft 5 at 12:23 pm (Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RACE 1: TAYLORS WINES MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

FREDDY THE EAGLE (P. Gatt) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto SIRIANNI by MANAGE THE CYCLE.

MANAGE THE CYCLE (J. Eaton) - shifted out on jumping away contacting FREDDY THE EAGLE.

TAVIKAT (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly. Hung in under pressure in the straight, placing its rider at a disadvantage. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: TPI ASSOCIATION OF S.A. BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

FIELD OF ROSES (J. Toeroek) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

LOMAX (E. Boyd) - slow to begin.

HARBOURING (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CONCONI (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 3: COOPERS BREWERY MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

HOSTESS SUSIE (E. Boyd) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

LADY BERLINETTA (M. Collett) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto KAMALANI (NZ) by HARMONIOUS STAR. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the mare raced greenly throughout the event.

TIGER QUEEN (J. Toeroek) - shifted out on jumping away onto KAMALANI (NZ).



RACE 3: COOPERS BREWERY MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

TRUE AIM (J. Maund) - rider reported that the filly laid out throughout the event.

HARMONIOUS STAR (J. Potter) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr D. Carrison was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its pre-race manners. Jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto LADY BERLINETTA.

KAMALANI (NZ) (K. Crowther) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened onto LADY BERLINETTA by TIGER QUEEN.

HONEY PERFECTION (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres

CLASSY KENNY (J. Maund) - hung out from near the 800 metres until the entrance to the straight.

SPECIAL BOOM (E. Boyd) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported that she had become concerned with the gelding's action from inside the 400 metres and for that reason did not ride her mount out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RATTLESNAKE RIDGE (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly.

SPIRIT ABOVE (C. Jones) - inconvenienced shortly after the start when the gelding shifted in and away from RATTLESNAKE RIDGE onto KID KINGDOM.

UNDOUBTEDLY LUCKY (S. Metcalfe) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by EIGHT RUBIES. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding was inclined to lay in throughout the event.

VICTORY TIME (J. Toeroek) - slow to begin and shortly after was inconvenienced by VICTIMISE, which shifted in.

EIGHT RUBIES (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto UNDOUBTEDLY LUCKY. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight. Near the 50 metres shifted out onto VICTIMISE. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

VICTIMISE (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto VICTORY TIME. Near the 50 metres had to be steadied momentarily when EIGHT RUBIES shifted out.

RACE 5: AEP HEALTH GROUP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

GRAND HOST (L. Overall) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TOORAK WARRIOR (J. Toeroek) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground at the entrance to the straight, became disappointed and held up when attempting a tight right to the inside of RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE and outside of GENERAL MINT and due to the formation of the field was unable to obtain clear ground to the finish and was untested to the line.

TURF TAPPER (R. Hurdle) - disappointed when attempting a tight run approaching the 200 metres and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

SAHARA SONG (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

NORDIC LASS (A. Lindsay) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NORTHERN SUPERSTAR (J. Maund) - slow to begin.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (D. Tourneur) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DAWNBURST (E. Boyd) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

MAID IN MILAN (P. Gatt) - laid in over the concluding 200 metres.



RACE 6: COUNTRY LIVING HOMES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

RICHED (R. Hurdle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HEADPHONES (S. Callow) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MALINONG CLUB (S. Logan) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

WHEN STARS ALIGN (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 7: HENSON LLOYD ACCOUNTANTS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

ELEMENTAE (A. Chung) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event when being restrained to allow I'M KENNY to cross.

FOX D'OR (C. Rawiller) - contacted on jumping away. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

SAWTELL (NZ) (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted FOX D'OR. At the entrance to the straight was disappointed when attempting a run to the inside of LOVE FROM LUCY and altered course to obtain clear ground; however, had difficulty obtaining clear ground from near the 200 metres until approaching the 50 metres.

LOVE FROM LUCY (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 200 metres was unable to obtain clear ground and was obliged to alter course to do so.

DANAYI (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by E. Annells and noted that she used it on six occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.
