Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln
Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on
Wednesday, 13 April 2022

RACE 1: REMEMBERING GERALD SCHLINK MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by two minutes.

VON GEORGE (B. Price) - had to be resaddled behind the barriers. Rider was reminded of his obligation under AR132(6)(b) for using his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.

SECOND LAST CHANCE (M. Collett) - hampered on jumping away when PROUD MARY shifted out. Raced greenly in the early stages of the event.

PROUD MARY (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SECOND LAST CHANCE. Shifted ground and inclined to lay out over the concluding stages. Rider was reminded of his obligation under AR132(6)(b) for using his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.

ANGRY ANT (H. Yuen) - Rider, H. Yuen could not claim her full allowance and was only able to claim 1.5 kg of her 2.kg her minimum riding weight. Rider was reprimanded under AR143(14).

SAVVY MAK (NZ) (S. Logan) -underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. After being loaded was fractious in the barriers and reared on a number of occasions. A further veterinary examination revealed the mare fit to start. Trainer Mr R. King was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.



RACE 2: EP LIVESTOCK & REAL ESTATE AND MARINA HOTEL & APARTMENTS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed six minutes.

LORAINE'S FLOWJO (C. Murray) - hampered on jumping away by BUILDING CASTLES, which shifted out.

INTO THE FURY (L. Neindorf) - laid in when placed under pressure in the straight.

KINGSLEY (S. Callow) - dislodged its rider and jumped the outside fence near the 1200 metres mark and was recaptured some distance later off course. Acting on veterinary advice KINGSLEY was withdrawn by order of Stewards at 1.19pm. Rider was examined by First Care Medical Personnel and was passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements. Co-Trainer Mr G. Richards was advised the gelding would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race. A veterinary examination revealed the gelding had sustained superficial lacerations and skin abrasions.

CASSABELLA (H. Yuen) - jumped away awkwardly and raced wide throughout the event.

PERFECT ZED (S. Metcalfe) - rider was reminded of her obligation under AR132(6)(b) for using her whip in an action that raised her arm above shoulder height.

BUILDING CASTLES (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and hampered LORAINE'S FLOWJO.

HARMONIOUS STAR (M. Collett) - rider was reminded of her obligation under AR132(6)(b) for using her whip in an action that raised her arm above shoulder height. Rider was also advised not to use her whip when her mounts are out of contention.

SIR GRUMPY (D. Caboche) - raced wide throughout the event.

RACE 3: RUSTIK COVE/THE BAY ROOM BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

WOTUWANT (L. Neindorf) - hampered on jumping away.

BRAZILLIANT (M. Collett) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

JONQUEST (B. Price) - crowded on jumping away between JUSTICA and WOTUWANT.

JUSTICA (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and crowded JONQUEST onto WOTUWANT.

STORM VOYAGER (D. Caboche) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 4: OCEANNIA JEWELS RATING 0-56 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

WAR CHEVAL (S. Logan) - kicked behind the barriers by another runner. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (L. Neindorf) - had to be steadied near the 150 metres when racing in restricted room between ZARAFSHAN and DUCHESS NICCI, which was inclined to lay out. Shifted back to the inside of the heels of WAR CHEVAL to continue into clear running, resulting in DUCHESS NICCI being taken in approaching the winning post. Rider was advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

DUCHESS NICCI (S. Callow) - passing the 800 metres had to be steadied when briefly tightened for room to the inside of MR PIQUET, which shifted in slightly. As a result, over-reacted and made contact with the running rail. Taken in over the concluding stages by I'M OH SO PRETTY.





RACE 4: OCEANNIA JEWELS RATING 0-56 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (Cont'd)

MR PIQUET (J. Doyle) - shifted in when passing the 800 metres briefly tightening the running of DUCHESS NICCI, which had to be steadied. Rider was reminded of her obligations to ensure she leaves sufficient racing room for runners to her inside.

Correct weight was delayed to allow S. Callow (DUCHESS NICCI) placed fourth, to view the official footage in the vicinity of the 800 metres and approaching the finish.

RACE 5: DOUG WATSONS MENSLAND BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

CROWNED KING (A. Chung) - laid in, in the early part of the straight and near the 200 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of the tiring PAULO PACE.

MESSERSCHMITT (S. Metcalfe) - briefly held up rounding the home turn, on the heels of LUCKY DOG, which laid out.

PAULO PACE (A. Lindsay) - raced wide in the early stages of the event.

RIVERSIDE ROCK (B. Price) - jumped out at the start and hampered COMPARDY.

IT'S HUMPHREY (J. Doyle) - got its head up at the start.

TIME WARRIOR (L. Neindorf) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

LUCKY DOG (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out rounding the home turn Near the 200 metres shifted in and crowded the running of COMPARDY. Rider was reminded of her obligations to stop riding and straighten her mounts sooner than she did on this occasion.

MR WHITACRE (K. Crowther) - laid in rounding the home turn and in the early part of the race.

COMPARDY (S. Logan) - dipped at the 1100 metres and again in the 700 metres. Laid out rounding the home turn. Near the 200 metres was crowded for room when awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of LUCKY DOG, which shifted in slightly after being inclined to lay in early in the straight.

RACE 6: LIENERT ENGINEERING "BUD WOOLFORD MEMORIAL" BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

AXECAPITAL (NZ) (K. Crowther) - rider could offer no excuse for the disappointing performance of the gelding. She stated that AXECAPITAL (NZ) was unsuited by the solid early tempo, however despite her urgings, was a beaten horse from the 800 metres and was disappointing to the finish off the race, when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr D. Carrison, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

THE MASTER (E. Annells) - leaving the winning post on the first occasion, had to be steadied away from the heels of CRAZY CULPRIT, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Over-raced for some distance in the early stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Trainer Mr B. Cozamanis was fined \$100 under AR206(1) as THE MASTER had raced in blinkers, which was not part of its approved gear.

HAND TO HAND (NZ) (S. Callow) - inconvenienced over the concluding stages when GALAXY FALLS laid in.

SIRMAZE (L Neindorf) - Shifted back to the inside of THE MASTER at the entrance to the straight tightening the running of GOTTABITON. Rider was reprimanded for careless riding under AR 131 (a). Shifted out over the concluding stages and again inconvenienced GOTTABITON.

VANCOUVER VELVET (B. Price) - raced wide during the middle stages of the event.





RACE 6: LIENERT ENGINEERING "BUD WOOLFORD MEMORIAL" BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP
- 1750 Metres (Cont'd)

CRAZY CULPRIT (C. Murray) - shifted in passing the winning post on the first occasion near the 1500 metres when insufficiently clear of THE MASTER. Rider was advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

GOTTABITON (A.Chung)- Had to be steadied approaching the 150 metres when SIRMAZE shifted in when not clear. Inconvenienced close to the finish when SIRMAZE shifted out.

GALAXY FALLS (D. Caboche) - laid in early in the straight and over the concluding stages and was inconvenienced by HAND TO HAND, which shifted out slightly. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(6)(a) for using his whip forward of the gelding's shoulder and was fined \$200.

NEAR MAGIC- When questioned regarding the improved performance of the gelding, compared to its previous two unplaced efforts, trainer Mr M White, stated the gelding had derived benefit from its first start for over a month, when backing up a week after Balaklava on 6th April. He added that, although the gelding mixes his form, he had been successful over this distance on his home track three starts ago and was suited being back up to the 1750 metre journey.

RACE 7: DK QUARRIES KIMBA CUP - 1960 Metres

PORT ROYAL (D. Caboche) - hampered on jumping away by LEONARDA, which shifted out. Laid out in the straight.

BRAMFIELD (L. Neindorf) - rider of fourth placegetter, pleaded guilty to a charge under AR211 for weighing in, in excess of 1kg overweight and was fined \$200. In assessing penalty, Stewards considered rider's good record and guilty plea.

LEONARDA (K. Crowther) - jumped out at the start and hampered PORT ROYAL.

BURNING HARD (M. Collett) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore tendon. First aid administered. Trainer, Mrs A. Harder, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RACE 8: THE BEAUTY COLLECTIVE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

CHONCAPE (L. Overall) - jumped away awkwardly and had to be steadied away from ANGEL'S WISH, which shifted in slightly.

PRESCIENT (C. Murray) - Weakened from the 500m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor post-race recovery.

MISTA KNOWITALL (A. Chung) - slipped in front and knuckled badly on jumping away, losing ground.

SASSY MANEUVER- (S.Callow) - slipped on jumping away and lost ground.

CELERITATE REGEM (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly. Had to be steadied near the finish when improving onto the heels of ONWARD and then shifted back to the inside of that runner to continue into clear running. Lost its off hind and off fore plates during the event.

ANGEL'S WISH (B. Price) - laid out over the concluding stages.

WHITCHETY GRUB (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and lost ground at the start.
