## RACE 1: ELDERS MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

THIRTY TWO GUNS (D. Caboche) - slow to begin, approximately two to three lengths. Near the 200 metres raced in restricted room between ANGRY ANT and BLAZE OF COLOUR and as a result, contacted the hindquarters of BLAZE OF COLOUR.

BLAZE OF COLOUR (M. Collett) - near the 200 metres had its hindquarters turned by THIRTY TWO GUNS, which was racing in restricted room.

READY FOR A MOET (K Crowther) - trainer Mr G. Lynch was reprimanded under AR65(1) for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for this mare. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards.

## RACE 2: WESTERN AG MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

DANGEROUS WAR (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres rolled in onto TONY MONTANA. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 2: WESTERN AG MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

MELINKE (J. Opperman) - prior to the running of race one, Trainer Mr L. Creek made an application to the Stewards that the gelding race with blinkers as it had trialed in them recently in Mount Gambier and he had failed to make the request prior. Stewards acceded to the request and Mr Creek was fined \$200 under AR206.

SANDHILL KNIGHT (A. Chung) - hung out rounding the home turn and in the straight and proved difficult for the rider to ride out in his normal manner.

TONY MONTANA (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 100 metres was momentarily inconvenienced as DANGEROUS WAR, which was laying in and rolled in.

PARIS DOLL (C. Jones) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

SANDHILL TUTU (E. Annells) - raced greenly throughout the event.

SHIMURA (B. Price) - shortly after the start was unable to improve its position when awkwardly placed between the heels of SANDHILL TUTU and FLOYD'S PREDICITON (NZ).

FINE THINGS (K. Walters) - inside the 800 metres raced in restricted room for a short distance and raced ungenerously between PARIS DOLL and SANDHILL KNIGHT.

RACE 3: NUTRIEN AG / G M HARFIELD MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

ROHLON DRUNK (J. Opperman) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

LANCASTER SOUND (B. Price) - hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

THINEISTHEKINGDOM (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced since December 2019 and was passed fit to start. Slow to begin.

GRAND HOST (A. Jordsjo) - laid out rounding the home turn.

RACE 4: PPHS BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

BRIGADIER (NZ) (K. Walters) - on exiting the home straight on the first occasion was taken wider by EAGLES FOREVER, which hung out.

DYAGILEV (E. Annells) - over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

FLOW METER (J. Maund) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it is a 12 year old and was passed fit to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALL HARD WOOD (S. Fawke) - acting on advice from Co-Trainer Ms C. Riggs that the gelding had injured itself in the float en route to the course, in particular had large skin abrasions to the off side hip and therefore would be unfit to start. Stewards declared ALL HARD WOOD a late scratching at 8.28 am. Ms Riggs was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to a future trial or race.

EAGLES FOREVER (K. Crowther) - on exiting the home straight on the first occasion, hung out taking BRIGADIER (NZ) wider.

GOOD GIRL BELLA (E. Finnegan) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUEBECOIS (J. Eaton) - rider reported in relation to the mare's performance that it travelled well in the early and middle staged of the event however, when asked for an effort shortly after the entrance to the straight, failed to let down as she had expected and raced flat to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 5: TRANS AUSTRALIA / COMBINED CARRIERS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

PEWTER (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event and as a result, inconvenienced MULGA LIL (NZ).

MANHATTAN ARCH (J. Maund) - held up for clear running from the 400 metres until the 200 metres. When questioned in relation to the gelding's performance, the rider stated MANHATTAN ARCH was not suited to the tempo of today's race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LONGMIRE (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MULGA LIL (NZ) (C. Jones) - approaching the finish was inconvenienced as PEWTER, which was laying in, shifted in.

DABAY (A. Jordsjo) - raced keenly in the lead.

RACE 6: TDC RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BITAEQUI (R. Hurdle) - trainer Mr G. Lynch was reprimanded under AR65(1) for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for this mare. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. On jumping away knuckled and shifted in hampering CALL ME ARCHER, which lost its position. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 100 metres, when weakening, rolled out.

CALL ME ARCHER (M. Collett) - on jumping away was hampered and lost its position when tightened onto NICANTELLYA as BITAEQUI knuckled and shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (S. Logan) - hung out rounding the home turn and was held up for clear running until inside the 200 metres. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to be checked when awkwardly placed between the heels of LADY ANNABEL (NZ), which was inclined to lay in and BITAEQUI, which rolled out when weakening.

ANGEL'S WISH (B. Price) - knuckled on jumping away.

COMIENDO (J. Opperman) - on jumping away bumped with LADY ANNABEL (NZ).

LADY ANNABEL (NZ) (E. Boyd) - on jumping away shifted out and bumped COMIENDO. Dipped approaching the 400 metres. Laid in approaching the 100 metres.

RACE 7: SAL RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

LATEST BENTLEY (J. Eaton) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until approaching the 100 metres. Near the 200 metres attempted a very tight run to the inside of FERGIE, which rolled in and as a result, had to be checked and shift out in an attempt to gain clear running.

NOBLE ROCKS (J. Opperman) - slow to begin.

FERGIE (E. Finnegan) - near the 200 metres rolled in onto LATEST BENTLEY, which attempted a tight run to its inside and was obliged to be checked. Rider reported it was not her intention to lead in the event however, after being trapped wide, she elected to allow FERGIE to roll forward.

FANCIED (D. Tourneur) - near the 100 metres shifted in abruptly and momentarily inconvenienced GOODNESS GRACIE and continued to shift in onto LAST DREAM (NZ), which was obliged to be steadied momentarily. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in future.

GOODNESS GRACIE (D. Caboche) - near the 100 metres was inconvenienced as FANCIED shifted in abruptly.



RACE 7: SAL RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres (Cont'd)

LAST DREAM (NZ) (E. Boyd) - inside the 100 metres was momentarily steadied as FANCIED which had improved quickly to its outside and shifted in abruptly.
