## RACE 1: RJM PASTORAL HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TIME WARRIOR (R. Hurdle) - raced in restricted room when attempting a tight run to the inside of NORDIC LASS approaching the finish and was unable to be fully tested to the line. Rider explained the gelding did not travel as well as expected and was back in distance today .A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SCARLET RIVER (A. Livesey) - laid in, in the straight.

KIROSHIMA (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly.

IT'S NEVER ENUFF (J. Doyle) - slow to begin. Approaching the 100 metres became disappointed for a run to the inside of TIME WARRIOR, which rolled in and elected to shift out to obtain clear running to the finish.

LEAN THY ARMS (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - slow to begin.

## RACE 2: BILLA KALINA PASTORAL CO MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

AUGUSTA POWER (C. Murray) - had its hindquarters bumped on jumping away by SEND IT.

PLUTONIUM (J. Potter) - contacted on jumping away by JULIEJULIEJILLY.

SQUEAKY GATE (S. Metcalfe) - rider reported after jumping away fairly was caught wide and was unable to take up a forward position near to the rail. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEND IT (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped the hindquarters of AUGUSTA POWER and lost its position.

FLUFFY BUNNY FEET (A. Livesey) -Stewards acceded to a request from Trainer Mr T. Montgomerie that the filly race without its cross-over noseband in today's event and was reprimanded under AR206(2).

JULIEJULIEJILLY (D. Caboche) - Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54 kg. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted PLUTONIUM. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: OLDFIELD MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

WAR CHEVAL (C. Murray) - raced greenly in the straight. Approaching the finish rolled in and tightened the running of MAID IN MILAN. Rider reminded of his obligations and advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

MAID IN MILAN (A. Lindsay) - stood flat footed as the start was affected and as a result, was slow to begin (approximately 6 lengths). Approaching the finish was tightened for running by WAR CHEVAL. Trainer Mr G. Lynch was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Stewards to view the vision of the start.

RACE 4: JIM HIGGINS MEMORIAL MAIDEN PLATE - 1396 Metres

GALLANT RUN (F. Atkinson) - rolled out shortly after the start tightening the running of VARIARA. Rider reported the gelding raced greenly in the middle stages of the event.

HILL ROAD RAIDER (L. Overall) - shortly after the start rolled in and tightened DENMANSURA.

EXILE TED (J. Potter) - bumped on jumping away by CLEO BAY.

VARIARA (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly. Shortly after the start and tightened onto FREE STANCE by GALLANT RUN.

CLEO BAY (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped EXILE TED.

TOFFAMI (A. Lindsay) - refused to load. TOFFAMI was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 1.42 pm. Trainer Mr G. Lynch was advised that the mare would now be required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards and to load without delay prior to accepting for a future race.

DENMANSURA (E. Boyd) - tightened and lost its position shortly after the start between FREE STANCE, which was taken out and HILL ROAD RAIDER, which rolled in.

FREE STANCE (D. Caboche) - shortly after the start, lost its position when hampered between VARIARA and DENMANSURA when both shifted ground.

RACE 5: CROWN POINT PASTORAL COMPANY SQUATTER'S CUP - 1867 Metres



HARBOURING (S. Metcalfe) - laid out in the straight.

GOTTABITON (C. Murray) - Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54 kg.

#### RACE 5: CROWN POINT PASTORAL COMPANY SQUATTER'S CUP - 1867 Metres (Cont'd)

CHARLTON (J. Doyle) - raced wide throughout the event. Rider explained that her instructions were to encourage the gelding in the early stages of the event. She added that after beginning slowly, despite her efforts, CHARLTON was reluctant to maintain its contact with the field in the early stages. She further added that the gelding picked up the bridle in the middle stages and travelled well and rounding the turn, was inclined to lay in.

MONGOLIAN PRIDE (NZ) (B. Wong) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had raced in Gawler on 26 June 2022 and was deemed suitable to race.

NEAR MAGIC (E. Boyd) - laid out rounding the home turn and inside the 400 metres had to be momentarily eased to avoid the heels of GALAXY FALLS, which rolled in marginally.

GALAXY FALLS (J. Potter) - Stewards permitted J. Potter to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg. Rolled in, inside the 400 metres.

#### RACE 6: MAHANEWO STATION HANDICAP - 1396 Metres

RAISE AN ARMY (J. Potter) - rider returned to scale in excess of 0.5 kg below the weight as he was required to carry in the race. Stewards were able to determine that the lead bag that the rider had weighed out with had not been added to the saddle and were able to locate it at the stall where the gelding was saddled. Trainer Mr S. Cahill pleaded guilty under AR209(2)(b) in that he was the person at fault in relation to RAISE AN ARMY failing to carry the correct weight and was fined \$300. In arriving at penalty, Stewards took into account Mr Cahill's guilty plea and that the horse was placed fifth over the line, as a result, RAISE AN ARMY was disqualified from the event under AR209(2)(a).

IT'S MAGIC (R. Hurdle) - rider explained that as a result of being slower than expected to begin and was obliged to settle further back than anticipated and in his opinion, it did not appreciate the kick back from the event

FESTIVAL OF LIGHT (T. Voorham) - became fractious as the start was affected, reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin (approximately 3 lengths).

TWELVE STARS (S. Metcalfe) - became fractious as the start was affected and jumped away very awkwardly and was slow to begin (approximately 3 lengths). Trainer Mr B. Hotham was advised a warning had placed on the mare in relation to being fractious in the barriers.

CRAZY CULPRIT (D. Caboche) - laid out from the 400 metres.

SPENCER GULF (F. Atkinson) - laid in, in the straight placing the rider at a disadvantage over the concluding 100 metres and was unable to be fully tested to the line.

Correct weight was delayed to allow the Stewards to view the vision of the start.

#### RACE 7: BOLLARDS LAGOON PASTORAL COMPANY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BRUTAL POWER (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out in the straight.

RICHED (C. Rawiller) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(b) in that he used his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height and was reprimanded.

OBELOS (GB) (A. Lindsay) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had raced at Gawler on 26 June 2022 and was deemed suitable to race. Reared on jumping away, resulting in the gelding being slow to begin (approximately 6 lengths). Trainer Mr G. Lynch was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PIPE DREAMS (T. Voorham) - hung in throughout the event proving difficult to ride. In the vicinity of the 500 metres, when laying in, had to be steadied off the heels of DESERT KNIGHT. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: BOLLARDS LAGOON PASTORAL COMPANY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

CASE CLOSED (E. Wong) - when questioned regarding the improved performance, Trainer Mr M. Moosha explained that the gelding had benefited from its recent runs this preparation and the removal of blinkers may have allowed CASE CLOSED to settle better during the running of the event.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Stewards to view the vision of the start.

RACE 8: NONNING PASTORAL CO HANDICAP - 1498 Metres

GRIMESY (E. Wong) - commenced to buck shortly after the start. Trainer Mr G. Lynch was advised that the gelding would now be required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a sore lumbar. Trainer Mr G. Lynch was advised that a Veterinary Clearance is required prior to a future trial or race.

CALL ME ARCHER (C. Murray) - laid out rounding the home turn.

CHICK IN CHARGE (N. Yuen) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

READY FORA MOET (C. Rawiller) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had raced in Gawler on 26 June 2022 and was deemed suitable to race. Rider explained the mare never travelled throughout the event and was under pressure from the 500 metres and for that reason, he did not ride READY FOR A MOET out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
