RACE 1: KINGSFORD HOTEL HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

CHOCOCO (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MISOGYNIST (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Inconvenienced near the 50 metres when contacted by RUBINI, which had been taken in.

RUBINI (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin. Near the 50 metres was inconvenienced when tightened onto THE MISOGYNIST by CELTIC VADER.

CELTIC VADER (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Near the 50 metres shifted in onto RUBINI.



RACE 2: TAB MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

BE ABOVE (J. Holder) - slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from near the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

LUCKY BLUE (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SIR ARMINIUS (B. Vorster) - inconvenienced near the 50 metres when forced to race in restricted room to the inside of HANSOM MAN, which shifted ground.

WILLASTON (D. Caboche) - shifted out slightly near the 400 metres onto MILLA'S READY. Rider reported that in his opinion that gelding may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TEA RAV (NZ) (B. Price) - contacted on jumping away.

EXOPIPI (L. Neindorf) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MILLA'S READY (T. Pannell) - stood flat footed as the gates opened and as a result was slow to begin. Near the 400 metres was inconvenienced and obliged to be momentarily steadied when taken out onto MYSTIC STORM by WILLASTON. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISCHIEVOUS TYCOON (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MYSTIC STORM (E. Boyd) - inconvenienced near the 400 metres when its hind quarters were contacted by MILLA'S READY.

HANSOM MAN (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted TEA RAV (NZ). Inside the 200 metres was disappointed for a run to the inside of EXOPIPI and in altering course to obtain clear ground, shifted in near the 50 metres and inconvenienced SIR ARMINIUS.

STAY AT HOME (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: MATRIX SOLAR SOLUTIONS HANDICAP - 2100 Metres

TRUMPSTA (T. Voorham) - near the 600 metres rolled out slightly onto DROP THE ORANGE.

BLAZING REBEL (B. Vorster) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort at the entrance to the straight had only been one pace and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MANZALA (B. Price) - rider explained that the gelding had jumped away well and had improved to take up a position outside the leader of its own accord from the wide barrier.

AUSSIE SOJOURN (A. Chung) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FLOW METER (J. Maund) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DROP THE ORANGE (R. Hurdle) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres was hampered when tightened by TRUMPSTA.

STAYING STRONG (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

RACE 4: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

FOX D'OR (C. Rawiller) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour advised Stewards that the gelding would now be spelled.

LOMAX (J. Potter) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.





RACE 4: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP – 1700 Metres (cont'd)

SEA OF SECRETS (C. Jones) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SILENT DON (B. Price) – slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding was exhibiting signs of the thumps.

NICAJON (B. Vorster) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WOLF PRINCE (R. Hurdle) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

APPLIED (A. Chung) – held up from near the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

RACE 5: COOPERS BREWERY HANDICAP – 1500 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

HANKSTAR (C. Rawiller) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

TONGSAI BOSS (J. Holder) – slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CAFE TORTONI (T. Pannell) – rider became concerned with the gelding's action near the 1200 metres and eased it from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

GETOUTTHEWAY (R. Hurdle) – slow to begin.

ROBE BAY (B. Vorster) – refused to load and was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 1.59pm. Trainer, Mr P. Hardacre was advised that the mare was now required to load without delay on two separate occasions before next being allowed to start in a race, one of which must be an Official Barrier Trial, and the other either an Official Barrier Trial or an Approval to Race Jump-Out.

KYSHAKA (S. Metcalfe) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since 2 May 2021 and was deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: TRIMBOLI SERVICES HANDICAP – 1100 Metres

JABALI RIDGE (K. Crowther) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ASTON RAPOVA. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WOTUWANT (R. Hurdle) – slow to begin. Held up from approaching the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight.


OAMARU OWL (J. Maund) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

ASTON RAPOVA (B. Vorster) – contacted on jumping away.

ZION (NZ) (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THREE TEARS (S. Metcalfe) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: GC & J CONSTRUCTIONS HANDICAP – 1500 Metres



PRINCE JOFRA (R. Hurdle) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rolled out slightly near the 500 metres onto GARRIRE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BLUE LUNA (E. Wong) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 7: GC & J CONSTRUCTIONS HANDICAP - 1500 Metres (cont'd)

ALPINE FLYER (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

HALIFAX ROAD (S. Metcalfe) - at the entrance to the straight was hampered when tightened onto YELLOW IDOL by MAGICLANE.

SADLER'S SONG (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YELLOW IDOL (K. Crowther) - at the entrance to the straight had to be steadied when taken out onto the heels of SADLER'S SONG by HALIFAX ROAD, which had been taken out. Rider reported that the filly felt uncomfortable in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FAST AND FLEXIBLE (J. Potter) - had to be momentarily steadied near the 500 metres when GARRIRE was taken out into its running line.

MAGICLANE (D. Caboche) - at the entrance to the straight shifted out slightly onto HALIFAX ROAD, which was hampered when tightened onto YELLOW IDOL. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

GARRIRE (T. Voorham) - near the 500 metres was taken out into the running line of FAST AND FLEXIBLE by PRINCE JOFRA.

RACE 8: CORNERSTONE STUD HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

MIDNIGHT STORM (J. Holder) - eased down at the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Co-trainers, Mr L. Macdonald and Mr A. Gluyas were advised that as this was the gelding's second bi-lateral bleed MIDNIGHT STORM would now be ineligible to start in any race in accordance with AR79(6).

SESAR (A. Chung) - slow to begin.

STREET LIFE (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CONFIDANT (D. Caboche) - trainer, Ms K. Byrnes advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that she would instruct her rider to attempt to lead in the event if possible. Settled behind midfield.

MASTER CHUM (E. Annells) - obliged to alter course near the 150 metres to obtain clear ground.

RACE 9: HOLDFAST INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

SO YOU CAN (T. Voorham) - at the entrance to the straight was hampered when CHICAGO STORM laid in. Rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort at the entrance to the straight, failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GO BUNDLE (C. Rawiller) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by C. Rawiller and noted that he used it on three occasions over the final 100 metres of the event. Rider was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

PERFECT COMMAND (J. Benbow) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CROWNED MONARCH (S. Logan) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight. Inside the 100 metres was disappointed when attempting a run between PERFECT COMMAND and HONEY GO LIGHTLY and as a result did not obtain clear ground to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.





RACE 9: HOLDFAST INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

CHICAGO STORM (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Near the 350 metres laid in onto SO YOU CAN, which was inconvenienced.

REMARKABLES (S. Metcalfe) - approaching the 200 metres shifted out towards RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 200 metres had to be momentarily steadied when REMARKABLES shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SELF SUFFICIENT (C. Jones) - slow to begin.

GENERAL

Following the running of Race 3 Stewards received a report in relation to the conduct of rider, T. Voorham on pulling up. After taking evidence from rider, R. Hurdle and T. Voorham, Stewards charged T. Voorham under AR115(1)(a) in that she had misconducted herself on pulling up by making an inappropriate comment to R. Hurdle in response to a comment that he had made to her. T. Voorham pleaded guilty to the charge and was fined \$200. In determining penalty, Stewards took into account T. Voorham's clean record under this rule and her guilty plea. Acting under AR283(5) Stewards wholly suspended this penalty for a period of 12 months provided that she is not found guilty of a conduct related matter during that period. R. Hurdle was reminded of his obligations under AR193(c) in relation to not speaking to other riders (unless during the race) until dismounted.
