Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks
Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on
Saturday, 23 July 2022

RACE 1: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

GETOUTTHEWAY (C. Jones) - slow to begin.

DANISH FORTUNE (B. Vorster) - lost its near hind plate during the event.

RACE 2: SCHILD ESTATE HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

CASHIN' CHEX (NZ) (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 3: CONGRATULATIONS FLOW METER ON '200' HANDICAP - 2250 Metres

LORD BOUZERON (NZ) (J. Eaton) - shifted out onto SMILING ASSASSIN shortly after the start. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

SMILING ASSASSIN (E. Boyd) - inconvenienced shortly after the start. Rider reported that the gelding travelled fairly in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort had not let down in its normal manner. She added that approaching the finish and on pulling up she had some concerns with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CAPRICORN RIDGE (K. Crowther) - at the entrance to the straight had to be momentarily steadied when awkwardly placed between SILENT COMMAND and SMILING ASSASSIN.



RACE 3: CONGRATULATIONS FLOW METER ON '200' HANDICAP - 2250 Metres (cont'd)

PERFECT ILLUSION (GB) (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

FLOW METER (J. Maund) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: PFD FOODS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

EROS (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto ICE SYMPHONY. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 700 metres rolled out onto KUSU.

ICE SYMPHONY (B. Vorster) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto BONNIE GANGSTER by EROS. Raced greenly during the event.

KETCHIKAN (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the colt to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

KUSU (J. Toeroek) - near the 700 metres was hampered when it shifted in slightly at the same time as EROS rolled out. Raced greenly during the event.

LORD BENTLEY (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto ZEBELLA.

METAL MERIT (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr J. Cannon advised that the gelding would now be spelled.

RAJNISH (J. Eaton) - laid out over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

GALLIUM (J. Benbow) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RICH LADY (L. Neindorf) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ZEBELLA (K. Crowther) - inconvenienced on jumping away when taken out by LORD BENTLEY.

RACE 5: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

RIVER TWAIN (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(b) in that he used his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height and was reprimanded.

STREET LIFE (S. Metcalfe) - laid out under pressure in the straight.


RACE 6: DARREN FEY BIRTHDAY MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

WINNING WEATHER (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a speedy cut to the near hind coronet.

I'M A LEGEND (L. Neindorf) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUIETLY DISCREET (T. Pannell) - shortly after the start was taken out onto the hind quarters of ZARACE by KISHSTAR.

MR HAVE A CHAT (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr D. Jolly was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.



DEEVINE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Near the 200 metres was momentarily disappointed for a run between MR HAVE A CHAT, which shifted out slightly and SABERMETRIC, which shifted in and away from ZARACE, resulting in it making contact with SABERMETRIC on a number of occasions.



RACE 6: DARREN FEY BIRTHDAY MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

SABERMETRIC (B. Vorster) - near the 200 metres shifted in and away from ZARACE onto DEEVINE, which had been taken out slightly, resulting in these two runners making contact on a number of occasions and the gelding becoming unbalanced. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZARACE (C. Jones) -inconvenienced shortly after the start when its hind quarters were contacted. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: SPRING CARNIVAL AT MORPHETTVILLE (OCTOBER 8TH - NOVEMBER 5TH) HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

JACKS ON ICE (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHICAGO STORM (B. Vorster) - raced three wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

KNIGHTSTOWN (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly.

FORBIDDEN CITY (J. Benbow) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOORAK MISS (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 8: PIKE & JOYCE HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

The official start time for this event listed on the Racing Australia and Racing SA websites, race book and all paper work held by the Stewards and Starter was 4.02 pm. The race commenced one minute and 23 seconds (4.03.23 pm) after the official start time however, shortly after the start, Stewards became aware that the Sky Channel countdown clock showed that the race had commenced approximately 40 seconds early. Racing SA have commenced inquiries to ascertain the reasons the Sky Channel start time did not match that of the official start time.

TIME WARRIOR (B. Price) - unable to obtain clear ground over the concluding 50 metres of the event.

CLASSY KENNY (J. Maund) - shifted out shortly after the start onto STRYKE IN STYLE. Made the turn near the 1000 metres awkwardly, shifted out and then raced ungenerously for some distance.

KONG (J. Holder) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by J. Holder and noted that he used it on six occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

SHORT STORIES (E. Boyd) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by E. Boyd and noted that she used it on eight occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

STRYKE IN STYLE (T. Pannell) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto MORPHETT ROAD by CLASSY KENNY.

MAID IN MILAN (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MORPHETT ROAD (J. Benbow) - slow to begin.



RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES - NEW YEARLINGS AVAILABLE NOW! HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

VENUSIAN (C. Rawiller) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES - NEW YEARLINGS AVAILABLE NOW! HANDICAP
- 1400 Metres (Cont'd)

MONRAAJ (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RUN AND TELL (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MY KHALIFA. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider was advised to make a greater effort to keep her mount straight.

PIVOTAL FORCE (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUNNY GREEN (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MY KHALIFA (T. Pannell) - inconvenienced on jumping away. Near the 200 metres was disappointed for a run between TUPOLEU, which shifted out slightly at the same time as HEADPHONES shifted in, resulting in the gelding becoming held up until near the 100 metres.

HEADPHONES (L. Neindorf) - raced three wide without cover throughout the event.
