

# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown  
Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on  
Friday, 22 July 2022



RACINGSAA

TRACK: Soft 6 (Moist but not a badly affected track)  
Upgraded to a Soft 5 at 2:55pm, retrospective to Race 6  
(Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RAIL: Out 4 metres 1400 metres to 1200 metres, true remainder.

WEATHER: Overcast.

## RACE 1: WOOLSHED INN MAIDEN HANDICAP (1) - 1000 Metres

MR FERRARI (E. Annells) - slow to begin. Raced wide for the majority of the event.

GIVING CHEEK (K. Crowther) - hampered and lost ground at the start by DIVINE WATERS, which shifted out.

KATIM'S CLUB (C. Murray) - hung in and raced greenly in the straight.

WESTMINSTER ABBE (M. Collett) - near the 50 metres shifted out slightly and became awkwardly placed on the heels of DIVINE WATERS, which at the same time shifted in and as a result the gelding had to be eased. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUBY RIVER (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

DIVINE WATERS (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and hampered GIVING CHEEK. Near the 50 metres shifted in when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LUNATIC (F. Atkinson) - rider reported that the mare laid out when placed under pressure in the straight.



## RACE 2: BORDERTOWN AG MAIDEN HANDICAP (2) - 1000 Metres

ROLL THE DRUMS (J. Potter) - approaching the 100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of GYPSY SPIRIT resulting in that horse being tightened for room. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in similar circumstances. Near the 100 metres became awkwardly placed inside the heels of SASS SASS BOOM, which shifted in slightly.

SASS SASS BOOM (A. Livesey) - approaching the 100 metres shifted in slightly when placed under pressure and tightened ROLL THE DRUMS in onto GYPSY SPIRIT. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in similar circumstances.

AND THEN (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the mare had not raced for over one year and was deemed suitable to race.

THE SNOW BURNER (M. Collett) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced for over one year and was deemed suitable to race. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped ROUGE RENARDE. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly rounding the home turn.

GYPSY SPIRIT (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly, was slow to begin, shifted out and bumped BORN TO RUN (NZ). Shortly thereafter, the filly was hampered by GIALLO, which shifted out on jumping away. Approaching the 100 metres had to be steadied when tightened for room to the inside of ROLL THE DRUMS.

POCKET RAIDER (S. Metcalfe) - rider reported that the filly failed to travel for the majority of the event and proved disappointing when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GIALLO (H. Yuen) - shifted out at the start and hampered GYPSY SPIRIT. Shortly after the entrance to the straight was held up for clear running behind BORN TO RUN (NZ) and shifted out to improve, resulting in the mare carrying ROUGE RENARDE wider on the track.

ROUGE RENARDE (B. Price) - kicked by another runner upon arrival at the barriers, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. On jumping away was bumped by THE SNOW BURNER on its inside and as a result the mare shifted out and tightened SASS SASS BOOM. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

## RACE 3: DOAN PHARMACIES BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

GIGGLON (M. Collett) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

CONFIDANT (L. Overall) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and hampered FOUR WINDS.

YANACOCHA (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (K. Walters) - jumped away very awkwardly and lost ground.

FOUR WINDS (K. Crowther) - hampered at the start by CONFIDANT, which shifted in.

KILOWATT (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(b) for using his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height and was reprimanded.

## RACE 4: BORDERTOWN PUMPS & REFRIGERATION MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres

CAMBERWOOD (M. Collett) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and near the 800 metres had to be steadied away from heels in front. Approaching the 200 metres had to be momentarily steadied to avoid the heels of UNCHAINED LAD, which shifted out to improve.

FREE FALLIN' (L. Overall) - slow to begin.

PICK ME (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped LADY OF SPLENDOUR.





RACE 4: BORDERTOWN PUMPS & REFRIGERATION MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres (Cont'd)

UNCHAINED LAD (J. Maund) - held up for clear running in the early stages of the straight behind SLY CLUB and LADY OF SPLENDOUR and near the 200 metres shifted out around the heels of LADY OF SPLENDOUR to improve.

LADY OF SPLENDOUR (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped PICK ME. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

APOLLO GIRL (B. Wong) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Near the 800 metres shifted out abruptly and race wider on the track for a short distance.

SLY CLUB (H. Yuen) - shifted ground, in and out, when placed under pressure in the straight.

VICKEZZSTOCKINGS (NZ) (S Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: RAY WHITE BORDERTOWN RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

TEXERRO (C. Murray) - rider reported that the gelding made respiratory noises. Consequently, he restrained the gelding from the 400 metres and did not place it under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Taking into account that the gelding finished a considerable distance behind the field, Stewards advised trainer, Ms E. Maher that the results of an Endoscopy are to be forwarded to the Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

KEYSOR (S. Metcalfe) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

SAINT KITTS (D. Caboche) - near the 700 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of CHEEKY GRACE and had to be steadied.

NANA DULCE (J. Potter) - rider explained that when entering the straight he elected to shift wider across the heels of CHEEKY GRACE and ENZED BEER (NZ) as he believed the previous winners had come down the middle of the track. He added that in hindsight he may have been better suited staying close to the rails and improve to the inside of CHEEKY GRACE.

PHILLYVONNE (E. Boyd) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

KEETTOM (S. Logan) - buffeted on jumping away between JAYWICK and CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR.

JAYWICK (L. Overall) - shifted in at the start and bumped KEETTOM. Rider explained that it was his intention to lead; however, the gelding was unable to show sufficient speed and as a result trailed SPITEFUL. He added that on entering the straight he was hoping to improve to the inside of SPITEFUL; however, that run did not eventuate and as a result he elected to shift out across SPITEFUL's heels but was then again held up behind SPITEFUL and to the inside of CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR. He further added that thereafter he continued to be held up behind SPITEFUL, which commenced to weaken and as a result the gelding was never fully tested to the line.

GOOD LUCK CHUCK (S. Metcalfe) - which is over 10 years of age underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

INEBRIATING (D. Caboche) - hung out rounding the home turn.

CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR (B. Price) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped KEETTOM.

RACE 7: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

HASTA LA FIORENTE (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

MOSCOW MULE (K. Crowther) - hung in, in the straight.

RACE 7: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres (Cont'd)

PAINTED ON (S. Logan) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Logan and noted that she used it on three occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

SASUN (J. Maund) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by J. Maund and noted that he used it on three occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

READY FORA MOET (A. Livesey) - shifted out abruptly at the start and lost ground.

TIZA (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

RACE 8: WISE FARM EQUIPMENT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

RODNEY (L. Overall) - shifted out passing the 300 metres across the heels of HELLO LADIES to obtain clear running.

LUCIAN (B. Price) - rider had concerns with the geldings action near the 950 metres and restrained it out of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding suffered a catastrophic break down in the upper near hind area. The gelding was humanely euthanised and a post mortem sample was obtained. The matter was adjourned to allow Stewards and Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon to inquire into the relevant circumstances.

TEXAN WINDSTORM (C. Murray) - rider explained that over the concluding stages he was mindful of crowding JIMMYS EDGE on his inside when racing tight on the inside of LONRODEX, which was shifting in slightly on his outside, and therefore he did not ride his mount out fully to the end of the race.

SCOTTISH SOLDIER (J. Potter) - on entering the straight was held up for clear running behind HI SMOKEY and LONRODEX until near the 250 metres.

LADY ANNABEL (NZ) (K. Walters) - slow to begin.
