Report on Race Meeting held at Murray Bridge  
Racecourse by the Murray Bridge Racing Club on  
Friday, 29 July 2022

TRACK: Soft 5 (Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RAIL: Out 12 metres 1000 metres to Winning Post, out 6 metres Winning Post to 1700 metres, true remainder, out 9 metres 1200 metre Chute, out 6 metres 2000 metre Chute.

## RACE 1: DUTTON'S EASY TO DO BUSINESS WITH!! MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

MAGIC CITY (J. Toeroek) - slow into stride.

AERONOMIC (L. Neindorf) - rider explained in relation to the mare's performance that it travelled well during the event and may be suited over a shorter trip. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BRAZEN EAGLE (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly. Over raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 200 metres shifted out and away from SELLIX, which rolled out slightly.

SELLIX (A. Livesey) - over raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 200 metres rolled out slightly.

## RACE 2: CONGRATULATIONS FLOW METER DOUBLE CENTURY NOT OUT MAIDEN PLATE - 2000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to NELIAKA being fractious in the barriers and dislodging its rider.

ARASSEM (B. Price) - slow to muster speed in the early stages of the event. Near the 300 metres bumped with BOB'S REWARD, which rolled out. Over the concluding 200 metres laid in.

EROKI (J. Toeroek) - rider reported in relation to the gelding's performance that it failed to respond to his riding from shortly after the entrance to the straight and therefore he elected not to ride EROKI out in his normal manner over the concluding 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GEORGE HERCULES (K. Crowther) - near the 1500 metres rolled in and became awkwardly placed on the heels of AFRIDI (NZ), which was being restrained when over racing. Thereafter raced ungenerously in the middle stages of the event.

SILENT KHAN (B. Vorster) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it has not raced since November 2020 and was deemed suitable to race. Trainer, Mr A. Bain was fined \$100 under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards.

AFRIDI (NZ) (L. Overall) - over raced in the early stages of the event.

BOB'S REWARD (S. Metcalfe) - near the 300 metres rolled out and bumped ARASSEM.

ITALIAN REDWOOD (NZ) (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr G. Young was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future approval jump-out, trial or race start.

NELIAKA (J. Benbow) - was fractious in its barrier after being loaded and dislodged its rider. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and declared unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice NELIAKA was declared a late scratching at 1.21 pm. Assistant trainer, Mr T. Stokes was advised that the colt was now required to prove tractable in the barriers in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race start. J. Benbow was examined by First Care Medical personnel and was declared fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 3: TAB MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres

PLAYBOY CHARLIE (T. Pannell) - rider explained when question in relation to the gelding's performance that he was obliged to settle further back than he had intended and that the gelding travelled only fairly during the event and was inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr G & Mr D. Alexander were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future approval jump-out, trial or race start.

PRANCEALLOVERME (L. Neindorf) - shortly after the start rolled out taking FIREBASE CORAL out.

FIREBASE CORAL (B. Price) - shortly after the start was taken out by PRANCEALLOVERME.


LADY OF SPLENDOUR (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MISS PEARLY KATE (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr D. Shepherd was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future approval jump-out, trial or race start.

MELODY SHINE (C. Jones) - rider reported that the filly travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however when asked for an effort shortly after entering the straight, the filly failed to let down as she had expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: 2022 - 2023 MBRC MEMBERSHIP NOW AVAILABLE CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

BRAZANO (L. Overall) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

HANABI (J. Toeroek) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until near the 300 metres. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained in relation to the filly's performance that it did not travel well during the event and was held up rounding the home turn and when able to gain clear running near the 300 metres, it failed to let down and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE GOLFER (J. Maund) - near the 300 metres shifted in and away from VALHALLA FELLA onto THE WEIGHT, which was obliged to be steadied.

BOSSY CHLOE (K. Crowther) - reared as the start was effected and as a result was slow to begin, losing many lengths. Trainer, Mr D. Jolly was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

MANAGE THE CYCLE (S. Metcalfe) - near the 300 metres rolled out onto THE WEIGHT, which was obliged to be steadied.

GRACEFUL EAGLE (P. Gatt) - stood flat footed as the start was effected and as a result was slow to begin. Approaching the 200 metres shifted in abruptly and when being corrected rolled out and appeared to slip behind, become awkward in its action and shifted in abruptly. From that point on raced greenly to the line and was not tested by its rider. Trainer, Ms K. Byrnes was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its racing manners.

THE WEIGHT (J. Holder) - near the 300 metres was obliged to be steadied and shift in to obtain clear ground as THE GOLFER shifted in and away from VALHALLA FELLA and MANAGE THE CYCLE rolled out.

MADAM FURPHY (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow the Stewards and the Starter to view the vision of the start in relation to BOSSY CHLOE.

RACE 5: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

SEGAL (S. Callow) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto CONFIDANT as SHOPSTER shifted out.

SHE'S ESTELLE (J. Holder) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until near the 300 metres when racing between MAGICCOURT and MAY'S WEST.

SHOPSTER (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SEGAL, which lost its position. Near the 150 metres rolled out and inconvenienced SEBAGO.

YEAH YEAH NAH (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOOD APPROACH (K. Crowther) - on jumping away shifted in and hampered CONFIDANT.

SEBAGO (S. Logan) - near the 150 metres was inconvenienced as SHOPSTER rolled out.

UNASSAILABLE (J. Benbow) - lost its near hind plate during the event.

MAGICCOURT (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr P. Hardacre was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future approval jump-out, trial or race start.

JIVE BABY (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly.

MAY'S WEST (J. Maund) - rider reported that the mare felt short in its action in front. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEE YOU LATER Now (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Hung out rounding the home turn.



RACE 5: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

CONFIDANT (L. Overall) - on jumping away was hampered when tightened onto SEGAL as GOOD APPROACH shifted in.

RACE 6: 2022 GOLD CUP TICKETS NOW ON SALE!! BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

ZIGGI ROCKS (C. Rawiller) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

SILENT DON (B. Price) - following the declaration of acceptances Trainer, Ms A. Downing made a gear application to add a nasal strip to the gelding's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request. Trainer, Ms. A. Downing advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that she would instruct his rider to attempt to be more positive in today's event due to the favourable barrier draw. Settled midfield.

DAWNBURST (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly.

OBELOS (GB) (R. Hurdle) - prior to entering the mounting yard slipped over in the parade ring, underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg and was declared unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice OBELOS (GB) was declared a late scratching at 3.38 pm. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future approval jump-out, trial or race start.

EM BRYAN (J. Benbow) - slow to begin.

AZZURO BIANCO (A. Livesey) - on exiting the mounting yard took charge of the rider who did not have her feet in the irons and completed a full circuit of the course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice AZZURO BIANCO was declared a late scratching at 3.45 pm. Trainer, Mr G. Young was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its pre-race behaviour.

RACE 7: SPRY CIVIL CONSTRUCTION BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately three minutes owing to MAVETTE dislodging its rider.

DANISH FORTUNE (A. Livesey) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until approaching the 200 metres when racing between DESIDERO and ALL HARD WOOD.

LOMAX (L. Overall) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

MAVETTE (C. Jones) - on exiting the mounting yard contacted a perimeter fence, dislodged its rider and cantered free for some distance prior to being captured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Rider was examined by First Care Medical Personnel and was passed fit to ride. In the middle stages, when racing keenly, got its head up when being restrained.

FIGHT FOR FREEDOM (T. Pannell) - rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it raced flat and may be suited to racing trips over a shorter distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANOTHER FREE GLASS (J. Holder) - rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it travelled well during the event however, when asked for an effort shortly after the entrance to the straight, failed to respond to his riding and was very disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abnormal upper respiratory noise. Co-Trainer Mrs S. Jaensch advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future approval jump-out, trial or race.

JAMCRA (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - which raced at Balaklava on Wednesday, 27 July 2022, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

TIZA (S. Metcalfe) - slow to begin.

RACE 7: SPRY CIVIL CONSTRUCTION BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (Cont'd)

WE'LL MEET AGAIN (NZ) (D. Caboche) - Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg.

Race 6 - AZZURO BIANCO - Warning - Pre-race behaviour (took charge of rider en route to barriers) (Late scratching). Race 7 - ANOTHER FREE GLASS - Not to Race - Results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future approval jump-out, trial or race.
