RACE 1: EXIDE BATTERIES THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

AL RANCHERO (L. Overall) - Trainer, Mr A. Bain was fined \$100 under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Shifted out on jumping away and contacted MISCHIEVOUS TYCOON. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by L. Overall and noted that he used it on four occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

CLOSED VAULT (J. Toeroek) - kicked by another runner on arrival at the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed unsuitable to race. CLOSED VAULT was a late scratching at 12.09 pm by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice.

GLACIER GREY (B. Vorster) - Trainer Mr A. Bain was fined \$100 under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and hung out from near the 1000 metres until the entrance to the straight.



RACE 1: EXIDE BATTERIES THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

MOON BOOT (C. Murray) - rider reported the gelding raced greenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIR ARMINIUS (R. Hurdle) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages and hung out from near the 1000 metres until the entrance to the straight.

MISCHIEVOUS TYCOON (P. Gatt) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by AL RANCHERO.

ROC THE WOLF (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - proved difficult to load. Trainer Mr D. Jolly was advised a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners. Raced three wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported the filly was inclined to lay out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STELLA NOTATION (J. Holder) - Trainer Mr R. Balfour was reprimanded under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Refused to load. STELLA NOTATION was a late scratching at 12.12 pm by order of Stewards. Trainer Mr R. Balfour was advised the filly would be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 2: MID NORTH TYRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

MAJESTIC MOSHE (J. Maund) - near the 100 metres had to be steadied when MARGIN OF ERROR was taken in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANYTHINGYOUWANT (B. Price) - raced greenly in the early stages and near the 1300 metres shifted in onto CHENJAH. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported the gelding raced greenly in the straight.

HOTFOOTIT (J. Benbow) - inconvenienced near the 1000 metres when taken in slightly by TORRATORIO. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TORRATORIO (L. Neindorf) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and near the 1000 metres, shifted in onto MARGIN OF ERROR, which was taken in onto MAJESTIC MOSHE.

CHENIAH (C. Murray) - near the 1300 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when it shifted in and away from ANYTHINGYOUWANT.

RED ROOF (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

WILD SONNET (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 1300 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when CHENJAH shifted in and away from ANYTHINGYOUWANT.

THAT'S UNFORTUNATE (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

RACE 3: BALAKLAVA CUP 14TH SEPTEMBER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes in an attempt to avoid a clash with an Interstate race.

MORALLY BOUND (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported the gelding was inclined to hang out over the concluding 1000 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VERSES (T. Voorham) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since 14 January 2021 and was deemed suitable to race. Fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Trainer Ms J. Virgin was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Inconvenienced near the 1100 metres when KITBAG shifted out.



RACE 3: BALAKLAVA CUP 14TH SEPTEMBER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

KITBAG (D. Caboche) - near the 1100 metres improved onto the heels of MORALLY BOUND and in being steadied, shifted out into the running line of VERSES, which was inconvenienced when taken out onto STADIUM OF LIGHT (NZ).

STADIUM OF LIGHT (NZ) (J. Eaton) - inconvenienced near the 1100 metres when VERSES was taken out.

LADY DE LUNE (K. Crowther) - raced three wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained the filly had never travelled and had raced flat. She added when asked for an effort at the entrance to the straight, LADY DE LUNE only responded for a short distance and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: THE EYRE PENINSULA ADVOCATE MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

HELLO HOLLYWOOD (L. Overall) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

SAVILLE (R. Hurdle) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since 12 May 2021 and was deemed suitable to race. Laid out over the concluding 200 metres.

COURAGEOUS HEARTS (T. Voorham) - inconvenienced when taken wider inside the 200 metres by SAVILLE, which laid out.

KEMI (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr B. Richards, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race.

SUBUKI (A. Livesey) - got its leg up in the barriers shortly after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed unsuitable to race. SUBUKI was late scratching at 1. 56 pm by order of Stewards on veterinary advice. Trainer Mr T. Montgomerie was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

BICKERING (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOREXTRA (S. Logan) - rider reported that she had become concerned with the filly's action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: THE PLAINS PRODUCER BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres


DIXIE WHISTLER (L. Neindorf) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by L. Neindorf and noted that he used it twice over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

AMMO LOCO (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HALLAROSTE (K. Crowther) - reared as the start was affected and became cast. HALLAROSTE was safely removed from the barriers however, took no part in the race. Trainer Mr S. Seyers was advised that the gelding would be required to jump away with the field in an Official Barrier Trail prior accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abrasions to the off foreleg.

WOLF PRINCE (J. Eaton) - made the crossing in the vicinity of the 1800 metres awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

LUTZ (J. Benbow) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.



Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow the Stewards to view the start in relation to HALLAROSTE. After doing so, the gelding was declared a runner in accordance with AR204.



RACE 6: K BRERETON SHOWCASE JEWELLERS CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

CELESTIAL ILLUSION (L. Overall) - near the 300 metres commenced to shift out in attempt to a run to the outside of BALCREST BELLE and in doing so, continued to shift out taking REMARKABLES out towards the heels of SOUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ). Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to stop riding and straighten his mounts sooner than he had on this occasion.

FOX GEM (T. Pannell) - had to momentarily steady near the 1100 metres when SADLER'S SONG was taken out. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

REMARKABLES (S. Metcalfe) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened onto SOUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ) by BALCREST BELLE. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 200 metres had to take hold and alter course across the heels of SOUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ), which shifted in after it had initially been taken out onto the heels of SOUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ) by CELESTIAL ILLUSION.

BALCREST BELLE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto REMARKABLES.

SADLER'S SONG (T. Voorham) - near the 1100 metres was inconvenienced when contacted by SUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ) and taken out onto FOX GEM.

SOUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ) (E. Wong) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto MAKE IT A DOUBLE by REMARKABLES. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages and near the 1100 metres, shifted out onto SADLER'S SONG. Near the 200 metres shifted in under riding onto REMARKABLES, which had to take hold and alter course across its heels. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to straighten his mounts sooner that he had on this occasion.

EIGHT RUBIES (M. Collett) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE LEPRECHAUN (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the start and was deemed unsuitable to race. THE LEPRECHAUN was a late scratching at 3.03 pm by order of Stewards on veterinary advice as the gelding was found to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Ms J. Virgin, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RACE 7: BEACHY'S TERMINUS HOTEL, BALAKLAVA BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately four minutes.

CROWNED KING (E. Wong) - became fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. After being reloaded, again became fractious in it barrier. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Co-Trainer Mr J. Dunn was advised the gelding would be required to be tractable in the barriers in an Official Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

CHEVITE (L. Overall) - raced three wide without cover throughout the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by L. Overall and noted that he used it on five occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

FIFTY FOUR SQUARES (C. Murray) - slow to begin. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by C. Murray and noted that he used it once over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

CRIMSON ROSE (J. Maund) - fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.



RACE 8: DES ROSS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

DUNDEE (E. Wong) - near the 900 metres rolled in onto FIAMETTE. Rider was advised to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight in future.

RACE 8: DES ROSS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

CANIDAE (L. Overall) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground near the 200 metres and had to be steadied for a number of strides when tightened onto DUNDEE by FIAMETTE.

WHISKEY 'N' WOMEN (J. Benbow) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CITY BEATS (J. Doyle) - near the 1400 metres was hampered when contacted by LANCER and commenced to race fiercely until inside the 1000 metres.

FIAMETTE (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 900 metres had to be steadied when DUNDEE rolled in. Near the 200 metres shifted out onto CANIDAE. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure she was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

LANCER (A. Livesey) - near the 1400 metres shifted in onto CITY BEATS, which was hampered when tightened onto PALE ALE. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure she was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

PHOTOGENIC (R. Hurdle) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers as the rider was concerned with its action and was deemed suitable to race. Proved difficult to load. Trainer Mr G. Lynch was advised the gelding would be required to load without delay in an Official Trial prior to accepting for a future race. Shifted in on jumping away contacting READY FOR A MOET.

READY FOR A MOET (K. Crowther) - shifted out on jumping away contacting PHOTOGENIC. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PALE ALE (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OREGON TRAIL (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was exhibiting signs of the thumps. First aid administered.
