

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on
Wednesday, 3 August 2022



Stewards: S. Callanan (A/Chairman), M. Santoro (HT) & C. Deakin (F) (Stewards), B. Jarman (Cadet Steward), L. Murch (Deputy Steward), Dr B. Agnew (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Soft 7 (Rain affected track that will chop out)

RAIL: Out 3 metres 800 metres to 400 metres, out 2 metres remainder

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: IRONGATE AUSTRALIA MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

BLUE PAWSOM (S. Callow) - on jumping away shifted out onto TONY MONTANA. Shortly after the rider dropped her off side rein and was regathered over several strides. Held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until inside the 200m when racing between DR CHOCCY and AND THEN. Thereafter laid out for the remainder of the event.

DR CHOCCY (R. Hurdle) - which had not raced since November 2020, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

HELLO HOLLYWOOD (J. Maund) - on jumping away, shifted in onto TONY MONTANA. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Got its head up when being restrained near the 800m. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action with particular reference to its hind legs.

TONY MONTANA (B. Vorster) - on jumping away was inconvenienced by HELLO HOLLYWOOD, which shifted in and BLUE PAWSOM, which shifted out.

RACE 2: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

ALPINE FUN (J. Holder) - near the 900m was inconvenienced when TEQUILA SUNSET rolled in. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

KATINA JOY (B. Price) - hung out under pressure in the straight.

LILICIA (R. Hurdle) - after arriving on course, lost its off hind plate. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice LILICIA was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 11.55 am. Trainer, Mr P. Nolan was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

MYSTIC STORM (S. Callow) - laid in, in the early part of the straight.



RACE 2: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

SEMIFOX (B. Vorster) - rider reported that he had concerns with the mare's action from shortly prior to rounding the home turn and he therefore elected not to ride it out in his normal manner.

TEQUILA SUNSET (E. Annells) - near the 900m rolled in onto ALPINE FUN, which was inconvenienced. Approaching the 800m had to be momentarily steadied when awkwardly placed to the inside of POCKET RAIDER. Near the 150 metres shifted in and away from KATINA JOY, which was hanging out and shifted out. Raced greenly approaching the finish and was awkwardly placed on the heels of KATINA JOY.

TIGER QUEEN (T. Pannell) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the mare's performance.

RACE 3: TRIMBOLI SERVICES CLASS ONE PLATE - 2100 Metres

CHELIMO (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Approaching the 1600m rolled in onto RAPID RIDE which was steadied when racing keenly.

OREGON TRAIL (S. Metcalfe) - late scratching by order of the Stewards at 10.25 am acting on confirmed advice from Trainer, Mr K. that the gelding had injured itself on the float en route to course and would be unsuitable to race. Mr Healy was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

PAINTED ON (S. Logan) - in the early stages when racing keenly got its head up when being restrained.

RAPID RIDE (E. Wong) - approaching the 1600m when racing keenly was steadied when CHELIMO rolled in. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action, in particular reference to its front legs. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WOLF PRINCE (K. Crowther) - jumped away very awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FAST AND FLEXIBLE (B. Price) - slow into stride. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: COOPERS BREWERY RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

A KNIGHT IN PARIS (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

CITY BEATS (J. Doyle) - became cast in the float upon arrival on course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice CITY BEATS was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 12.22 pm. Co-trainer, Mr D. Moyle was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 5: MATRIX SOLAR SOLUTIONS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

ZIGGI ROCKS (R. Hurdle) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GO BALLISTIC (C. Murray) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MUFFLA (P. Gatt) - slow to being. Shifted about under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: CORNERSTONE STUD BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

DEEVINE (A. Livesey) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

OLD TIME ROCK (T. Pannell) - inside the 1000m rolled out.



RACE 6: CORNERSTONE STUD BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

WRITTEN IN HISTORY (R. Hurdle) - on arrival on course, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. After being loaded JUSTA JILLAROO, which was in the adjoining barrier, became fractious and kicked out. WRITTEN IN HISTORY underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

COMMANDING DIVA (P. Gatt) - inside the 1000m rolled in and was awkwardly placed on the heels of OLD TIME ROCK, which rolled out.

JUSTA JILLAROO (C. Jones) - became fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice JUSTA JILLAROO was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 3.41 pm. Trainer, Mr D. O'Leary was advised that the mare must perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump-out prior to a future race start.

THE PUBLIKIN (S. Metcalfe) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: GC & J CONSTRUCTIONS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BETTA EDDIE (E. Wong) - slow to begin. Approaching the finish shifted out abruptly. Rider was reminded of his obligations in relation to keeping his mounts straight when they commence to shift ground.

RIPPA EAGLE (NZ) (S. Callow) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped CHEH CHEH CHARLEE.

ZIP AKEED (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

NANA DULCE (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHEH CHEH CHARLEE (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped RIPPA EAGLE (NZ).
