

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown
Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on
Sunday, 21 August 2022



RACINGSAA

Stewards: C. Deakin (A/Chairman) & A. Hayles (HT) (Stewards), K. Rayson (Cadet Stewards), D. Holland (F) & J. Foster (Deputy Stewards), Dr D. Goulding (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Heavy 8 (Rain affected track that horses will get into)
Upgraded to Soft 7 at 2.58pm retrospective to Race 4 (Rain affected track that will chop out)

RAIL: Out 4 metres 1400 metres to 1200 metres, true remainder

RACE 1: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

CAPRICORN RIDGE (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages but when asked for an effort inside the 800m, bridled up and improved into the race however, inside the 400m was only one pace. She added that in her opinion CAPRICORN RIDGE may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAVETTE (L. Overall) - laid out from the 400m.

RACE 2: RAY WHITE BORDERTOWN BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

LOVE TO LOVE (T. Voorham) - rider explained that the gelding never travelled throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REGAL ROCKET (J. Benbow) - rider explained the gelding did not handle the underfoot condition in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR LYRIC (L. Overall) - laid in under pressure from the 200m.

CHEEKY GRACE (S. Callow) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.



RACE 3: WOOLSHED INN MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

HI CARL (NZ) (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly. Inside the 200m shifted in and away from TONY MONTANA onto the heels of ALL CLUBS and had to be eased.

TONY MONTANA (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped SKILLED UP. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

ALL CLUBS (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out in the straight and proved difficult to ride out over the concluding 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BONANSKI (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

SKILLED UP (E. Boyd) - bumped on jumping away by TONY MONTANA.

RACE 4: BORDERTOWN PUMPS & REFRIGERATION MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

DR CHOCCY (J. Benbow) - slow into stride. Rider explained that his instructions were to be forward in today's race however, after being slow to begin, the gelding became awkward in its action for a short distance shortly after the start, never really travelled until mid-race and approaching the 300m became disunited in its action and did not let down in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOON BOOT (C. Murray) - rider explained the gelding did not respond to his riding from inside the 400 metres and for that reason he did not ride MOON BOOT out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NOTA SINGLE SECRET (K. Crowther) - contacted the barriers when being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

RACE 5: DOAN PHARMACIES BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

TERRITORY TITAN (S. Callow) - approaching the 1000m was inconvenienced by ENZED BEER (NZ), which shifted in. Laid out in the straight.

ENZED BEER (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - approaching the 1000m shifted in and inconvenienced TERRITORY TITAN. Rider was reminded of her obligations to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

RACE 6: WISE FARM EQUIPMENT BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

SITTING BULL (L. Overall) - contacted on jumping away by CRIMSON ROSE.

DEFORCE (A. Lindsay) - hung out from the 800m and proved difficult to ride out. Trainer Mr R. Nicholson was advised that the gelding would be required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards at an Official Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

CRIMSON ROSE (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted SITTING BULL. Rider reported the mare laid out rounding the home turn.

RACE 7: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

JOURNEY IN TIME (C. Murray) -declared JOURNEY IN TIME a non-runner (refer below).

EIGHT RUBIES (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.



RACE 7: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres (Cont'd)

GOODARCHIE (C. Sardelic) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Rider explained after the gelding was slow to begin, he elected to take up a position rear of the field on the fence. However after doing so, GOODARCHIE began to over race from the 600m when placed under pressure and did not respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to review the start in relation to JOURNEY IN TIME. After doing so, Stewards determined the mare was encumbered on jumping away by the Barrier Attendant who has led JOURNEY IN TIME into the stalls, was still on the ground in front of the mare in the gates as the start was effected and as such, was denied a fair start. Stewards declared JOURNEY IN TIME a non-starter under AR204
